All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Kalyani (WB) has been established as an Institute of National Importance is one of the new upcoming AIIMS and apex healthcare Institute being established by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India under the **Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY)** with the aim of correcting regional imbalance in quality tertiary level healthcare in the country, and attaining self-sufficiency in graduate, postgraduate and higher medical education and training.

AIIMS, Kalyani will conduct **Written Exam and / or Personal Interview** for the post of **Junior Resident (Non-Academic)** on tenure basis in various Departments of AIIMS, Kalyani, West Bengal on **08.09.2026 (tentative)** in the Examination Hall, Ground Floor, Auditorium Building, AIIMS Kalyani. Candidates who have already done 2 terms* of Junior Residency (Non- Academic) either at AIIMS or outside will not be considered. Experience in Army services, Central Health Services, Private Nursing Homes & Private practice will be taken as equivalent to Junior Residency (Non- Academic).

Note (*): Term of JR (Non-Acad.) is 6 months, if anyone joins and leaves at any time it will be counted as one term irrespective of duration of work. For each term, the candidate(s) required to submit his/her application separately.

Essential qualification	- MBBS from Institution recognized by NMC. The candidate must have completed compulsory internship and must produce internship completion certificate and registration under any state medical council. - Those candidates who have passed MBBS (including Internship) not earlier than 03 (three) years before the start date of Junior Residency i.e. 24th August, 2026 will be considered. - Those candidates who have already done two terms of Junior Residency anywhere will not be considered.
GENERAL CONDITIONS	- The aspiring applicants satisfying the eligibility criteria in all respects can bring their application on the day of Written Exam and / or Interview in prescribed format attached herewith along with self- attested copies of certificates/documents in support of fulfilling the essential criteria of age, educational qualification, teaching/research experiences etc. - The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must be fulfilling eligibility criteria up to the date of publishing this notification in Institute website failing which their application will be rejected. - The original certificates i.e. MBBS Degree Certificates, Internship completion certificate, Qualifying degrees (MBBS) Medical Registration Certificate, Date of Birth Certificate, Caste Certificate etc., of the Candidates for the post of Junior Residents will be verified at the time of the Written Exam and / or Interview. - The candidate must submit a valid Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) certificate issued by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of a hospital/institution under the State or Central Government (for PwBD candidate).

The in-service candidates will not be permitted for Interview, if no objection certificate from employer is not produced. • Based on the reporting, the Written Exam will be conducted after verifying the application and requisite documents of the candidates. On selection, the candidates working in Govt./PSUs have to submit the Relieve Order. • The PwBD certificate should be issued by a duly constituted Medical Board of the State or Central Government Hospitals/ Instructions (for PwBD candidate). • All candidates, who want to avail benefit of reservation/ age relaxation / exemption of fee, should enclose a copy of certificate issued by competent authority in support of their claim for reservation exemption of fee and relaxation of age.

Terms & Conditions:

1. The appointment is purely on tenure basis and initially for a period of 6 months only. This appointment will not vest any right to claim by the candidate for regular appointment or permanent absorption in the Institute or for continued contractual appointment which may be renewed or terminated as decided by the Institute.
2. The appointment will entitle the appointee to a remuneration as mentioned.
3. The tenure engagement will automatically expire on completion of 6 months. The tenure engagement can be terminated at any time by the Institute. The employee can also leave the Institute by giving 01 (one) month notice or salary in lieu thereof.
4. The leave entitlement of the appointee shall be governed by the Institute's leave rules as amended from time to time.
5. Executive Director, AIIMS, Kalyani reserves the right to cancel the advertisement at any point of time without prior notice or fill up less number of posts as advertised depending upon the institutional requirement.
6. If any candidate who joins the post and leaves / resigns before the completion of the tenure, he/she may do so by giving one month notice as per rules or by depositing pay and allowances with the Institute for the period of which notice falls short of one month.
7. The Competent Authority reserves the right to change the number of vacancies, withdraw the process in full or in part and also the right to reject any or all applications received without assigning any reasons or giving notice etc..
8. This appointment is whole time and private practice of any kind is prohibited.

9. He/she will have to work in shifts and can be posted on rotation at any place including the Trauma & Emergency Medicine in the Institute.

10. He/she should also note that he/she will have to conform to the rules of discipline and conduct as applicable to the Institute employees.

11. No travelling or other allowances will be paid to the candidate for joining the post.

12. The candidate should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.

13. Canvassing in any form will render the candidate disqualified for the post.

14. If any declaration given or information furnished by the candidate proves to be false or if the candidate is found to have willfully suppressed any material information, he/she will be liable to be removed from services and such action as the appointing authority may deem fit.

15. The decision of the Competent Authority regarding selection of the candidate will be final and no representations will be entertained in this regard. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding.

16. If selected, you have to join within 30 days of issue of the Offer of Appointment & no joining extension will be considered.

17. Any corrigendum or revision of the advertisement or any other information regarding this recruitment will be posted on the official website of AIIMS, Kalyani only in due course. Candidates are advised to visit the website regularly for updated information in this regard.

Application Fees:

3) PwBD Category: Exempted (No Application Fees required)

4) The candidates have to pay the prescribed application fee through Demand Draft in favour of "AIIMS KALYANI INTERNAL RESOURCES ACCOUNT" payable at Kalyani.

5) Application fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

6) Applications without the prescribed fee will not be considered and summarily rejected.

Maximum Age-limit: -

Not exceeding 33 (Thirty-three) years as on the last date of the submission of the application.

(i) No age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC Candidates applying for unreserved vacancies.

(ii) Age relaxation permissible to various categories is as under: -

However, age relaxation will be regulated as per the DoPT instructions.

Reservation (for SC/ST/OBC/PWBD/EWS candidates):

- I. Reservation has been provided in the above post in accordance with the rules.
- II. Candidates applying in OBC/SC/ST category should possess the caste certificate issued by competent authority, valid for administration / Job in Central Govt. Institutions issued before the date of interview, failing which he/she shall not be allowed to appear in the interview for the same category. However, he/she can be treated as UR candidate, if in merit through Written Exam and / or Interview, subject to verification by Examination Recruitment cell. The OBC-NCL Certificate should be issued on or after 01.04.2026, but not later than the last date of submission of the application.
- III. In case suitable Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) candidates are not found, these posts will not be carried forward/or considered as backlog vacancy, hence Unreserved (UR) candidates may also be allowed provisionally to apply against EWSs posts advertised through above referred advertisement who may be considered in case suitable EWSs candidate are not found to fill up these posts reserved for EWSs. The EWS Certificate should be issued on or after 01.04.2026, but not later than the last date of submission of the application.
- IV. The reservation for PWBD candidates is 4% (on horizontal basis), as per GoI guidelines.

V. Criteria for Persons with Bench mark Disabilities (PWBD):

The disability certificate should be signed by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals/Institutions & countersigned by Medical Superintendent/CMO/Head of Hospital/Institution.

Note: Candidates whose compulsory rotating internship will be completed **on or before 24.08.2026** are eligible to apply for and appear in the Junior Resident Written Exam and / or Interview.

However, such candidates **must produce the original Internship Completion Certificate with one xerox copy on the day of the Written Exam and / or Interview.**

Failure to produce the original certificate will result in disqualification, and the candidate will not be permitted to appear for the Junior Resident Written Exam and / or Interview under any circumstances.

The last date for online registration is 24.08.2026, 5 PM.

Candidates will be informed in due course regarding their name inclusion, document verification schedule, and interview date based on their registration.

Please note:

- **No candidate will be allowed to appear for the Written Exam and / or Interview without prior registration.**
- **The Written Exam and / or Interview date may be changed, in such case, revised date will be informed to registered candidates only in due course through AIIMS kalyani website.**

On the day of the interview, candidates must:

- Come with application fee through Demand Draft in favour of “AIIMS KALYANI INTERNAL RESOURCES ACCOUNT” payable at Kalyani
- Fill the application form annexed to the advertisement with the required details.
- Bring the original documents and one set of self-attested photocopies of all relevant certificates for verification.
