The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) is a Statutory body established by the Government of India under the Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority Act passed by the Parliament in December 1985, which came into effect from 13th February, 1986. APEDA is the apex organization engaged in the work related to the development of exports of agricultural and processed food products from India, which fall a part of the Schedule under the APEDAAct. 1985.

APEDA intends to make recruitment to the following posts:

General Conditions:-

- 1. A candidate shall submit application only through online portal in the link provided.
- 2. The candidate will be required to upload documents/certificates in support of his/her educational qualifications and experience as may be required.
- 3. The candidate must have completed the essential qualification/experience on or before the closing/last date for submission of online application.
- $4. \qquad \text{Mere submission of the application does not confirm any right on the applicant to be called for test.}\\$
- 5. Application Fee:
 - (1) For the posts of Assistant General Manager (Information Technology): Rs 500/- (Rs Five Hundred only).
 - (2) For the posts of Assistant Manager (Agriculture) / Assistant Manager: Rs 300/- (Rs Three Hundred only).

Fee is payable by all candidates (excepting Female/SC/ST/Persons with Benchmark Disability who are exempted from payment of fee).

- 6. Fee should be paid through the link provided in the online application portal.
- 7. Applications received without the prescribed fee shall not be considered and summarily rejected. No representation against such rejection will be entertained.
- 8. Candidates who are not exempted from fee payment must ensure that their fee has been deposited with APEDA. If the fee is not received by APEDA, status of Application Form will be shown 'Incomplete' and this information is printed on the top of the Application Form. Further, status of fee payment can be verified at the 'Payment Status' link provided in the candidate's login screen. Such applications which remain incomplete due to non-receipt of fee will be SUMMARILY REJECTED and no request for consideration of 'such applications and/or fee payment made after the last date and time for submission of online applications' shall be entertained.
- 9. Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor will it be adjusted against any other selection current or future.
- 10. Relaxation in upper age limit is available for claiming age relaxation as under:

- (i) Candidates belonging to the OBC category who are also covered under any other clauses mentioned above will be eligible for grant of cumulative age-relaxation under both categories.
- (ii) The term Ex-servicemen will apply to the persons who are defined as Ex-servicemen in the Ex-servicemen (Re-employment in Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1979, as amended from time to time. The age concession will be admissible to Ex-servicemen i.e. a person who has served in any rank whether as combatant or non-combatant in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union and who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at own request or being relieved by the employer after earning pension.
- 11. SELECTION PROCEDURE:
- (1) Assistant General Manager (Information Technology):

The selection will be made through a written test consisting of one paper of 100 marks followed by interview of shortlisted candidates (40 marks).

(A) WRITTEN TEST: The questions scheme for the written test will be as under:

- Each objective type question will have four answer options and will carry one mark.
- There will be 25% negative marking for every wrong answer for objective type question.
- The duration of test will be 3 hours
- Marking of answers on OMR answer sheet by pen. No books/materials will be allowed.
- Answers for descriptive to be given on descriptive answer booklet.

(B) INTERVIEW:

Broad topics for the interview are: a. General IQ / general awareness about the agriculture sector in the country including knowledge of functioning of Government Departments (Central/States)/ their agencies and other stakeholders and various schemes announced and being implemented at various levels. b. Understanding of agriculture production and export – overall agriculture production in the country and state specific information. Role and functioning of APEDA and State nodal agencies and other stakeholders in promotion and development of Agri and processed food exports. NPOP/Certification under NPOP/APEDAAct/TRACE NETS/RCMC/COE etc. c. Managerial ability d. Understanding about International Trade and export process – About WTO /tariff structure and practice of international agreements, Market intelligence, Startups and Unicorns in Agri-business and Market Access. It is informed that the above topics are only indicative and not exhaustive. The Interview Board has the liberty to elicit questions on other subjects which are found relevant.

- The qualifying marks to be obtained in the written test for short-listing of candidates for interview will be 60%.
- The qualifying marks to be obtained in the interviews will be 60%.
- The merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in both the written test and interview.
- (2) For the post of Assistant Manager (Agriculture) and Assistant Manager:

The selection will be made through a written test consisting of a single paper 2 ½ hours duration 100 marks as under:

12. Medium of Examination for written tests for all the posts:

The paper shall be bilingual i.e. Hindi and English. The candidate may choose to write the paper either in English or Hindi as per his/her choice i.e., all the answers for the questions, if chosen to be attempted in Hindi, should be attempted in Hindi only. Similarly all the answers for the questions, if chosen to be attempted in English, should be attempted in English only. The paper by attempting one or more question in Hindi and the remaining in English or vice-versa will not be evaluated.

The qualifying marks to be obtained in the written test for short-listing of candidates will be 60%.

- 13. The written test will be held in centre(s) in Delhi NCR.
- 14. The candidature is provisional at every stage of selection process. Mere submission of application or selection to the post will not confer any right(s) on the candidate/applicant for appointment to the post. The candidate is required to fulfill all the qualifications (educational and experience) as prescribed and other criteria as mentioned above in case of her/his selection to the post. Wrong declaration / submission of false information or any other action contrary to law shall lead to cancellation of the candidature at any stage. Candidates may note that their admission to the written test is purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. The candidates should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions. Mere issue of e-Admit Card to the candidate for the written test and the candidate appearing in the written test(s) shall not imply that his/her candidature has been finally considered by the Authority. The verification of eligibility conditions with reference to the uploaded documents while submitting online applications will be done only after the written test. In case of non-fulfillment of eligibility conditions mentioned in the said advertisement, their candidature will not be considered for further selection process.
- 15. No interim correspondence will be entertained.
- 16. Those candidates who are employed in Govt./Semi Govt./Autonomous Bodies etc. should upload No Objection Certificate in the online portal.
- 17. Age of the applicant for the post will be calculated with reference to the closing date for receipt of the applications. Age relaxation for OBC/PwD/Ex-servicemen candidates will be as per Government rules/orders.
- 18. Candidates who seek age-relaxation and or exemption from fee payment (except women candidates for fee payment) must upload requisite certificate from the competent authority, in the prescribed format. Otherwise, their claim for age relaxation or exemption from fee payment will not be entertained. Candidates applying for posts reserved for OBC/EWS/PwD category must upload requisite certificate from the competent authority, in the format prescribed by the Government. Certificates in any other format are liable to be rejected. Candidates may also note that in respect of the above, their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified by the Competent Authority.
- 19. The procedure and process of recruitment shall be governed as per the Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (Recruitment) Regulations, 2022.

- 20. Success in the written test confers no right of appointment unless the competent authority in APEDA is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the service/post
- 21. Candidates selected for appointment are liable to serve anywhere in India i.e. all these posts carry All India Service Liability (AISL)
- 22. Candidates may please note that after payment of fee through the link provided in the online application portal, they will have to upload a copy of the proof/challan in the application portal and proceed further. The application shall be deemed to have been submitted successfully, only after completing all the prescribed steps in the online portal and generation of application number. Completed applications after generating application number will only be considered for further process.
- 23. APEDA reserves the right to cancel the recruitment process at any time.

Caution: - Canvassing in any form shall lead to disqualification and cancellation of the candidature.

NOTE: Candidate is required to upload the scanned colour passport size photograph in JPEG format (20 KB to 50 KB) in the online Application Form The photograph should not be more than three months old from the date of publication of the advertisement. Image dimension of the photograph should be about 3.5 cm (width) x 4.5 cm (height). The photograph should clearly show applicant's face without any blur and should be without cap and spectacles. The photo should capture full face, front view, with eyes open. The head should be in the center of the frame. There should be no distracting shadows on the face or background. Head coverings are not permitted except for religious reasons, but the facial features from bottom of chin to top of forehead and both edges of the face must be clearly shown. The expression on the face should look natural.

If proper photograph is not uploaded by a candidate, his/her candidature will be cancelled
