Candidates must read the notification carefully, understand and accept all the terms and conditions specified therein before submission of application form. By submission of application form by the candidate, it is construed that he / she has read the notification and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down there under.

The candidate will be required to submit (upload) a copy of **passport size photo, signature, SSC certificate, community certificate (for BC/SC/ST candidates), EWS and Non-Creamy Layer certificate**, if applicable, while submitting STAGE I Online Application Form.

The exact dates for submission of the Online Application Form/Preliminary Written Test will be notified separately through a Press Release and will be published on the official website shortly. Only candidates who fulfil all the

prescribed eligibility conditions and other requirements shall be eligible to apply. Candidates are advised to carefully verify and satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility before submitting the application. The application shall be submitted **online only** through the official website (<https://slprb.ap.gov.in>).

3. RULES GOVERNING THE POSTS:

- This recruitment to the posts mentioned as above (Post Code Nos. 21 and 22) is being made as per the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Police (Stipendiary Cadet Trainee) Rules issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh in G.O. Ms. No 315 Home (Pol.C) Department, dated 13-10-1999 and the amendments thereon.
- Recruitment to the posts mentioned in the Fire & Emergency Services Department (post code no.42) is being made as per the provisions of A.P. Fire Subordinate Service Rules, 1992 issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh in G.O. Ms. No. 568 Home (Prisons-A) Department dated 24-11-1992 read with G.O. Ms. No. 98 Home (Prisons-A) Department dated 12-05-2008 and G.O. Ms. No. 110 G.A. (Ser.A) Dept., dated 28-02-2008 read

with G.O. Ms. No. 216 G.A. (Ser.A) Dept., dated 17-04-2008 and further amendments thereon.

- (c) Recruitment to the posts mentioned in the Prisons and Correctional Services Department (post code nos. 53 and 54) is being made as per the provisions of Andhra Pradesh Jail Subordinate Service Rules issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh in G.O. Ms. No. 514 Home (Prisons. A) Department, dated 23-11-1993, and further amendments thereon and G.O. Ms. No. 303 Home (Prisons. A) Department, dated 20-12-2007, and further amendments thereon and G.O. Ms. No. 110 G.A. (Ser.A) Dept., dated 28-02-2008 and G.O. Ms. No. 216 General Administration (Services-A) Dept., dt: 17.04.2008 and G.O. Ms. No. 261 Home (Prisons. A) Dept., dated 04-10-2010, and G.O. Ms. No. 62 Home (Prisons) Dept., dated: 23.02.2013, and G.O. Ms. No. 166 Home (Prisons) Dept., dated: 10.07.2013, G.O. Ms. No. 49 Home (Prisons & Fire Services) Dept., dated: 07.05.2015, and G.O. Ms. No. 05 Home (Legal.II) Dept., dt: 19.01.2016.

4. WOMEN RESERVATION: Under direct recruitment, 33 ¹/₃ % of vacancies in each category (Communal Category), including EWS, are reserved for women for the Post Code No. 21 and 20 % of vacancies in each category (Communal Category), including EWS, are reserved for women for the Post Code No. 22 under direct recruitment. The reservation will be **a horizontal reservation** following principle of sufficiency i.e., the reservation of women candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective category to which the women candidate belongs, in relaxation to relevant rules relating to Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules 1996 and further amendments thereon. In the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable women candidates in a particular year, the vacancies reserved for them shall not be carried forward to the subsequent year and shall be filled up by men candidates of respective category.

5. The rule of Special Representation (reservation) i.e., EWS, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC(Group-I, Group-II and Group-III) and ST as provided in Rule 22 of A.P. State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 and further amendments thereon shall be applicable except in the case of 75% vacancies in the Scheduled Areas for Stipendiary Cadet Trainee Police Constables (Civil) (Men). As per the G.O.Ms.No. 315 Home (Police.C) Dept., dtd: 13.10.1999, G.O. Ms.No. 97 Home (Legal.II) Dept., dtd: 01.05.2006, G.O.Ms.No. 101 Home (Legal.II) Dept., dtd: 16.02.2009 & G.O. Ms. No. 87, Home (LEGAL-II) Department, dated 15.07.2016, as per G.O.Ms.No. 173, Home (Legal-II) Department, dated:16.09.2026 and subsequent amendments thereon 75%

vacancies in the scheduled areas of the state of Andhra Pradesh for Stipendiary Cadet Trainee Police Constables (Civil) (Men) will be filled with the Scheduled Tribes who are domiciled in the Scheduled Areas of 1. Vizianagaram, 2. Anakapalli 3. Polavaram 4. Alluri Sitharamaraju (ASR) 5. Eluru and 6. Parvathipuram Manyam Districts.

6. RESERVATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

The vacancies reserved for Special Categories i.e., Home Guard (HG), Children of Police Personnel (CPP); Meritorious Sportsman (MSP); National Cadet Corps (NCC); Ex-Servicemen (Ex.Ser); Children of deceased and Incapacitated Police personnel (CDI); Children of Prisons Department Personnel (CJP) and as per details given in Para 20 below shall be adjusted in horizontal manner on compartmentalized basis i.e., the reservation of Special Category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in respective communal category to which the candidate belongs. Vacancies which remain unfilled in any of the special categories for want of eligible candidates shall be added to the vacancies to be filled by the direct recruitment.

Note: Vacancies remaining unfilled in any of the Special Categories due to non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from among the eligible candidates belonging to the respective Communal Category.

7. BC RESERVATION & Non-CREAMY LAYER:

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes shall produce the Community Certificate and a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate issued by the competent authority of the Government of Andhra Pradesh for claiming reservation and age relaxation. The NCL Certificate shall have been issued on or after 01.04.2026.

Candidates who fail to produce a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate at the time of Certificate Verification at the PMT/PET Centre shall be considered under the Open Category (OC), subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions, such candidates shall not be permitted, under any circumstances, to subsequently change their category or claim reservation or age relaxation under the Backward Classes category at their option.

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes who fall under the Creamy Layer shall not be entitled to claim reservation or age relaxation admissible to Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer).

8. Pertaining to Backward Classes, Relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 12(B)(b)(ii)), and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' or 'any category in BC-E group' will be subject to the adjudication of the litigation pending before the

Honourable Courts. However, relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 12(B)(b)(ii)) and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' is applicable to Sl. No. 1 to 14 of BC-E group as per interim order dated 25-03-2010 in Civil Appeal No(s). 2628-2637 of 2010 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. As per the G.O. Ms. No. 23, Backward Class Welfare Dept., dated 07.07.2007, the castes mentioned in Sl. No. 15 are treated as 'OC' category.

9. SC/ST RESERVATION:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes should submit the Latest Community certificate, issued by the competent authority of A.P. State to claim reservation and age relaxation. The candidates belong to SC community should submit the latest community certificate based on the ordinance issued by the Government in A.P. Ordinance No.2 of 2025, dated 17.04.2025 as per the SC Sub-Classification (Group-I, Group-II and Group-III).

10. RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION CATEGORY

Candidates who are local to AP State as per the definition given in Presidential Order, 2025 and belonging to Economically Weaker Section Category (as per the G.O.Ms.No.73, GA (Services-D) Department, dated 04.08.2021) whose gross annual family income is below Rs. 8.00 lakh are to be identified as Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) for the benefit of reservation. The Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. The applicants should submit the EWS certificate which was issued on or after 01.04.2026 by the Tahsildar concerned.

11. The requisite educational qualification, age, physical standards, procedure to be followed for selection etc are given below. The candidates must carefully read, in their own interest, the instructions given in this notification as well as "General Instructions" in the online application, before filling the online application form.

12. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- A.**
- i. For the posts mentioned against Post Code Nos. 21 and 22 Men & Women are eligible.
 - ii. For the post mentioned against Post Code No. 42 & 53 Men only eligible.
 - iii. For the post mentioned against Post Code No. 54 Women only eligible.

B. Age Limit:

a. General Rule

- i. A person who is a local candidate of the State of Andhra Pradesh, is serving in the Andhra Pradesh Police Department as a Home Guard as on the date of issuance of the Notification, and has rendered not less than 360 days of service as a Home Guard during the preceding period of two years, and who continues to be in service as a Home Guard in the State of Andhra Pradesh as on the date of the Notification, must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 32 years as on 1st July, 2026, i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1994 and not later than 1st July, 2008.

ii. For the post code Nos. 21 & 22:

All other candidates must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 24 years as on 1st July, 2026 i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 2002 and not later than 1st July, 2008.

- iii. **For the post code no. 42, 53 & 54 :** Must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 32 years as on 1st July, 2026, i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1994 and not later than 1st July, 2008.

b. Age Relaxation:

The upper age limit prescribed in para **12 (B)((a)(i) (ii) (iii))** above will be relaxed as under:

- (i) Up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to Economically Weaker Section Category.
- (ii) Up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to a Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) or a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe.
- (iii) Length of regular service limited upto a maximum of five years if a candidate is an employee of AP State Government. Employees of APTRANSCO, DISCOMs, APGENCO, Corporations, Municipalities, Local bodies etc. are not entitled for age relaxation.
- (iv) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Union for the candidates who served in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Union.

- (v) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC provided the candidate rendered a minimum service of 6 months as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC.
- (vi) Up to a maximum of three years if a candidate is a retrenched temporary employee in the State Census Department with a minimum service of 6 months during 1991.
- (vii) In the case of a widow, a divorced woman or a woman judicially separated from her husband, and who has not remarried:
 - a) The candidate if she is an SC or ST, must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 42 years on 1st July, 2026 i.e., she must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1984 and not later than 1st July, 2008;
 - b) In the case of all other categories other than SC & ST, the candidate must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 37 years as on 1st July, 2026 i.e., she must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1989 and not later than 1st July, 2008;

NOTE: A candidate claiming age relaxation by virtue of being either a widow or a divorcee or a woman judicially separated from her husband, and who has not remarried, should produce the following documentary evidence.

- (i) In case of a widow, death certificate of her husband along with the affidavit that she has not re-married since.
- (ii) In case of a divorced woman or a woman judicially separated from her husband, a certified copy of the judgment/decreed of the appropriate court to prove the fact of divorce or the judicial separation, as the case may be, along with an affidavit that she has not re-married since.

The prescribed age limits shall not be relaxed under any circumstances, except as specifically provided above.

NOTE:

(1) The date of birth accepted by the SLPRB, AP is that entered in the Secondary School Certificate or Matriculation or an equivalent examination certificate. The document relating to age like horoscopes, affidavits, birth extracts from Municipal Corporation, service records and etc., will not be accepted.

(2) Due to various Age relaxations, Age validation is not being done in the Online Application Form. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the Candidates to satisfy themselves about their Age eligibility for the Post(s) applied for.

13. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

a) For Post Codes: 21, 22 & 42:

As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must have passed Intermediate or its equivalent examination recognised by the State Government. In the case of a candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, as on 1st July, 2026, he/she must have passed SSC or its equivalent examination recognised by the State Government and should have studied Intermediate and appeared for the Intermediate Examinations of 1st year and 2nd year.

Note: The candidate who possesses higher qualification than the prescribed qualification shall also be considered for selection along with the candidates who have the prescribed qualification only.

b) For post codes: 53 and 54: -

As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must have passed Intermediate or its equivalent examination recognised by the State Government.

Note: The candidate who possesses higher qualification than the prescribed qualification shall also be considered for selection along with candidates who have the prescribed qualification only.

c) ONUS OF PROOF OF RECOGNITION OF EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION: The Candidates may please note that the onus of proof of recognition of educational qualification such as Intermediate Certificate or its equivalent, or SSC certificate or its equivalent by the State Government, in case of doubt, solely rests with the candidate.

14. MEDICAL STANDARDS:

a. Eye Sight: Visual Standards required for the above selection shall be as follows:

- iii) Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eye or lids of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification.
- b. The candidate should possess sound health and be free from any bodily defect or infirmity which will render him unfit.
- c. Candidates who have the following ailments or defects will not be considered for recruitment to any post specified in this rule:
 - i. Physically handicapped.
 - ii. Knocking-knees, pigeon chest, flat feet, Varicose veins, Hammer toes, fractured limbs, decayed teeth, stammering, hard of hearing and abnormal psychological behaviour.

NOTE: In order to avoid disappointment, candidates are advised to have themselves examined by a **Civil Surgeon** before applying for the examination to ensure that they meet the prescribed Physical and Medical Standards.

15. FEE STRUCTURE

- a. Candidates having local candidature of Andhra Pradesh belonging to the OCs(including EWS) and BC categories, applying for the posts of SCT PC (Civil/AR) in the Police Dept., Warder (Men) & Warder (Women) in the Prisons & Correctional Services Department, and Firemen in State Disaster Response and Fire Services Department, shall pay a fee of Rs.300/- towards processing of the application, PMT/PET, Written Examinations, etc.
- b. Candidates having local candidature of Andhra Pradesh belonging to the SC and ST categories shall pay a fee of Rs.150/- only.
- c. Candidates who are Non-Local to the State of Andhra Pradesh shall be treated under the Open category (OC) and shall pay a fee of Rs.300/-.

Mode of Payment of Fee:

I Step: Candidate has to visit SLPRB Website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> to pay prescribed Registration Fee, through Credit Card, Debit Card, Net Banking or any other mode made available on the SLPRB Website by providing his / her details such as Name, Date of Birth, Mobile Number, Community and SSC Hall Ticket Number or its equivalent.

II Step: After making the Payment, Candidate has to visit the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> to submit the STAGE I Online Application Form. After making payment of fee, if the candidate fails to press “submit” in the STAGE I

Online Application Form, such cases shall be rejected without giving any notice, and fee once paid shall not be refunded in any case.

III Step: Candidates who are declared qualified in Preliminary Written Test have to again visit the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> for uploading the STAGE II Application along with the original scanned copies of Certificates / Documents before participating in the PMT/PET.

16. Those who intend to apply for different categories of posts (Post Code No 21, 22, 42, 53 & 54), need to submit only **one application form**.

17. CANDIDATES SHOULD ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The candidates applying for the recruitment should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions as given in the notification. Their admission at all stages of the recruitment process will be purely provisional and subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.

Mere issue of Admit card / Hall ticket to the candidate will not imply that his / her candidature has been finally cleared by the SLPRB. The SLPRB will take up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to the Genuineness of original documents only after the candidate has finally qualified.

18. SELECTION PROCEDURE / SCHEME:

The Selection Procedure/Scheme will be as follows:

A. PRELIMINARY WRITTEN TEST: (Post Code Nos: 21, 22, 42, 53 & 54):

Candidates shall be required to appear for the Preliminary Written Test in **One Paper** (three hours' duration) for **200 marks (200 Questions)**. The syllabus for Preliminary Written Test is given in Annexure II (enclosed).

NOTE:

- (1) (a) The minimum marks to be secured by the candidates in order to qualify in the Preliminary Written Test is 40% for OCs (including those claiming EWS reservation), 35% for BCs, 30% for SCs/STs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks, he/she will be disqualified and will not be allowed for further stage of selection process. Marks obtained in Preliminary Written Examination will have no relevance in the final selection.
- (b) Candidates who belongs to Special Categories i.e. Ex-Servicemen, HG, MSP, CPP, CDI, NCC and CJP shall secure the minimum qualifying marks as per their respective communal category in which he/she belongs. If a

candidate fails to secure qualifying marks, he/she will be disqualified and will not be allowed for further stage of selection process. Marks obtained in Preliminary Written Examination will have no relevance in the final selection.

- (2) Questions in Preliminary Written Test will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu and Urdu languages. Candidates have to answer the questions on OMR answer sheet using Blue / Black Ball Point pen only. For this purpose, candidates should bring Blue / Black Ball Point pens along with them.

INTIMATION LETTER: The candidates who qualify in the Preliminary Written Test will be informed about the dates for downloading the Intimation letter through the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> for appearing in the PHYSICAL MEASUREMENTS TEST (PMT)/ PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (PET) with details of Venue, Date and Time. Candidates should bring the Intimation Letter when they come to attend the PMT/PET.

B. PHYSICAL MEASUREMENTS TEST (PMT): Candidate who qualify in the Preliminary Written Test has to undergo Physical Measurements Test and should meet the following requirements:

i. MEN: For the Post Code Nos. 21, 22, 42 & 53:

- a. Height: Must not be less than 167.6 centimeters.
- b. Chest: Must not be less than 86.3 centimeters round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 5 centimeters.

WOMEN: For the Post Code No. 21, 22 & 54:

- a. Height: Must not be less than 152.5 centimeters.
- b. Weight: Must not be less than 40 Kgs.

NOTE: Provided that the candidates who belongs to Aboriginal Scheduled Tribes (ABO-ST) in the Agency areas of 1. Vizanagaram, 2. Anakapalli 3. Polavaram 4.Alluri Sitharamaraju (ASR) 5.Eluru and 6.Parvathipuram Manyam Districts should meet the following requirements::

MEN: For the Post Code Nos. 21, 22, 42 & 53:

- a. Height : Must not be less than 160 centimeters.
- b. Chest : Must not be less than 80 centimeters round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 3 centimeters.

WOMEN: For the Post Code No. 21, 22 & 54:

- a. Height: Must not be less than 150 centimeters.
- b. Weight: Must not be less than 38 Kgs.

Note: The Height, Chest and Weight measurements of the candidates shall be recorded using a digital measurement system. The Height of the candidate shall be measured while the candidate is standing upright in the correct position.

C. PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (PET): Candidate who qualify in the above Physical Measurement Test will be required to undergo the following tests and qualify as specified below:

i. (Post Code No. 21, 42, 53 & 54):

Men & Women Candidates must qualify in:

1. 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run) and
2. One out of the remaining two events of 100 meters run or long jump.

The Physical Efficiency Test will be qualifying in nature, as per the qualifying standards given below:

The candidates will be given marks for their performance in the above three events as per the gradation table as shown in **Annexure I(A) & Annexure I(B)** (enclosed).

Note-1:

1. The events shall be conducted using electronic devices/equipment.
2. Spike shoes shall not be permitted during the Physical Efficiency Test (PET).
3. The time taken by the candidate in each event shall be recorded accurately using the prescribed electronic timing system. Any fraction of a millisecond or delay beyond the prescribed measurement shall not be taken into consideration for the purpose of calculation of time.
4. Once any event is conducted as part of the recruitment process, the result thereof shall be treated as final. No second chance, re-test or re-conduct of the event shall be permitted under any circumstances.

Note-2:

Participation in all prescribed events shall be compulsory for every candidate, including candidates belonging to Special Categories.

D. FINAL WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

Candidates who qualify in the above Physical Efficiency Test shall be required to appear for the final written examination in one paper (three hours duration) for 200 marks.

For the post code no. 21, 42, 53 & 54, the 200 questions will be graded for a maximum marks of 200.

For the post code no. 22 the 200 questions will be graded for a maximum marks of 100.

The syllabus for the exam is given in **Annexure II (enclosed)**.

NOTE:

1. (a) The minimum marks to be secured by the candidates in order to qualify in the Final Written Test is 40% for OCs (including those claiming EWS reservation), 35% for BCs, 30% for SCs/STs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks, he/she will be disqualified.

(b) Candidates belonging to Special Categories i.e. Ex-Servicemen, HG, MSP, CPP, CDI, NCC and CJP shall secure the minimum qualifying marks as per their respective communal category in which he/she belongs.
2. Candidates will have to mention their option of Language in which he/she will write Written Examination while submitting Application Forms.

3. Questions in written examination will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu and Urdu languages. Candidates have to answer the questions on an OMR answer sheet using Blue / Black Ball Point pen only. For this purpose, candidates should bring Blue / Black Ball Point pens along with them.

E. FINAL SELECTION:

For Post Code No. 21 : The final selection of the candidates (Men & Women) will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their score in the final written examination for 200 marks for the candidates who qualified in Physical Efficiency Test. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are applicable for the post of PC (Civil) as specified in G.O.Ms.No.103, G.A.(SPF&MC) Department., dated :15.07.2026.

As per G.O.Ms.No. 172 G.A. (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 02.09.2026 and further amendment thereon, while filling up of the posts under direct recruitment the first 05% of posts should be filled locals and non-locals candidates on the basis of merit in Open Competition and thereafter, the remaining 95% of the posts shall be filled up by locals only.

For Post Code No. 22: The final selection of the candidates (Men & Women) will be made strictly on relative merit, as per marks obtained by them based on their score in the final written examination (for 100 marks) and Physical Efficiency Test (for 100 marks) totalling to 200 marks. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are applicable for the post of PC (AR) as specified in G.O.Ms.No.105, G.A.(SPF&MC) Department., dated :15.07.2026.

As per G.O.Ms.No. 172 G.A. (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 02.09.2026 and further amendment thereon, while filling up of the posts under direct recruitment the first 05% of posts should be filled locals and non-locals candidates on the basis of merit in Open Competition and, thereafter, the remaining 95% of the posts shall be filled up by locals only.

For Post Code No. 42: The final selection of the candidates will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their score in the final written examination for 200 marks for the candidates who qualified in Physical Efficiency Test. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are applicable for the post of Firemen in State Disaster Response

and Fire Services Department as specified in G.O.Ms.No.107, G.A.(SPF&MC) Department., dated :15.07.2026.

As per G.O.Ms.No. 172 G.A. (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 02.09.2026 and further amendment thereon, while filling up of the posts under direct recruitment the first 05% of posts should be filled locals and non-locals candidates on the basis of merit in Open Competition and, thereafter, the remaining 95% of the posts shall be filled up by locals only.

For Post Code No. 53 & 54: The final selection of candidates for the posts of Warder (Men) and Warder (Women) shall be made strictly on the basis of relative merit, determined by the marks obtained by the candidates in the Final Written Examination carrying 200 marks, subject to their qualifying in the prescribed Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are applicable for the post of Warder (Men) and Warder (Women) in Prisons and Correctional Services Department as specified in G.O.Ms.No.162, G.A.(SPF&MC) Department,dated :24.08.2026.

As per G.O.Ms.No. 172 G.A. (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 02.09.2026 and further amendment thereon, while filling up of the posts under direct recruitment the first 05% of posts should be filled locals and non-locals candidates on the basis of merit in Open Competition and, thereafter, the remaining 95% of the posts shall be filled up by locals only.

NOTE:

Preference: When two or more candidates in a particular category obtain equal marks, preference will be given to the candidate who was born earlier.

19. RESERVATION TO LOCAL CANDIDATES (POST CODE No. 21, 22,42,53 & 54):

DEFINITION OF LOCAL CANDIDATE:

Reservation to Local Candidates shall be applicable as per The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025, issued vide G.O.Ms.No.45, General Administration (SPF&MC) Department, dated 20.04.2026. Candidates claiming Local Candidate reservation shall submit the required Study Certificate(s) from Class I to Class VII, issued by the concerned Government/Government-recognized School Authorities (Annexure-III(A)). If the candidate has not studied in any Government/Government-recognized school during any part of the seven-year period, a Residence Certificate for that period, issued by the

Tahsildar of the concerned Mandal, shall be submitted for determining Local Status (Annexure-III(B)).

NOTE: Single certificate, whether of study or residence would suffice for enabling the candidate to apply as a “Local Candidate”.

(i) If, however, a candidate has resided in more than one Mandal during the relevant four/seven years’ period but within the same District, separate certificates from the Mandal Revenue Officers exercising jurisdiction has to be obtained in respect of different areas.

NOTE: Residence certificate will not be accepted, if a candidate has studied in any educational institution up to 7th class or equivalent examination. Invariably, such candidates have to produce study certificates only. The candidates, who acquired Degree from Open Universities without studying SSC/Matriculation or equivalent in educational institutions, have to submit residence certificate only.

Reservation to local candidates is applicable as provided in the Rules and as amended from time to time as in force on the date of notification. The candidates claiming reservation as local candidates should enclose the required Study certificates from I class to VII class. In case, he/she has not studied from I class to VII class in one particular district Residence Certificate, in the given proforma only, should be enclosed for those candidates who have not studied in any Educational Institutions.

NOTE: As per G.S.R. 775 (E) read with GSR 591 (E): The candidates who migrated to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of Ten years from the 2nd day of June, 2014 shall be regarded as the local candidate in the State of Andhra Pradesh at the place of his / her residence and be treated at par with the local candidates residing in that area, in accordance with such guidelines as may be issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for the purpose of employment.

Candidates who are covered by this order will be required to submit necessary certificate as per the instructions given by the Government of Andhra Pradesh at the time of appearing for Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test (Only those candidates who qualify for Preliminary Written Test).

20. SPECIAL REPRESENTATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

As per G.O.Ms.No. 173, Home (Legal-II) Department, dated:16.09.2026, all vacancies arising under the Special Categories shall be applicable exclusively to

candidates who are local to the State of Andhra Pradesh, in accordance with “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025” and the rules and orders in force.

As per G.O. Ms No. 87 of HOME (LEGAL-II) dated: 15-07-2016 and subsequent amendments thereon, the vacancies reserved for special categories shall be adjusted in a horizontal manner on compartmental basis, that is the reservation of special category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective communal category to which the candidate belongs.

A. Percentage of Quota in the Special Categories:

- i) **For Post Code No. 21:** 15% for Home Guards (HG); 4% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP); 3% for Meritorious Sportsperson (MSP); 3% for NCC; 2% for Ex-Servicemen; and 2% for CDI.
- ii) **For Post Code No. 22:** 15% for Home Guards (HG); 4% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP); 3% for Meritorious Sportsperson (MSP); 3% for NCC; 2% for Ex-Servicemen; and 2% for CDI.
- iii) **For Post Code No. 42:** 10% for Home Guards (HG); and 2% for Ex-Servicemen.
- iv) **For post code no. 53:** 5% for Children of Jail/Prison Personnel (CJP); and 2% for Ex-Servicemen.

B. Candidates who claim reservation / quota under the special categories should satisfy the following conditions:

- i. **Home Guard:** A person who is a local candidate of the State of Andhra Pradesh, is serving in the Andhra Pradesh Police Department as a Home Guard as on the date of issuance of the Notification, and has rendered not less than 360 days of service as a Home Guard during the preceding period of two years, and who continues to be in service as a Home Guard in the State of Andhra Pradesh as on the date of the Notification, shall be eligible to avail the reservation earmarked for Home Guards, subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions.
- ii. **CPP:** Children of Police Personnel up to the rank of Inspector of Police in AP Police Department who are either in service or retired or dead, will come under this special category.

NOTE: Children of police personnel who were compulsorily retired or removed or dismissed from service will not be considered for quota under “Children of Police Personnel” (CPP).

iii. MSP (Meritorious Sportsperson) – "Meritorious Sportsperson" means a sportsperson who has represented the State of Andhra Pradesh or the Country in recognized sports events at the national or international level or secured a medal either in State level Competition or in the All India Inter - University competitions conducted by the Inter-University Boards in any of the games, sports mentioned in G.O. Ms. No. 56 GA (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 15.05.2026; and any other games / sports as may be specified by the Government from time to time:

- a. As per G.O.Ms.No.25, YAT&C (Sports & YS) Department, dated 15.05.2026 written tests and events are mandatory for applicant for selection under sports quota.
- b. Priority will be given based on the level of sports achievement as per the priority list prescribed at Section-VIII in G.O.Ms.No. 25 YAT & C (Sps & YS) Dept., dtd: 15.05.2026 for the best achievement made by the meritorious sportsperson during the eligible period.
- c. Resolution of Tie Cases: - In the event of a tie between two or more candidates holding equal priority at the highest level.
 - i. Preference shall be given to the candidate having a greater number of similar high-level sports achievements.
 - ii. If the tie persists, preference shall be given to the candidate possessing a greater number of sports achievements at the next lower level.
 - iii. If the tie still persists, preference shall be given to the candidate who is elder in age.

NOTE: While filling up the vacancies, preference shall be given to Category-A disciplines. Category-B disciplines will be considered only if vacancies remain unfilled by Category-A candidates (As mentioned in the G.O.Ms.No. 25 YAT & C (Sps & YS) Dept., dtd: 15.05.2026.

NOTE: Candidates who claim reservation quota under Meritorious Sportsperson category should satisfy the above conditions and submit the certificates in Annexures: VIII, IX, X or XI, as the case may be, of this notification.

iv. NCC – National Cadet Corps: Candidates who possess NCC ‘C’ certificate will be preferred. If sufficient candidates are not available, then the candidates who possess NCC ‘B’ certificate will be considered. If vacancies still remain unfilled, then the candidates who possess NCC ‘A’ certificate will be considered.

NOTE: Candidates who claim reservation / quota under NCC (A/B/C) should submit the necessary certificate.

v. Ex-Servicemen: Candidates who claim reservation as Ex-Servicemen should satisfy the conditions mentioned in Rule 2 (16) of A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules and should have the necessary certificate from the competent authority.

“Ex-Servicemen” means a person who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or as a non-combatant) in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union, but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the General Research Engineering Force, Lok-Sahayak Sena and the para-military forces, i.e., Border Security Force, Central Reserve Police Force, Indo-Tibetan Border Police, Central Industrial Security Force, Central Secretariat Security Force, Assam Rifles and Railway Protection Force and

- (i) who has retired from such service after earning his/her pension; or
- (ii) who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or

- (iii) who has been released, otherwise than on his own request, from such service as a result of reduction in establishment or
- (iv) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct, inefficiency and has been given a gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories; namely:-
 - (a) pension holders for continuous embodied services;
 - (b) person with disability attributable to military services; and
 - (c) gallantry award winners.

Explanation: The persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service, would come under the category of ex-servicemen, may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified terms of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specified term of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union.

- vi. **CDI:** (1) Children of Police Personnel of A.P. Police Department who (a) died due to violent action of the extremists/criminals/anti-social elements or (b) were incapacitated and were retired on medical invalidation due to violent action of the extremists/criminals/anti-social elements and
 (2) Children of Police Personnel of Andhra Pradesh Police Department who (a) died due to violence while on duty or (b) were incapacitated and were retired on medical invalidation due to violence while on duty.
- vii. **CJP:** Children of Jail/Prison Personnel upto the rank of Jailor in service in A.P. Prisons and Correctional Services Department as well as Children of Prison Personnel upto the rank of Jailor, who after serving in the A.P. Prisons and Correctional Services Dept. have, either retired or died, will come under this special category.

NOTE: Candidates who claim reservation/quota under Home Guard, CPP, CDI & CJP special category should satisfy the above conditions and submit the certificate as per annexure IV, V, VI and VII respectively. The certificate(s) pertaining to Home Guard, CPP, CDI or CJP should be obtained on or after the date of notification from the competent authority. The certificate obtained before the date of notification is not valid and it will not be entertained.

21. Recruitment to all the posts, including those of special categories, shall be made as per the provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local cadres and regulation of direct recruitment) Order, 2025” and further amendments thereon.

22. The selection of the candidates will be provisional and subject to verification of the genuineness of original certificates, antecedents and medical examination.

23. ANTECEDENTS VERIFICATION: No person shall be eligible for appointment to any service by direct recruitment unless he / she satisfies the selection authority as well as the appointing authority that his / her character and antecedents are such as to qualify him / her for such service.

24. DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT: The candidates falling under the following categories shall be disqualified for appointment, under these rules:

- i. If any document produced by the candidate is found fake or forged as established during antecedent verification.
- ii. If the candidate himself or through his relatives or friends or any other has canvassed or endeavoured to enlist extraneous support whether from official or non-official sources for his candidature.
- iii. A person (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person. Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- iv. A person who has been dismissed from the services of a State or Central Government or from the service of any Central or State Government undertaking or local body or other authority.
- v. A person who has been convicted for any offence or facing trial in any court of law, except for offences of technical nature like Motor Vehicles Act Violations, J.J. Act (Juvenile Justice) Violations, shall stand disqualified.
- vi. A person who is involved in an offence involving moral turpitude is disqualification for appointment.

25. In the event of any information being found false or incorrect or ineligibility being detected at any time even after appointment, he / she will be discharged from service forthwith by the appointing authority without giving any notice.

26. STIPEND AND ALLOWANCE: During the period of institutional training (for Post Code nos. 21 & 22) (regular as well as extended), candidates shall be eligible for stipend as fixed by the Government from time to time.

27. After successful completion of training, they will be appointed in the regular time scale of Pay as mentioned herein.

Scale of Pay: For Post Code No. 21, 22, 42, 53 and 54): Rs 25,220 – 80,910 /- as per Revised Pay Scale 2022.

28. The employees who are appointed on or after 01-09-2004 are covered by the Contributory Pension Scheme.

29. Time limit for submission of attestation forms (or) other relevant documents (or) attend medical examination (or) join the training: As per G.O.Ms.No. 101 Home (Legal.II) Department, dated: 16.02.2009, the candidates who are provisionally selected for any one of the post specified in this rule, will be asked to submit an attestation form, produce other relevant documents and attend medical examination on a specified date. The candidates who become eligible to be sent for training will be asked to join the training on a specified date. If any candidate fails to respond and submit the necessary form or document, or fails to attend the medical examination, or fails to join the training on a specified date, his / her provisional selection shall be cancelled without giving prior notice to the candidate.

30. General Instructions:

- i. Particulars furnished by the Candidates in the Application Form will be taken as final. Candidates should, therefore, be very careful in uploading / submitting the Application Form Online.
- ii. Incomplete / Incorrect Application Form will be summarily rejected. The information, if any, furnished by the Candidate subsequently in any form will not be entertained by the SLPRB, AP under any circumstances. Candidates should be careful in filling up the Application Form before submission. If any lapse is detected at any stage of the recruitment process, the candidature will be instantly rejected.
- iii. Serving personnel of the Army, Navy, Air Force or Territorial Army of the Indian Union who are due to retire within one year from the last date prescribed for submission of the Stage-I Online Application Form shall produce a “No Objection Certificate (NOC)” issued by their respective Unit Commanding Officer, duly indicating the Personnel Number, Rank, Name, Unit and Date of Retirement, or the Retirement Order, as applicable, for

claiming age relaxation and/or reservation under the Ex-Servicemen category.

- iv. Based on the information submitted by the candidate, at the time of STAGE I Online Application Form, (i.e. Community, Local & Non-Local, Ex-servicemen certificate, EWS and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate etc.), the Preliminary Written Test results will be issued. If any information is later found false, the candidature of such candidate shall be rejected, without giving notice and prior intimation.
- v. Candidates must submit all the relevant certificates during the process of physical verification of the certificates at the time of PMT/PET. No further submission of certificate will be entertained/received by SLPRB, AP at later stage.
- vi. The selection list shall be prepared based on the preferences indicated by the candidate in the Application Form as per the eligibility (i.e. Post Preference and Unit Preference). Candidature will not be considered against those Posts / Units which were left blank / or were left unfilled by the Candidate.
- vii. Candidates are advised to carefully read and fully understand all the instructions, terms and conditions contained in this Notification before submitting the Online Application Form. Submission of the Online Application Form shall be deemed to constitute the candidate's acceptance of all the terms and conditions stipulated in this Notification.
- viii. If Candidates who are Under-Age or Over-Age apply for this Recruitment Notification, SLPRB, AP will not be responsible for rejection of their candidature, and fee once paid will not be refunded.
- ix. No waiting list shall be maintained for any recruitment conducted by SLPRB, AP. The selection list against the notified vacancies shall be final. Any vacancy arising due to cancellation, relinquishment, unwillingness, non-joining, medical unfitness, adverse antecedents or any other reason shall be deemed to have lapsed and shall not be filled.
- x. The candidates who were selected for any one of the post specified in this notification and is an employee of A.P. State Government / any other State Government / Central Government / any Government undertaking can join training only after relief / resignation in the earlier service.

- xi. **The SLPRB, AP reserves the right to issue corrigendum/supplementary notifications time to time in case there is any modification in rules or in the recruitment process.**

Failure to produce the same will lead to rejection of the candidature and no additional time shall be given.

- g) Certificate from the competent authority in respect of State Government employees/those who worked in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Indian Union/NCC Instructors/ retrenched temporary employees in the State Census Department during 1991 for claiming age relaxation.*

- m) A candidate claiming age relaxation by virtue of being either a widow or a divorcee or a woman judicially separated from her husband, and who has not remarried, should produce the relevant documentary evidence (Para 12 (B) (b) (vii)).*

- n) The candidate who migrated to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of ten years from the 2nd day of June, 2014 shall submit relevant certificate in order to claim local candidate status (Para No. 19).*
