SLPRB, AP, reserves the right to notify the modifications with regard to any aspect of recruitment any time during the process of recruitment. Candidates must read the notification carefully, understand and accept all the terms and conditions specified therein before submission of application form. By submission of application form by the candidate, it is construed that he / she has read the notification and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down there under.

2. The candidate will be required to submit (upload) a copy of **passport size photo, signature, SSC certificate, community certificate (for BC/SC/ST candidates), EWS and Non-Creamy Layer certificate**, if applicable, while submitting Online Application Form.

3. The exact dates for submission of the Online Application Form will be notified separately through a Press Release and will be published on the official website shortly. Only candidates who fulfil all the prescribed eligibility conditions and other requirements shall be eligible to apply. Candidates are advised to carefully verify and satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility before submitting the application. The application shall be

submitted **online only** through the official website (<https://slprb.ap.gov.in>).

4. RULES GOVERNING THE POSTS:

This recruitment to the posts mentioned as above (Post Code Nos.15 to 16) is being made as per the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Police (Stipendiary Cadet Trainee) Rules issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh in G.O. Ms. No.315, Home (Pol.C) Department, dated 13-10-1999 and the amendments thereon.

5. WOMEN RESERVATION:

Under direct recruitment, 33 ¹/₃ % of vacancies in each category (Communal Category), including EWS, are reserved for women for the Post Code No. 15. The reservation will be **a horizontal reservation** following principle of sufficiency i.e., the reservation of women candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective category to which the women candidate belongs, in relaxation to relevant rules relating to Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules 1996 and further amendments thereon. In the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable women candidates in a particular year, the vacancies reserved for them shall not be carried forward to the subsequent year and shall be filled up by men candidates of respective category.

6. The rule of Special Representation (reservation) i.e., EWS, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC(Group-I, Group-II and Group-III) and ST as provided in Rule 22 of A.P. State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 and further amendments thereon..

7. RESERVATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

I. For the Post Code Nos. 15:

The vacancies reserved for Special Categories i.e. Ex.Servicemen (Ex-Ser.), Children of Police Personnel (CPP), as per details given in Para 21 below shall be adjusted in horizontal manner on compartmentalized basis i.e., the reservation of Special Category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in respective communal category to which the candidate belongs. The vacancies which remain unfilled in any of the special categories for want of eligible candidates shall be added to the vacancies to be filled by the direct recruitment.

Note: Vacancies remaining unfilled in any of the Special Categories due to non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from among the eligible candidates belonging to the respective Communal Category.

II. For the Post Code Nos.16:

The vacancies reserved for Special category i.e., Ex. Servicemen (Ex-Ser.), as per details given in Para 21 below shall be adjusted in a horizontal manner on compartmentalized basis i.e., the reservation of Special category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in respective communal category to which the candidate belongs. The vacancies which remain unfilled in special categories for want of eligible candidates shall be added to the vacancies to be filled by the direct recruitment.

Note: Vacancies remaining unfilled in any of the Special Categories due to non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from among the eligible candidates belonging to the respective Communal Category.

8. BC RESERVATION & NON-CREAMYLAYER:

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes shall produce the Community Certificate and a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate issued by the competent authority of the Government of Andhra Pradesh for claiming reservation and age relaxation. The NCL Certificate shall have been issued on or after 01.04.2026.

Candidates who fail to produce a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate at the time of Certificate Verification at the PMT/PET Centre shall be considered under the Open Category (OC), subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions, such candidates shall not be

permitted, under any circumstances, to subsequently change their category or claim reservation or age relaxation under the Backward Classes category at their option.

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes who fall under the Creamy Layer shall not be entitled to claim reservation or age relaxation admissible to Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer).

9. Pertaining to Backward Classes, Relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 13(B)(b)(ii)), and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' or 'any category in BC-E group' will be subject to the adjudication of the litigation pending before the Honourable Courts. However, relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 13(B) (b)(ii)) and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' is applicable to Sl. No. 1 to 14 of BC-E group as per interim order dated 25-03-2010 in Civil Appeal No(s). 2628-2637 of 2010 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. As per the G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Class Welfare Dept., dated 07.07.2007, the castes mentioned in Sl. No. 15 are treated as 'OC' category.

10. SC/ST RESERVATION:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes should submit the Latest Community certificate, issued by the competent authority of A.P. State to claim reservation and age relaxation. The candidates belong to SC community should submit the latest community certificate based on the ordinance issued by the Government in A.P. Ordinance No.2 of 2025, dated 17.04.2025 as per the SC Sub-Classification (Group-I, Group-II and Group-III).

11. RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION CATEGORY:

Candidates who are local to AP State as per the definition given in Presidential Order, 2025 and belonging to Economically Weaker Section Category (as per the G.O.Ms.No.73, GA (Services-D) Department, dated 04.08.2021) whose gross annual family income is below Rs. 8.00 lakh are to be identified as Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) for the benefit of reservation. The Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. The applicants should submit the EWS certificate which was issued on or after 01.04.2026 by the Tahsildar concerned.

12. The requisite educational qualification, age, physical standards, procedure to be followed for selection etc are given below. The candidates must carefully read, in their own interest, the instructions given in this notification as well as “General Instructions” in the online application, before filling the online application form.

13. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

A) i. For the post mentioned against Post Code No. 15; Men & Women are eligible.

ii. For the post mentioned against Post Code No. 16 only Men are eligible.

B) Age Limit:

a. General Rule

For the Post Code Nos. 15 & 16:

Must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 27 years as of 1st July, 2026 i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1999, and not later than 1st July, 2005.

b. Age Relaxation:

The upper age limit prescribed in para 13 (B) (a) above will be relaxed as under:

- (i) Up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to Economically Weaker Section Category.
- (ii) Up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to a Backward Class (Non- Creamy layer) or a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe.
- (iii) Length of regular service limited upto a maximum of five years if a candidate is an employee of AP State Government. Employees of APTRANSCO, DISCOMs, APGENCO, Corporations, Municipalities, Local bodies etc. are not entitled for age relaxation.
- (iv) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Union for the candidates who served in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Union.
- (v) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC provided the candidate rendered a

minimum service of 6 months as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC.

- (vi) Up to a maximum of three years if a candidate is a retrenched temporary employee in the State Census Department with a minimum service of 6 months during 1991.

The prescribed age limits shall not be relaxed under any circumstances, except as specifically provided above.

NOTE: (1) The date of birth accepted by the SLPRB, AP is that entered in the Secondary School Certificate or Matriculation or an equivalent examination certificate. No other document relating to age like horoscopes, affidavits, birth extracts from Municipal Corporation, service records and the like will be accepted.

(2) Due to various Age relaxations, Age validation is not being done in the Online Application Form. It is the responsibility of the Candidates to satisfy themselves about their Age eligibility for the Post(s) applied for.

14. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

i. For the Post Code: 15

As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must possess Diploma/B.Tech in Electronics and Communication Engineering or Electrical and Electronics Engineering or Computer Engineering or Information Technology or Special Diploma Course in Electronics with specialization in Computer Engineering or Special Diploma Course in Electronics with specialization in Communication Engineering awarded by the any State Board of Technical Education and Training or Three years degree in B.Sc. Electronics or a qualification approved by the Government of Andhra Pradesh as equivalent to any of the above.

NOTE: The candidate who possesses higher qualification than the prescribed qualification and the candidate with higher qualification without the prescribed qualification shall also be considered for selection along with candidates who have the prescribed qualification only.

ii. For the Post Code: 16

As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must possess Diploma in Electrical Engineering or Mechanical Engineering or Automobile Engineering awarded by the State Board of Technical Education, Andhra Pradesh (or) a qualification approved by the Government of Andhra Pradesh as equivalent to any of the above.

NOTE: The candidate who possesses higher qualification than the prescribed qualification and the candidate with higher qualification without the prescribed qualification shall also be considered for selection along with candidates who have the prescribed qualification only.

15. ONUS OF PROOF OF RECOGNITION OF EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION: The Candidates may please note that the onus of proof of recognition of educational qualification by the State Government, in case of doubt, solely rests with the candidate.

The Degrees obtained through open universities / Distance Education mode must have recognition by the Distance Education Council (DEC), Government of India. Unless such degrees have been recognized by the DEC, they will not be accepted for the purpose of Educational Qualification. The onus, in case of doubt, of proof of recognition by the DEC, that the Degrees / Universities have been recognized, rests with the candidate. Candidates may also refer to GO RT No. 143 of HIGHER EDUCATION (EC) DEPARTMENT, Dated:11.07.2018 and the Supreme Court Judgment Dated 03.11.2017 in this context.

16. MEDICAL STANDARDS:

a. Eye Sight: Visual Standards required for the above selection shall be as follows:

ii) Each eye must have a full field of vision.

iii) Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eye or lids of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification.

b. The candidate should possess sound health and be free from any bodily defect or infirmity which will render him / her unfit.

c. Candidates who have the following ailments or defects will not be considered for recruitment to any post specified in this rule:

- i) Physically handicapped.
- ii) Knocking-knees, pigeon chest, flat feet, Varicose veins, Hammer toes, fractured limbs, decayed teeth, stammering, hard of hearing and abnormal psychological behavior.

NOTE: In order to avoid disappointment, candidates are advised to have themselves examined by a **Civil Surgeon** before applying for the examination to ensure that they meet the prescribed Physical and Medical Standards.

17. FEE STRUCTURE

- a. Candidates having local candidature of Andhra Pradesh belonging to the OCs (including EWS) and BC categories, applying for the posts of SIs (Communication) and SIs (PTO), shall pay a fee of Rs.600/- towards processing of the application, PMT/PET, Written Examinations, etc.
- b. Candidates having local candidature of Andhra Pradesh belonging to the SC and ST categories shall pay a fee of Rs.300/- only.
- c. Candidates who are Non-Local to the State of Andhra Pradesh shall be treated under the Open Category (OC) and shall pay a fee of Rs.600/-.

a. Mode of Payment of Fee:

I Step: Candidate has to visit SLPRB Website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> to pay prescribed Registration Fee, through Credit Card, Debit Card, Net Banking or any other mode made available on the SLPRB Website by providing his/her details such as Name, Date of Birth, Mobile Number, Community and SSC Hall Ticket Number or its equivalent.

II Step: After making the Payment, Candidate has to visit the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> to submit the Online Application Form. After making payment of fee, if the candidate fails to press “submit” in the Online Application Form, such cases shall be rejected without giving any notice, and fee once paid shall not be refunded in any case.

III Step: As there is no Preliminary Written Test for the technical posts of SCT SI(Communications) and SCT SI (PTO), Candidates shall visit the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> at the appropriate time prior to PMT / PET and upload the Application along with scanned copies of the required certificates / documents.

18. Those who intend to apply for both categories of posts (Post Code Nos.15 & 16), need to submit only **one application form**.

19. CANDIDATES SHOULD ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The candidates applying for the recruitment should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions as given in the notification. Their admission at all stages of the recruitment process will be purely provisional and subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.

Mere issue of Admit card / Hall ticket to the candidate will not imply that his / her candidature has been finally cleared by the Board. The board will take up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to the genuineness of the original documents only after the candidate has finally qualified.

20. SELECTION PROCEDURE / SCHEME:

The Selection Procedure / Scheme will be as follows:

(a) Preliminary Written Test:- There will be no Preliminary Written Test for the above posts. Candidates have to report for verification of certificates and Physical Measurements Test which will be mentioned in the Hall Tickets after registration.

(b) PHYSICAL MEASUREMENTS TEST (PMT): Physical Measurements Test and should meet the following requirements:

i. MEN: For the Post Code Nos. 15 & 16:

- a) Height : Must not be less than 162 centimeters.
- b) Chest : Must not be less than 84 centimetres round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 4 centimetres.

ii. WOMEN: For the Post Code No. 15:

- a) Height: Must not be less than 152.5 centimeters.
- b) Weight: Must not be less than 40 Kgs.

NOTE : Provided that the candidates who belongs to Aboriginal Scheduled Tribes (ABO-ST) in the Agency areas of 1. Vizanagaram, 2. Anakapalli 3. Polavaram 4.Alluri Sitharamaraju (ASR) 5.Eluru and 6.Parvathipuram Manyam Districts should meet the following requirements:

MEN: For the Post Code Nos. 15 & 16:

- a) Height : Must not be less than 160 centimeters.
- b) Chest : Must not be less than 80 centimetres round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 3 centimetres.

WOMEN: For the Post Code Nos. 15:

- a) Height: Must not be less than 150 Centimeters.
- b) Weight: Must not be less than 38 Kgs.

Note: The Height, Chest and Weight measurements of the candidates shall be recorded using a digital measurement system. The Height of the candidate shall be measured while the candidate is standing upright in the correct position.

C) PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (PET): Candidate who qualifies in the above Physical Measurement Tests will be required to undergo the following tests and be qualified as specified below:

- i) (Post Code No. 15) (Men & Women):** All candidates declared qualified as above shall be required to attend 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run) which is qualifying.
 - (a) Male candidates must complete the run in 10 Minutes or less time.
 - (b) Women candidates must complete the run in 12 Minutes 30 Second or less time.
- ii) (Post Code No.16) (Men):** All candidates declared qualified as above shall be required to attend 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run) which is qualifying. Candidates must complete the run in 10 Minutes or less time.

Note-1:

- 1. The events shall be conducted using electronic devices/equipment.
- 2. Spike shoes shall not be permitted during the Physical Efficiency Test (PET).
- 3. The time taken by the candidate in each event shall be recorded accurately using the prescribed electronic timing system. Any fraction of a millisecond or delay beyond the prescribed measurement shall not be taken into consideration for the purpose of calculation of time.

4. Once any event is conducted as part of the recruitment process, the result thereof shall be treated as final. No second chance, re-test or re-conduct of the event shall be permitted under any circumstances.

Note-2:

Participation in all prescribed events shall be compulsory for every candidate, including candidates belonging to Special Categories.

D) WRITTEN EXAMINATION (For the Post Code Nos. 15&16)

Candidates who qualify in the above Physical Efficiency Test shall be required to appear for the Written Examination in three papers (each of three hours duration) as given below. **The syllabus is given in Annexure-I (A) & (B)**

NOTE:

- (i) (a)The minimum marks to be secured by the candidates in order to qualify in the Final Written Test in each the paper is 40% for OCs (including EWS category), 35% for BCs, 30% for SCs/STs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks even in one paper, he/she will be disqualified. The marks secured in this papers i.e., paper I will not be taken into account for final selection.
- (b) Candidates who belonging to Special Categories i.e. Ex.Servicemen and CPP, shall be secure the minimum qualifying marks in each paper as per their respective communal category in which he/she belongs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks even in one paper, he/she will be disqualified. The marks secured in Paper-I will not be taken into account for final selection.
- ii) Papers I is only qualifying in nature. The cases of the candidates who do not secure the minimum qualifying marks in this Paper will not be considered further in the selection process irrespective of their performance in Paper II and III. The marks secured in this paper i.e., paper I will not be taken into account for final selection.

- iii) Paper I referred above will include questions that are descriptive in nature. They have to answer the question using Blue/Black Ball point pen.
- iv) Questions in Papers II will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu and Urdu languages. Paper-III will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu and Urdu languages. Candidates have to answer the questions on an **OMR answer sheet** using Blue / Black Ball Point pen only. For this purpose candidates should bring Blue / Black Ball Point pens along with them.
- v) Candidates will have to mention their option of Language in which he/she will write Written Examination while submitting Application Forms.

Note:- Revaluation of Answer Sheets will not be entertained under any circumstances. However, the Re-counting of marks may be considered.

E) FINAL SELECTION:

- i. **For Post Code No. 15 (Men & women):** The final selection of the candidates (Men & Women) will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their score in the written examination Paper-II for 100 marks and Paper-III for 200 marks (Total 300 marks) for the candidates who qualified in Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are not applicable
- ii. **For Post Code No. 16 (Men):** The final selection of the candidates will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their score in the written examination in Paper-II for 100 marks and Paper-III for 200 marks (Total 300 marks) for the candidates who are qualified in Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are not applicable.

NOTE: When two or more candidates in a particular category obtain equal marks, preference will be given to the candidate who was born earlier.

21. SPECIAL REPRESENTATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

As per G.O.Ms.No.173, Home (Legal-II) Department, dated:16.09.2026, all vacancies arising under the Special Categories shall be applicable exclusively to candidates who are local to the State of Andhra Pradesh, in accordance with “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025” and the rules and orders in force

As per G.O. Ms No. 87 of HOME (LEGAL-II) dated:15-07-2016 and subsequent amendments thereon, the vacancies reserved for special categories shall be adjusted in a horizontal manner on compartmental basis, that is the reservation of special category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective communal category to which the candidate belongs.

A. Percentage of Quota in the Special Categories:

- i) **For Post Code Nos. 15:** 2% for Ex-Servicemen; 2% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP).
- ii) **For Post Code Nos. 16:** 2% for Ex-Servicemen.

Candidates who claim reservation / quota under the special categories should satisfy the following conditions:

a) Ex-Servicemen: Candidates who claim reservation as Ex-Servicemen should satisfy the conditions mentioned in Rule 2 (16) of A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules and should have the necessary certificate from the competent authority.

“Ex-Servicemen” means a person who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or as a non-combatant) in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union, but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the General Research Engineering Force, Lok-Sahayak Sena and the para-military forces, i.e., Border Security Force, Central Reserve Police Force, Indo-Tibetan Border Police, Central Industrial Security Force, Central Secretariat Security Force, Assam Rifles and Railway Protection Force and

- (i) who has retired from such service after earning his/her pension; or
- (ii) who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or

- (iii) who has been released, otherwise than on his own request, from such service as a result of reduction in establishment or
- (iv) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct, inefficiency and has been given a gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories; namely:-
 - (a) pension holders for continuous embodied services;
 - (b) person with disability attributable to military services; and
 - (c) gallantry award winners.

Explanation: The persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service, would come under the category of ex-servicemen, may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified terms of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specified term of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union.

b) CPP (Children of Police Personnel): Children of Police Personnel, up to the rank of Inspector of Police in AP Police Department who are either in service or retired or dead, will come under this special category.

NOTE-1: Children of police personnel who were compulsorily retired or removed or dismissed from service will not be considered for quota under 'Children of Police Personnel' (CPP).

NOTE-2: Candidates who claim reservation/quota under CPP special category should satisfy the above conditions and submit the certificate as per annexure-III, respectively, as the case may be. The certificate(s) pertaining to CPP should be obtained on or after the date of notification from the competent authority. The certificate obtained before the date of notification is not valid and will not be entertained.

22. Recruitment to the post of special categories, shall be made as per the provisions of "The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local cadres and regulation of direct recruitment) Order, 2025" and further amendments thereon.

23. The selection of the candidates will be provisional and subject to verification of the genuineness of original certificates, antecedents and medical examination.

24. ANTECEDENTS VERIFICATION: No person shall be eligible for appointment to any service by direct recruitment unless he / she satisfies the selection authority as well as the appointing authority that his / her character and antecedents are such as to qualify him / her for such service.

25. DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT: The candidates falling under the following categories shall be disqualified for appointment, under these rules:

- i. If any document produced by the candidate is found fake or forged as established during antecedent verification.
- ii. If the candidate himself or through his relatives or friends or any other has canvassed or endeavoured to enlist extraneous support whether from official or non-official sources for his / her candidature.
