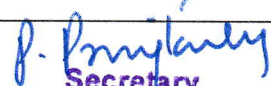

COMBINED COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION-2026**

The Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) invites online applications from the citizens of India who are Permanent Residents of Arunachal Pradesh and holds indigenous status of Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe for admission to **Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination-2026, (APPSCCE-2026)**, for recruitment to various Services/Posts in the Government of Arunachal Pradesh as per the details given below: -

NOTE: The number of vacancies and the reservations if any is based on “Proforma of Requisition” submitted by the indenting/requisitioning departments of Government of Arunachal Pradesh.


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A. HOW TO APPLY

- (1) Before filling the Online Application Form for the post advertised, a candidate must mandatorily register for **ONE TIME REGISTRATION (OTR)**.
- (2) Those who have already registered in OTR need not register again and they can directly login to fill up online form using the same user ID and password.
- (3) Candidates are required to apply online on <https://appsc.gov.in> . Detailed instructions for One Time Registration (OTR) and Online Application are available on the APPSC website (<https://appsc.gov.in>).
- (4) The applicants are advised to submit only single application, however, if due to any unavoidable situation, he/she submits another/multiple applications, the application with the highest Registration ID (RID) will be accepted by the Commission. Therefore, the highest RID application should be complete in all respects. The fee paid against one RID shall not be adjusted against any other RID.
- (5) The online application submission link shall be active from **1700 hours on 16th September, 2026** till last date of submission i.e. before **1700 hours on 20th October, 2026** on the APPSC website.
- (6) **The candidates should carefully fill the requisite details in the online application form. The application form once submitted within the last date of submission should be complete in all respects and no additional time shall be provided to the candidate to further change or upload additional information. The candidates are requested to minutely go through the DECLARATION provided in the online application form before final submission of form. Any information found to be wrong or not in conformity to the conditions laid in the Recruitment Rules or other relevant Govt. Rules at any stage of examination may lead to cancellation of candidature for APPSCCE-2026.**

B. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

- (1) Applicants should hold a Graduate Degree from any of the University Grants Commission recognized Universities incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institution established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or possess such qualification as may be declared equivalent by the Government.
- (2) Applicants who have appeared or who intend to appear at such a qualifying examination shall also be eligible. However, such candidates will be admitted to the examination, if otherwise eligible, but their admission shall be deemed to be provisional and subject to cancellation if they do not produce the proof of having passed the requisite examination, in original, on the day of Interview/Viva voce test of the Main Examination. If an applicant fails to do so, he/she will not be permitted to appear in the interview/viva-voce test of the main examination. If the degree certificate cannot be produced due to non-holding of convocation by the concerned university, then marksheet issued by competent authority should be produced as proof of having passed the qualifying examination.


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C. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In pursuant to Government Notification issued vide F.No.AR-33/17/2026-SECT-1-AR (Computer No.326793) /111 dated 26th August, 2026, all the candidates applying for Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination-2026 must satisfy the following conditions of Mandatory Eligibility Criteria:

(1) Permanent Residence Criterion:

The candidate must be a citizen of India and an inhabitant of Arunachal Pradesh holding a valid Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) of Arunachal Pradesh issued by the designated Competent Authority under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh.

(2) Indigenous Status and Arunachal Pradesh Schedule Tribe Criterion:

The candidate must be an original inhabitant of Arunachal Pradesh and holds an Arunachal Pradesh Schedule Tribe (APST) Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, as per the list of Tribes notified by the Government of India in the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950 from time to time.

(3) Indigenous Tribal Language Proficiency Criterion:

The candidate must be able to speak any of the Indigenous Tribal Languages of Arunachal Pradesh as per the list of Tribal Language notified by the Government India under the Constitution of India Scheduled Tribes Order, 1950, as amended from time to time and must possess working knowledge of the local indigenous tribes. However, the implementation Mechanism for Language Test will be as per the provision of the Government Notification issued vide F.No.AR-33/17/2026-SECT-1-AR (Computer No.326793)/111 dated 26th August, 2026.

D. AGE LIMIT

- (1) A candidates should not be less than 21 years and not more than 35 years of age as on last date of receipt of online application form i.e. 20th October, 2026.
- (2) The upper age limit prescribed above will be relaxable,
 - (i) Up to a maximum of the five years for the Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe (APST) candidates.
 - (ii) Up to a maximum of 8 years in case of Defence Service Personnel, belonging to APST, disabled in operations during hostility with a foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof.
 - (iii) Up to a maximum of 15 years for APST PwBD candidates.
- (3) Age concession in respect of regular Government servant will be as per Govt. rules and regulation in force from time to time.
- (4) The date of birth accepted by the Commission will be that which is entered in Matriculation/High School Leaving Certificate or Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate or a Certificate recognized by an Indian University as equivalent to matriculation or an extract from a Register or Matriculates maintained by a university, whose extract must be certified by the competent authority of the university.
- (5) No other documents relating to age, like horoscope, affidavits, birth extract from municipal corporation, registrar of economics and statistics and service records shall be accepted.


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E. PLAN OF EXAMINATION

- (1) The Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination (APPSCCE) - 2026, shall comprise of two successive stages as follows: -
 - (i) Preliminary Examination (Objective Type) for the selection of candidates for the Main Examination and
 - (ii) The Main Examination (Written and Interview) for selection of candidates for various Services and Posts in the Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
- (2) The Preliminary Examination will consist of 02(two) objective type papers (Multiple choice questions) and carry maximum marks in the subject as set out in Section – II, Part – A of Schedule -II of the **Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination Rules, 2019** and the **Syllabi for the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination notified vide dated 4th December, 2019 (ANNEXURE-2) and as amended vide Govt. Notification No. PERS-36/2/2022 dated 13th March, 2024 (ANNEXURE-3).**
- (3) The Preliminary Examination is meant to serve as a screening test only. Marks obtained in the Preliminary Examination by the candidates, who are declared qualified to write the Main Examination will not be counted for determining their final Order of Merit.
- (4) The number of candidates to be admitted to the Main Examination will be about **12 times** the number of advertised vacancies in the various services and posts or as decided by the Commission. Only those candidates who are declared by the Commission to have qualified in the Preliminary Examination will be eligible for admission to the Main Examination of that particular year, provided they are otherwise eligible for admission to the Main Examination.
- (5) The Main Examination will consist of Written Examination and Interview test.
 - (i) **Written Examination:** The written examination will consist of 08 (Eight) papers of subjective type in the subjects set out in Part – B, Section-II of Schedule-II of the **Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination Rules, 2019**. The syllabus for the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination notified vide dated 4th December, 2019 (ANNEXURE-2) and as amended vide Govt. Notification No. PERS-36/2/2022 dated 13th March, 2024 (ANNEXURE-3) is uploaded on the APPSC website. The candidates applying for the Arunachal Pradesh Police Service (APPS) has to conform to the physical standard, Physical Efficiency Test and Medical Standard as per provisions contained in Arunachal Pradesh Police Service Rules, 1989 as amended from time to time. **"The Arunachal Pradesh Police Service (Amendment) Rules, 2022 is appended herewith at ANNEXURE-1.**
 - (ii) In pursuance of the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination Rule, 2019, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Department of Administrative Reforms Notification vide no. AR-27012/212022-SECT-1-AR dated 14 August, 2023, Arunachal Pradesh Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018 and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the Minimum Qualifying Marks for the written examination of Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive (Main) Examination-2026 for each subject shall be as stated hereunder:


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English (Compulsory): 33% of the total marks (300 marks) for candidates of all categories.

The English (Compulsory) paper will be of qualifying nature and candidates across all categories must score 33% of the total marks (300 marks) in this paper. The marks obtained in this paper shall not be counted for merit, however, the rest of the subject papers shall be evaluated only if the candidate qualifies in this paper.

Merit Subjects (Essay, General Studies-I, General Studies-II, General Studies-III, General Studies-IV, Optional subject-I and Optional Subject-II):

a) In order to qualify the candidate should score an aggregate of 33% of the total marks of 07 papers (that is, aggregate of 577.50 marks out of 1750 marks) subject to the condition that the candidate should score at least 20% in each of 07 Merit Subjects.

b) In order to qualify a PwBD category candidate should score an aggregate of 20% of the total marks of 07 papers (that is, aggregate of 350 marks out of 1750 marks) subject to the condition that the candidate should score at least 10% in each of 07 Merit Subjects,

(iii) **Interview Test:** On the basis of performance in the Written Examination, candidates who obtain minimum qualifying marks in the Written Examination shall be invited for an Interview/Viva-Voce for personality tests in the ratio of 1:3 of the advertised vacancies or as decided by the Commission. The Interview Test will carry 275 marks in accordance with Part-C, Section – II of Schedule-II of the **Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination (APPSCCE) Rules, 2019.**

F. SCHEME AND SUBJECT FOR THE PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

(1) The Preliminary Examination will consist of two objective types as follows: -

Paper	Subject	Total Marks	Time	Remarks
Paper-I	General Studies	200	2 hours	Marks scored in this paper will be counted for qualifying for the mains examination.
Paper-II	Aptitude Test (CSAT)	200	2 hours	Candidates must score at least 33 % in this paper. This paper will be of qualifying in nature. Marks scored in this paper shall not be counted for qualifying for the mains exams.

NOTE: Syllabus for the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination notified vide dated 4th December, 2019 (ANNEXURE-2) and amendment vide Govt. Notification No. PERS-36/2/2022 dated 13th March, 2024 (ANNEXURE-3) is uploaded in the Syllabus section of the APPSC website.

(2) Each paper will be of two hours duration. But blind candidates and candidates with Locomotor Disability and Cerebral Palsy where dominant (writing) is extremely affected to the extent of slowing the performance of function (minimum 40% impairment) will be allowed an extra time of 20 minutes per hour for each paper.


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- (3) The question papers will be set in English. The standards of each subject are those of the Degree level course of any Indian University.
- (4) It is mandatory for the candidate to appear in both the papers of Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive (APPSCCE)-2026 Preliminary Examination for the purpose of evaluation. A candidate will be disqualified, in case he/she does not appear in both papers of APPSCCE Preliminary Examination.
- (5) The candidate should note that there will be penalty negative marking of $\frac{1}{3}$ for wrong answers marked by a candidate in the Objective Type question papers.

G. EXAMINATION DATE

The APPSCCE-2026 (Preliminary Examination) will be conducted on 6th December, 2026 (Sunday).

NOTE: The APPSC reserves the right to allocate or change the examination centre, if required at its discretion. No request for change of centre shall be entertained from the candidate by the APPSC.


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I. OTHER CRITERIA

- (1) All candidates in Government service, whether in a permanent or temporary capacity or as work charged employees, other than casual or daily rated employees or those serving under Public Enterprises/Banks and other such bodies, shall be required to state in the appropriate space of the application that they have informed in writing to their Employer/Controlling authority that they have applied to sit for the examination. Candidate should note that in-case communication is received from their Employer/Controlling authority by the Commission withholding permission to the candidate applying for appearing at the examination, their application shall be rejected and their candidature shall be cancelled.
- (2) Applicants in Government Service have to upload a copy of intimation submitted to their respective Heads of Department or NOC issued by the department at the time of filling the Detailed Application Form (DAF) on qualifying the Preliminary Stage.
- (3) No candidate shall be admitted to the Preliminary Examination unless he/she holds a certificate of admission (Admit Card) from the Commission for that purpose.
- (4) The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for admission to the examination shall be final and binding.
- (5) A candidate who indulges in any of the below mentioned unfair means during the examination or reported thereafter or has been declared by the Commission to be guilty of: -
 - (i) Obtaining support for his/her candidature by any unfair means, or
 - (ii) Impersonation, or
 - (iii) Procuring impersonation by any person, or
 - (iv) Submitted fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with, or
 - (v) Making false or incorrect statement or suppressing material fact or information, or
 - (vi) Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination, or
 - (vii) Using unfair means during the examination, or
 - (viii) Writing irrelevant matter, including obscene language or pornographic matter in the scripts, or
 - (ix) Misbehaving in any other manner in the Examination Hall, or
 - (x) Harassing or doing bodily harm to the Centre Superintendent/Invigilators/Staff employed by the Commission for the conduct of examination, or
 - (xi) Violating any of the instructions issued to the candidates along with their Admission Cards / Call Letters permitting them to take the examination, or commission or as the case may be attempting the commission of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clauses by a candidate may, in addition to rendering him/her liable to criminal prosecution, also render him/her liable: -
 - (a) To be disqualified by the Commission from the Examination for which he/she is a candidate, or
 - (b) To be debarred permanently or for a specified period: -
 1. by the Commission from any examination or selection held by them.
 2. by the State Government from any employment under them, and


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(c) If he/she is already in service under the Government, disciplinary action under the relevant rules shall be instituted.

(d) Provided that no penalty under these rules shall be imposed except after: -

1. Giving the candidate an opportunity of making such representation in writing as he wishes to make in that behalf, and
2. Taking the representation if any, submitted by the candidate within the period allowed to him into consideration.
3. Provided further that if any candidate found to have been debarred by any other Commission, the candidate shall stand so debarred for the purpose of this examination conducted by this Commission.

J. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS WITH REGARDS TO THE APPSCCE- 2026.

(1) Candidates must write the papers in their own hand.

(2) **Facility of a Scribe**

- (i) Only persons with Benchmark Disabilities in the categories of Blindness, Locomotor Disability (both arms affected – BA) and Cerebral Palsy will be permitted the facility of scribe, if so desired by the person.
- (ii) In case of other categories of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities, as defined under Section 2 (r) of the RPWD Act, 2016, the facility of scribe will be allowed to such candidates on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write and scribe is essential to write the examination on their behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution.
- (iii) Such candidates have discretion of opting for his/her own scribe or request the Commission for the same. The details of scribe i.e., whether own or the Commission's and the details of scribe in case candidates are bringing their own scribe, will be sought at the time of filling up the application form online. The qualification of the Commission's scribe or own scribe will not be more than the minimum qualification criteria or the examination. However, the qualification of the scribe should always be matriculate or above.

(3) **Compensatory Time**

- (i) Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in the category of Blindness, Locomotor Disability (Both arms affected – BA) and Cerebral Palsy will be allowed compensatory time of twenty minutes per hour of the examination. In case of other categories of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities, this facility will be provided on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution.

K. RESERVATION

- (1) The Govt. of A.P. policy of reservation in all Government jobs for APST candidates will be enforced.
- (2) The implementation of Reservation Policy for Persons with Disability will be in accordance with the requisition submitted by the Department of Personnel and roster maintained by the requisitioning/indenting Government Departments and also as per the Govt. Notification issued from time to time.
- (3) Person with Benchmark Disability (PwD) candidates should submit disability certificate issued by the certifying authority as per Section 57 of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, failing which, such candidates will be treated as normal candidate and shall not be entitled for any concession. In the Medical Board, the Specialist of the particular disabilities, for which certificate is sought, must be a member. Otherwise, the Disability Certificate will not be accepted.

L. EXAMINATION FEES

- (1) Candidates are required to pay fee of ₹ 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred) only through online mode.
- (2) PwD candidates are exempted from payment of application fee as per Section 19 of the Arunachal Pradesh Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018.

M. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

- (1) Online application is now invited for APPSCCE (Preliminary) only. Candidates who qualify in the APPSCCE (Preliminary) will be required to fill up a Detailed Application Form (DAF) again for the APPSCCE (Main Examination). The APPSC will issue a notification in this regard after declaration of the result of the APPSCCE (Preliminary Examination). However, candidates will not be required to pay any additional application fee for the same.
- (2) **Scanned copies of following documents and information are to be submitted with online application form for appscce-2026 (preliminary examination):**
 - a) Signature of the candidate on white paper with black ink pen (40-50 kb in jpg format).
 - b) Latest/Recent color passport size photo (40-100 kb in jpg format). The photograph is to be in white background, front faced and without headgear and sunglasses.
 - c) Self-Attested photocopy of Matriculation Certificate/Marksheet with Date of Birth mentioned issued by the Board for proof of age. **No other document shall be accepted as proof of Date of Birth.**
 - d) Self-Attested Photocopy of Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe (APST) certificate issued by Competent Authority of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, as per the list of tribes notified by the Government of India in the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950, as amended from time to time.
 - e) Self-Attested photocopy of Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) of Arunachal Pradesh issued by Competent Authority of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
 - f) The Government Employees of Arunachal Pradesh seeking relaxation in upper age limit must submit their self-attested photocopy of appointment order (not promotion order) as proof of continuous regular service of 3 (three) years in the same or allied cadre.


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- g) Person with Disability (PwD)/Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) candidates should submit disability certificate issued by the certifying authority as per Section 57 of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, failing which, such candidates shall not claim the reservation under PwBD category and shall not be entitled for any concession. In the Medical Board, the Medical Specialist of the particular disability, for which certificate is sought, must be a member. **The Disability Certificate must clearly mention the Percentage of Disability. The date of issuance of the Disability Certificate should be before the last date of submission of online application form.** Otherwise, the Disability Certificate will not be accepted for claiming reservation under PwBD category.
- h) Defence Service Personnel, belonging to APST, disabled in operations during hostility may submit the relevant document, if availing age relaxation.

LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION: 20th October, 2026 (1700 Hours)

NOTE:

- (1) The candidature of a candidate at any stage of the examination is provisional and subject to notification/direction/decision/order/pronouncement of the Government or any Court of Law. Mere issuance of Admit Card or appearance at the selection process does not entitle the candidate to any claim for the post.
- (2) Candidates falling under the Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) category with 40% and above percentage of disability must ensure compliance with the functional requirements prescribed for the post(s) for which the candidate intends to apply. The selection process will be as per the Right of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and Arunachal Pradesh Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018 as amended from time to time.
- (3) Eligible candidates will have to produce the above-mentioned (at Point M) Certificates/Documents and Mark Sheets in **ORIGINAL** at the time of interview. If a candidate is found not to be eligible during the document verification prior to the interview, his/her candidature shall be **REJECTED** and he/she shall not be allowed to appear in the interview.
- (4) The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate shall be final and no correspondence or personal enquiry will be entertained.
- (5) The candidate must note that the Appointing Authority, that is, the Indenting/ Requisitioning Department conducts the medical test and verifies the character and antecedents of the candidates, authenticity of all the documents/certificates, authenticity of the disability certificates and eligibility as per the Recruitment Rules before finally appointing the candidates. Therefore, the provisional recommendation of a candidate does not confer upon him/her any right to appointment unless the Appointing Authority is satisfied, after such inquiry as maybe considered necessary, that the candidate is suitable for the appointment to the post.
