#### G. RESERVATIONS, CONCESSIONS AND RELAXATIONS

- i) Reservation of posts for SC, ST, OBC (NCL), EWS and PwBD (Persons with Benchmarked Disabilities with degree of disability 40% or above) are as per Government Directives.
- ii) Candidates seeking reservation / relaxations as SC / ST / OBC (NCL) / EWS / PwBD will have to submit category certificate "ONLY in the Prescribed Proforma" meant for appointment to posts under the Government of India from the designated authority indicating clearly the candidate's caste, the Act / Order under which the category is recognized as SC/ST/ OBC (NCL) / EWS / PwBD. An application form without copy of valid certificates in prescribed format will be rejected.


