Online applications are invited from eligible Indian SPORTS PERSONS for filling up of 25 Posts (02 in Pay Level-5, 08 in Pay Level-2 & 15 in Pay Level-1) in the following disciplines against Sports Quota (Open Advertisement) for the year 2026-27 in BLW, Varanasi. **ONLY CANDIDATES HAVING THE REQUIRED SPORTS QUALIFICATION ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY.** There is no reservation for SC, ST, OBC, EWS, PH, and Ex-SM. Separate application is to be filled for separate discipline/game, if eligible, with separate examination fee as applicable for each application.

Note: No post is reserved for SC, ST, OBC & EWS. However, the candidates claiming to belong to SC/ST/OBC/EWS communities are required to enclose photocopy of Self Attested Caste Certificate/EWS Certificate in the format of central government issued by Competent

Authority i.e. not below the rank of Tehsildar. Otherwise no benefit will be given to them for their community in fee.

3. Minimum Sports & Educational Qualification: -

(A) Sports Norms/Qualification: The minimum norms for recruitment of sports quota shall be as under in addition to the qualifying performance/position. These provisions shall be read along with note given below of the para.

(B) Educational Qualification:

Candidates should possess requisite academic qualification while applying in response to the notification as given below. **Those who are appearing at and/or awaiting results of final examinations are not eligible:**

(4) NOTE:

(A) All the eligibility championship mentioned above in para 3 (A) should be conducted under the aegis of recognized International/National/State sports federation and also recognized by Railway Sports Promotion Board. Those Sports Federation which are not recognized or derecognized even after this notification, the certificate issued by them will not be considered for recruitment.

(B) In Volleyball, the sports achievement in the events conducted by Volleyball federation of India or its affiliated units after 25.06.2020, shall not be considered for recruitment. However, the certificates issued by the Association of Indian Universities and the International Federations for recognized sports achievement in the game of Volleyball, will be valid for the said purpose.

(C) In Handball, the participation and medal winning performances in the events organized by HAI (Handball Association India) or its affiliated units on or after 05.09.2023, will not be considered for recruitment. However, the certificates issued for the events conducted under the aegis of the Association of Indian Universities and recognized International Sports Federations in the game of Handball, will be considered valid for the said purpose.

(D) In Wrestling, Certificates of sports achievements issued for the events conducted by WFI of its affiliated units after 10.03.2025 shall be considered for recruitment.

(E) For recruitment of sportspersons on the basis of sports achievements in Junior National Championship, the age group as mentioned below, shall only be considered: -

All the recruitments against Open Advertisement Quota shall be at the minimum pay of the corresponding Level/scale of pay.

(5) Period of reckoning sports achievements:

Only those Sportspersons who have acquired the sports achievements - eligibility norms in the championship on or after 01/04/2024 and are active will be eligible to apply for appointment against Sports Quota. For validity of sports achievement, concluding day of the

championship/event shall be taken into account. Activeness in sports shall be adjudged as per his performance during the trials.

(6) Age Limit:

Minimum 18 years and maximum 25 years as on 01/01/2027. Candidates born between 01/01/2002 and 01/01/2009 (both days inclusive) should only apply. Candidates born on or before 31/12/2001 are not eligible. Similarly, candidates born on or after 02/01/2009 are also not eligible. (No relaxation in lower or upper age limit for any Community of candidate).

Note: -10th/Matriculation Certificate/Equivalent Educational Certificate/Educational Certificate mentioning date of birth are mandatory for D.O.B otherwise application will be rejected)

(7) Examination Fee:

For candidates belonging to SC, ST, Ex- Servicemen, Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD), Minorities and Economically Backward Classes	Rs. 250/-	Refund of Rs.250 will be made to the candidates who actually appear in the trial.
All other candidates	Rs. 500/-	Refund of Rs.400 will be made to the candidates who actually appear in the trial.

Note: - Candidates are advised to deposit the requisite fees for application from their own account number or their mother's/father's account number or from bank in favour of FA AND CAO, BANARAS LOCOMOTIVE WORKS, VARANASI, in Account No: 10852349060, IFSC Code SBIN0001868 of State Bank of India before the closing date. After depositing the examination fee, the candidates should login again to complete the application form. Candidate must take a printout of the application form. Candidate should keep the fees receipt for further recruitment process. Cheque, Draft & Postal Order will not be accepted.

* Minorities meaning Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains and Zoroastrians (Parsis). For claiming waiver of examination fee, Minorities candidates should submit 'self-declaration', as mentioned in Annexure-III, At the time of Trial/Document Verification, such candidate claiming waiver of examination fee will be required to furnish 'minority community declaration' affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper that candidate belongs to any of the above minority communities. **If 'self-declaration' as mentioned in Annexure-III not uploaded with online application or the affidavit is not produced during Trial/Document Verification, their candidature will be rejected.**

** Economically Backward Class (EBC) means those whose annual family income is less than Rs. 50,000/-. They have to submit income certificate at the time of applying in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-IV on the letter head of the competent issuing authority.

(8) SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- Selection will be based upon Screening of application, Document Verification, performance in Sports Trials and assessment of sports achievement & educational qualification etc.
- After scrutiny of applications short-listed eligible candidates will be called for Document Verification & Trial of sports performance. Candidates who will be found

suitable in Document Verification. Trials of those on candidates will be conducted by Trial Committee. Trial Committee will conduct trial to assess their sports performance and suitability for Railway/Unit team as well as Indian Railways team. Trial Committee shall give its recommendation in terms of either FIT or NOT FIT, for consideration for next stage, by giving marks as per the criteria given below: -

- iii. After Trial only the FIT Candidates in trial shall be considered for the next stage i.e. assessment of sports achievement & educational qualification by the Recruitment Committee.
- iv. Recruitment Committee shall award the marks (out of 60 marks) only to the FIT candidates for their sports achievements, educational qualifications etc. Candidates declared 'NOT FIT' will not be assessed further by the Recruitment Committee.
- v. Assessment of sports achievement & educational qualification of the FIT candidates shall invariably be held on the same day, just after trials or at the most, next day of the trials.
- vi. Recruitment Committee is to add the marks given by the Trial Committee to the FIT candidates (i.e., out of 40 marks), in order to make the final merit list (out of 100 marks.)
- vii. **Distribution of Marks:** Maximum marks which can be awarded by the Trial Committee for performance during Trial and Recruitment Committee during assessment of sports achievement & educational qualification, shall be as follows:

Note: The offer of appointment shall be given purely on the basis of merit. In case more than one sportsperson scores the same marks, preference should be given to younger candidate to decide the merit.

9. Medical Examination: Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass the requisite medical fitness standards prescribed for the post identified by the BLW Administration.

10. Period of Probation: All the candidates getting appointment will undergo probation period of Two years (02 years).

11. Selected candidates will have to submit "Service Bond" of 5 years at the time of appointment.

12. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. Recruitments of sports persons shall be dealt as per Government of India, Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) letter no. 2010/E (Sports)/4 (1)/1 (Policy) dated 31.12.2010 read with modifications/ amendments issued by the Railway Board from time to time.
- b. Merely Registering/filling up online application on BLW website does not entitle the candidate being eligible for selection process. Candidature of the candidate participating in the selection process is provisional at all stages.
- c. The decision of Railway Administration on all matters relating to eligibility, place, date, mode of selection, acceptance or rejection, recommendation of post, place of posting, grade etc. shall be final and binding on the candidates. No correspondence will be entertained in these regards. BLW Administration reserves the right to decide the number of sports persons to be selected for any individual/team game depending upon their requirement for that sports and availability of suitable candidates fulfilling the norms.
- d. No post is reserved for SC, ST, and OBC, However the candidates claiming to belong to SC/ST/OBC communities for Fee relaxation are required to upload copy of self-attested Caste Certificate issued by Competent Authority, failing which no Fee relaxation is permissible and any such candidate paying less fee than 500/- as applicable to General candidate shall be REJECTED.
- e. Sports person having sports norms of higher pay matrix and applied against the vacancies for the lower pay matrix will be considered for applied level only if found eligible otherwise.
- f. No TA/DA/Accommodation will be given for appearing in the selection trials/ assessment. Applicant will have to bring their own playing kit. They may also be required to stay during the selection for 4-5 days, for which they have to make their own arrangements. The BLW Administration reserves the right to fix any date, as deemed suitable, change of place or postpone trials/assessment (at its own convenience) or even cancel trials due to unforeseen circumstances against which no claim will be accepted.
- g. Candidate should be in readiness to appear for the Trials etc. at short notice after the last date for submission is over.
- h. Sports person recruited against sports quota shall be terminated from service, if the information and documents furnished by him/her for recruitment are found incorrect/ fake at any stage.
- i. Candidates who have been debarred for life from all RRB/RRC examinations or candidates who have been debarred for a specified period which is not yet completed need not apply in response to this employment notice. Their candidature will be rejected during any stage of recruitment as and when detected.
- j. Any subsequent changes in the terms and conditions of the Employment Notice as per extant rules will stand good. BLW reserves the right to consider/ incorporate any

subsequent changes/ modification/additions/cancellation in the terms & conditions of recruitment under this Employment Notice as and when applicable.

- k. Candidates selected through Sports quota will have to perform in his/her field of sports for a minimum period of 5 years. His/her performance will be assessed during first two years of service (Probation period). In case performance is not found up to the mark his/her service is liable to be terminated.
- l. BLW reserves the right to reject the candidature of any applicant at any stage of the process of recruitment, if any irregularity/ deficiency is noticed in the application/candidature.
- m. if any discrepancy exists between the notification and Government of India, Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) instructions, Government of India, Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) instructions shall prevail.
- n. The Railway Administration reserves the right to cancel/ postpone / keep in abeyance the recruitment process at any stage without assigning any reason.
- o. Candidates who have been debarred from NADA/other authorised agencies for a specified period which is not yet completed need not apply in response to this employment notice. Their candidature will be rejected during any stage of recruitment as and when detected.
- p. For any Legal dispute, the Jurisdiction will be CAT/Allahabad only.
- q. In the event of any dispute about interpretation or any mistake, the English version will be treated as final.
- r. Canvassing in any form, misbehaviour of misconduct will lead to summary rejection and cancellation of candidature and no correspondence will be entertained in this matter.
- s.
