Place of Research Fellowship: Centre for Airborne System(CABS), DRDO, Ministry of Defence, Belur, Yemlur PO, Bengaluru-560037.

Tenure: Initially the offer shall be for a period of two years which may be extended for further two years period (one year at a time) subject to satisfactory performance to be assessed by Review Committee.

Stipend: Monthly emoluments of Rs. 37,000/- pm plus House Rent Allowance(HRA) as admissible.

Education Qualification: BE/B. Tech in above disciplines first division with valid GATE score. Only GATE scores of 2024 & GATE score of 2025 are acceptable.

Or

ME/M.Tech in above disciplines in first division both at Graduate & Post-graduate level.

Upper Age Limit: 28 years as on 31 Dec 2025. 5 years relaxation to SC/ST candidates, 3 years to OBC (Non-creamy Layer) candidates. Caste certificate copy to be enclosed with application, if applicable.

Nationality: Only Indian National to apply

Application procedure:

Application form can be downloaded from website www.drdo.gov.in. Eligible candidates who are willing to attend the walk-in-interview are advised to send their willingness by email at [jrf.rectt.cabs\[at\]gov.in](mailto:jrf.rectt.cabs[at]gov.in) latest by **22nd Feb 2026**. The subject field of the email must contain "Application for the post of Junior Research Fellowship- Discipline".

Interview Guidelines:

1. Desirous candidates appearing for walk-in-interview are required to report at Centre for Airborne System(CABS), DRDO, Ministry of Defence, Belur, Yemlur PO, Bengaluru-560037 by 08:45 hrs as per following schedule:
 - i) Applications will be accepted starting from 0900 hrs to 1000 hrs on the date mentioned above. Candidates arriving late will not be allowed to participate in walk-in-interview process.
 - ii) Initial screening and verification of testimonials will be done between 1000-1100 hrs on the above date of interview
 - iii) Interview of the screened shortlisted candidates will take place from 1100 hrs onwards
2. In case large number of candidates appear interview can/will be conducted the next day. Therefore, candidates are requested to prepare/make arrangement accordingly.
3. Candidates are required to produce the duly filled application form, as per the format provided, along with attested copies of certificates/testimonials w.r.t qualification, experience and caste at the time of walk-in-interview. It is also required to affix recent passport size photograph on the right top corner of the first page of the application. (If any documents/certificate furnished are in a language other than English, a duly self-attested transcript in English of the same to be attached)
4. Incomplete application will be rejected during the screening for eligibility.

5. While appearing for interview, candidates are required to produce all certificates/testimonials **IN ORIGINAL** for verification
6. Candidate presently employed in Government department/PSUs/Autonomous bodies will be required to produce No-Objection-Certificate from the employer at the time of interview.
7. Candidate should bring Govt. issued Photo ID Proof such as Aadhar Card/PAN card/Passport etc in original.
8. Electronic items like Mobile Phone/Pen drive/laptop/smart watch etc., will not be allowed inside CABS campus.

General Condition

1. CABS, Bengaluru reserve the right to amend/modify/cancel this advertisement and also to cancel the admission/selection at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
2. Antecedents of selected candidates will be verified at the time of joining. In case deficiency of any type in the documents, the candidature would automatically stand cancelled.
3. A Panel for the vacancies available and future anticipated vacancies will be drawn based on the order of merit. The panel will operate for a period of one year. However, the mere fact of empanelment will not entitle any candidate to an offer of Fellowship, which is contingent upon occurrence of vacancies during the year. 4. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview/joining, irrespective of the selection.
5. The decision of the committee constituted by Director, CABS in selecting the candidates will be final and binding on all the candidates.
