- II. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the interview.
- III. Eligible & interested candidates will be required to be present at least 30 minutes before scheduled time on the date of interview for completing necessary formalities.
- IV. The positions are purely temporary and will be filled on purely contractual basis initially for a period of one year or co-terminus with the project or as per actual need, whichever is earlier. However, duration of engagement can be curtailed/extended as per need and subject to performance of the candidate.
- V. The engagement will not constitute a regular job or appointment of any nature in the ICAR/CIRB.
