THE YEAR 2021 : NOTIFICATION : REG.**

It is proposed to invite applications from eligible departmental candidates for filling up of **647 vacancies (UR- 502, SC- 97 and ST- 48)** of Asstt. Sub Inspector (Executive) in CISF through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) against the recruitment year 2021. **However, vacancies may increase/decrease at the time of final selection.**

2. **Only Head Constable/GD, Constable/GD and Constable/Tradesmen who have completed 5 years regular service including the period of basic training in the grade or five years combined regular service as Head Constable/GD, Constable/GD and Constable/Tradesmen, as on 01.08.2021 (i.e., those who have been appointed in the Force on or before 31.07.2016) are eligible to participate in this Limited Departmental Competitive Examination** and they may submit the following documents through proper channel to their respective DIsG (Application Receiving Centres) as mentioned in para No.3 below provided they fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Para-6 below.

- Certificate of Unit Commander as per **Appendix-A1**.
- No Criminal/DE/Vigilance including Sexual Harassment clearance Certificate as per **Appendix-B**.

4. Applications of eligible candidates who are posted in the units under the administrative control of DIsG Plant or DIsG DAE or DOS or Airports or BNs or GBS or SSG or HQRs or in Training Institutions will be forwarded directly to the respective **Zonal DIsG (Application Receiving Centres)** mentioned in Para-3 above by the respective Unit Commanders instead of routing the same through their Zonal DIsG. *For example, applications in respect of personnel posted in BARC Mumbai, VSSC Thumba and ASG Amritsar will be forwarded directly by the respective Unit Commanders to DIG/MZ Mumbai, DIG/SZ-1 Chennai and DIG/NZ-1 New Delhi respectively instead of routing the same through DIG/DAE, DIG/DOS and DIG/APNZ.* **Units/Bns/Offices under APS North Zone-1 will forward the applications of eligible candidates of their units/Bns/Offices to DIG/NZ-1 New Delhi. Applications in respect of eligible departmental candidates posted in FHQRs will be forwarded to DIG/NZ-I, New Delhi (ARC) through HQRs Estt Branch.** The respective Branch will forward applications of personnel attached with this Directorate, to their respective units from where the same will be forwarded to **DIG/NZ-I, New Delhi (ARC)** after verifying the service particulars of the candidate. **No application will be sent to Recruitment Branch. Unit Commander should ensure that the personnel on Election duty, temporary duty, attachment duty etc should be informed well in time. Forwarding of applications submitted by the individuals is the duty of concerned Unit Commanders.**

5. Applications duly completed, in respect of CISF personnel who are on deputation to outside organizations will be submitted through proper channel to the nearest Zonal DIsG (ARCs) under intimation to their parent unit. For example, a person is on deputation to SPG New Delhi from CISF Unit DSP Durgapur, he will submit his application to SPG who in turn will forward the same directly to DIG/NZ-I, New Delhi (ARC) under intimation to DIG DSP Durgapur. **Further, personnel who are on deputation to outside organizations at Delhi/NCR will submit their application through proper channel to the DIG/NZ-1 New Delhi under intimation to their parent unit.**

7. SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection will consist of the following: -

i)	Stage-I	Checking of service records.	No marks are allotted. However, it should be ensured that candidates must have "Good" or above (i.e. marks 4 & above) for the last 05 years and unblemished service record till joining the post of ASI/Exe (LDCE) on appointment.

(vi) **Final Selection**

Name of candidates will be placed in the merit list subject to the obtaining minimum qualifying marks in each subject as well as the aggregate marks (minimum 50% aggregate marks out of a total of 200 marks to General category i.e. 100 marks and candidate belonging to SC/ST category have secured minimum 45% aggregate marks i.e., 90 marks). **Final selection of candidates will be made according to availability of vacancies and subject to their being declared 'FIT' in the Detailed Medical Examination or Review medical examination as the case may be.**

8. **LAST DATE OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION**

All eligible departmental candidates may submit their application as per Appendix-A along with Appendix-B, B-1 & B-2 duly filled to their respective Unit Commanders by **05.02.2022** i.e., last date for receipt of applications by the Unit Commanders. **All received applications should be counter signed by a GO of the unit after verification of bio-data of the individual from service records.** All applications should be forwarded to concerned DIG duly signed by the Unit Commander in prescribed format as per **Appendix-A-1**. Last date of receipt of the above applications by the respective DIsG (Application Receiving Centre) as mentioned in Para-3 above shall be **12.02.2022**. The Unit Commanders while forwarding the applications will ensure that the following documents are duly attested by a Gazetted Officer:

- Certificate in support of belonging to SC/ST & Hill areas on the format as prescribed in Appendix "C" & "D" circulated vide this Directorate letter No.E-32017/3/06/Rectt/934 dated 25.05.2006.
- Matriculation certificate in support of date of birth
- Graduation degree certificate from recognized University in support of educational qualification.

Note: If there is any change/amendment in the eligibility condition, the same will be published on CISF website. Candidates may check the same from the website or from the Office of Sector IsG/Zonal DIsG. Mere submission of the application does not give the candidate right to be considered unless he meets the eligibility requirements prescribed at the time of issue of admit cards.

Applications received after 05.02.2022 i.e the last date of receipt of application in the concerned unit will not be accepted and summarily be rejected.

10. **RESPONSIBILITY OF THE UNIT COMMANDERS**

Unit Commanders will personally ensure that:-


- a) A copy of this notification is circulated to all Coy Commanders and is also affixed on the notice board and contents of the notification are also brought to the notice of all eligible personnel.
- b) **Unit Commander should ensure that the personnel on Election duty, Temporary duty, attachment etc should be informed well in time. Forwarding of applications submitted by the individuals is the responsibility of concerned unit Commanders.**
- c) It should be ensured that applications in respect of all eligible personnel of the unit have been obtained in the prescribed format and forwarded to the **concerned Zonal DisG (ARCs) (i.e., DIG(NZ-1) New Delhi, DIG(SZ-1) Chennai, DIG(WZ) Mumbai, DIG-RRC ES Ranchi, DIG(SEZ-1) Kolkata, DIG (NCR) New Delhi, DIG (CZ) Bhilai and DIG (NEZ) Guwahati as the case may be) so as to reach them on or before 12.02.2022.**
- d) Latest colour passport size photograph duly dated (i.e. not more than three months old from the date of publication of this Notification) of the candidate in uniform without cap should be affixed on the right corner of the application form for the post of ASI/Exe (LDCE)-2021 i.e., Appendix-A.
- e) It should be ensured that application form is filled correctly and the candidate is fulfilling the eligibility criteria as prescribed in Para-2 and 6 above. Particulars filled in the application form should be verified from the record held in the unit and the same may be countersigned by a GO of the Unit. There should not be any column left without verification, which may lead to complications at a later stage.
- f) It should be ensured that applications are accompanied with Photostat copies of required certificates, duly attested.



- g) It should be ensured that all columns meant for the candidates vide **Appendix-A, B, B-1 & B-2** are filled by the candidates and countersigned by a GO of the unit at appropriate place before the same is forwarded to the DIsG.
- h) An application with incomplete / wrong / false information / misrepresentation of facts / left unsigned / without a self-attested photograph pasted at the appropriate place shall be summarily rejected.
- i) Eligible personnel of the unit may be informed that **only three chances** are available for appearing in the LDCE.
- j) Service documents of the individuals, whose applications are sent to the application receiving authority, may be updated including **Annual Remarks up to 31.12.2021 and SHAPE- I certificate for the year 2021** and sent to DIG, CISF Unit, SSG, Noida (UP) by 20.02.2022, who will hand over the same to the recruitment board.
- k) In case any candidate who is having clean record of service as on the date of submission of application, is awarded any major or minor punishment subsequently in between the date of submission of application and the date of joining to the post of ASI/Exe(LDCE), his/her candidature will be rejected forthwith.
- l) **It will be the responsibility of the Unit Commander** not to forward any application of candidate who have not maintained 'Good' ACRs for the last five years and who have been awarded any major or minor punishment(s) during his/her entire service till the date of forwarding his/her application. Further, in case, a candidate is awarded any major or minor punishment after submission of his/her application, it will be the responsibility of the concerned Unit Commander to inform the facts to the application receiving Zonal DIsG (ARCs) and to not relieve such candidate for attending the Written Exam/PST/PET/Medical whenever he/she is called for the same. Information to this affect may also be sent to this Dte. The Zonal DIsG (ARCs) concerned will dispose of such cases at their end as per instructions issued in this Notification at Para-6(d) and Para-10(k).
- m) In case any candidate who is holding the post in Executive cadre on the date of submission of application and subsequently accepts appointment to any other cadre of the Force viz., Fire or Ministerial, etc., he will become ineligible to compete in this LDCE and his candidature will be rejected.
- n) *The applications of the candidates, who have availed 03 chances including 2019 & 2020 recruitment, need not to be forwarded for 2021 recruitment.*

11. **ACTION TO BE TAKEN BY THE ZONAL DIsG (ARCs)**

Immediately on receipt of an application, it will be checked thoroughly and it must be ensured that the candidate fulfills the prescribed eligibility criteria as mentioned above. Number of applications found in order and accepted will be intimated to this Directorate as well as to DIG/CISF SSG Noida latest by 20.02.2022, so that the concerned DIsG may be able to issue call up letters in consultation with EDP Cell, FHQr to the candidates accordingly.



- a) A register will be maintained in the following proforma and each application will be recorded therein immediately on receipt at the Zonal HQrs (ARCs): -

Note: All the columns will be filled up by Zonal DIsG (ARCs) Receipt Branch except columns 8 & 9 which will be filled by the officer who will endorse his signature in column 11 after scrutiny of applications. Roll No. under column 10 will be written by the person who has been authorized to allot the same to the eligible candidates.


- b) *The Roll Number which will be allotted to the candidates will be of 5 digits. The first digit will indicate the Zone and the rest of the four digits will be allotted in alphabetical order of names of the candidates to those applications which have been found in order and accepted. The Zonal Code (ARCs) is indicated as:- NZ(1)-1, WZ-2, SZ(1)-3, RRC/ES-4, SEZ(1)-5, NCR Z-6, CZ-7 and NEZ-8.*
- c) The roll number so allotted to the candidates will be recorded in their respective application forms at the space provided for the same as well as in the register under column 10.
- d) In case SC/ST certificate enclosed by the candidates with their applications are not found with all the Constitutional amendments, as mentioned in the format, it may be accepted, provided that rest of the format of the certificate is same as per format and one of the Constitutional amendments (which is applicable) is mentioned therein.
- e) On receipt of applications the particulars of the candidates for the above post should be entered online according to the requirement of the Software. For this task, personnel having experience may be deputed. The applications should be processed on a day to day basis on its receipt. The data entry should be completed **by 15.02.2022 repeat by 15.02.2022** positively. If needed, additional manpower may be deployed to complete the task within stipulated time.
- f) Apart from sending of admit card through speed post, this time admit cards of the candidates will also be uploaded on CISF website at each stage of recruitment. The candidates will bring the same to the recruitment centres duly affixing photograph at the space provided. The signature of the candidates will be obtained in presence of board member while reporting at recruitment centre. All Zonal DIsG/ARCs will allot roll number and upload Admit cards of all eligible candidates in consultation with EDP Cell, FHQ on receipt of instruction from this Directorate regarding recruitment centres.
- g) *The ARCs/Zonal DIsG shall issue Roll No. & issue Call up letters/admit card to the candidates whose applications are accepted as per alphabetical order of names of the candidates instead of unit wise to prevent malpractice during the written examination.
