MedicalStandards:

 - iii. Who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment.

 b) Whohasbeenreleasedfromsuchserviceafter completingthespecificperiod of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity;andincludespersonneloftheTerritorialArmy,namely,pension holdersforcontinuousembodiedservicesorbrokenspellsofqualifying service;

Or

c) PersonneloftheArmyPostalServiceswho arepartofRegularArmyand retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent servicewithpension,orarereleasedfromtheArmyPostalServiceonmedical groundsattributabletooraggravatedbymilitaryserviceorcircumstance beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension;

Or

 d) Personnel who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April'1987;

Or

e) Gallantry award winners of the Armed Forces including personnel of TerritorialArmy;

Or

f) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.

Age : They shall be allowed to deduct the period of military service from their actualage and the resultant age should not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for these posts by more than 3 years.

Theothereligibilityconditionswillbethesameasapplicabletoothersasmentioned under eligibility criteria.

Note – 1: Ex-Serviceman who has already secured employment in civil side under Central Government in Group "C" & "D" post on regular basis after availing of the benefits of reservation given to Ex-Serviceman for their re-employment are **NOT**eligibleforfeeconcession.However,hecanavailthebenefitofreservationasESM forsubsequentemploymentifheimmediatelyafterjoiningcivilemployment, has given selfdeclaration/undertaking to the concerned employer about the date-wise detailsofapplicationsforvariousvacanciesforwhichhehadappliedbeforejoining theinitialcivilemploymentasmentionedintheOMNo.36034/1/2014-Estt(Res) dated 14.08.2014 issued by DoP&T.

Note – 2 : The period of "Call up Service" of an Ex-Serviceman in the Armed Forces shall also be treated as service rendered in the Armed Forces for purpose of age relaxation.

Note-3:ForanyservicemanofthethreeArmedForcesoftheUniontobetreated as Ex-Serviceman for the purpose of securing the benefits of reservation, must have alreadyacquired,attherelevanttimeofsubmittinghisapplicationforthe Post/Service, the status of Ex-Serviceman is in a position to establish his acquired entitlement by documentary evidence from the competent authority that he would complete specified term of engagement with the Armed Forces within the stipulated period of one year from the date of closing of receipt of online Application Form. **i.e. 04/03/2025**

Note – 4 : Age concession is not admissible to sons, Daughters and dependents of ESM.Therefore, such candidates should not indicate their category as ESM.

Note – 5: Other terms and condition for re-employment of ESM as mentioned in Ex-Servicemen (Re-employment in Central Civil Service and Posts) amendment Rules, 2012andanyotherinstructionissuedbyGOlfromtimetotime, willalsobe applicable.

Note – 6 : No Physical Efficiency Test will be held for ESM at the time of their recruitment in CISF. However, ESM will be required to appear at the time of PET/PST for recording their physical standards, documentation and produce their education certificateandothertestimonials. They will also appear and qualify intradetest,

written test & medical examination. ESM will be required to qualify in medical examination as mentioned at Para-5.6 above.

Note – 7: The persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement fromservice, would comeunder the category of "Ex-Servicemen" may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified terms of engagementand availthemselves of all concessions available to ESM but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform (i.e. Armed Force of the Union) until they complete the specified term of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union. Such candidates should submit a certificate from the Commanding Officer concerned as per **Appendix – 'G'**.

7 ProcessofCertificationandFormatofCertificate:

Candidates who wish to be considered against vacancies reserved/or seek agerelaxationare requiredtosubmitrequisite certificate from the competentauthority in the prescribed format, failing which their claim for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/ESM status will not be entertained and their candidature/applications will be rejected. The formats of the certificates are annexed with this notification.

A person seeking appointmenton thebasis of reservation to OBCs must ensure thathe possess the caste/community certificate and does not fall in creamy layer on the crucial cut-off date i.e. closing date of receiptof online Application Form.

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Incomeand Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The crucial cut-off date for submitting income and asset certificate will be the closing date for receipt of online Application Form i.e. 04/03/2025.

Candidates may also note that in respect of the above, their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified by the Appointing Authority.Candidatesarecautionedthattheircandidaturewillbecancelledforthwith in case they fraudulently claim SC/ST/OBC/EWS status or avail any other benefit. Candidates are also warned that they will be permanently debarred from the examination in case they fraudulently claim SC/ST/OBC/EWS/ESM status.

WestPakistaniRefugees(WPRs)whohavesettledinJ&Kbuthave notbeengiven the status of citizens of the State will be recruited without the condition of having a domicile certificate from the designated authority of the J&K State.
