Ref: - 1. Rc.No. 86/MHN/Midwifery-II/2017, Dated: 02/12/2020 of the Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare, & Mission Director, (NHM) Telangana,

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It is to Submit that, the Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare, & Mission Director, (NHM) Telangana has issued a letter and informed that, one batch comprising of 30 midwives have already been trained and posted in the facilities with high delivery load and C-section rate and informed that, training of two batches with 56 members in Nurse Practitioner Midwifery (NPM) has commenced from 15.09.2020 for the financial year 2020-21 covering certain remote and tribal areas in order to saturate the coverage of the rural, remote tribal areas and uncovered areas with trained midwives, the Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare, & Mission Director, (NHM) Telangana decided to conduct Nurse Practitioner Midwifery Diploma (NPM) Course from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2021 onwards.

In this connection, the Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare, & Mission Director, (NHM) Telangana has instructed to the District Medical and Health Officer, Jayashankar Bhupalpally to identify & recruit eligible candidates with GNM/BSc (Nursing) from open market through paper notification in their respective district as per table below for the 18 months NPM training course at (Application with terms of reference is enclosed at Annexure-A) and as per the guidelines is enclosed here with.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- . Minimum educational recruitment: GNM or BSC Nursing degree (Please provided proof with a copy of the degree certificate with application submission)
- . Active Nursing registration (please provide proof)
- . Candidates should be below 38 years of age.
- . At least 2 years of labor room experience (preference)
- . Willingness to shift to Hyderabad during the training period and to the training facilities anywhere in the state.

Further it is to submit that in pursuance orders issued through the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Commissioner of Health and Family Welfare & Mission Director, NHM, Telangana, Hyderabad has permitted to the District Health societies to recruit eligible candidates for Nurse Practitioner Midwifery (NPM) residential training course for 18 months through the District Selection Committee.

**Selection will be done based on the following criteria:**

- a. Total marks are 100 of which 80% of marks will be awarded basing on the marks obtained in qualifying examination and 20 marks will be awarded for experience and interview.
  - b. Merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained with above criteria and displayed on website/notice board for transparency.
  - c. Selection list will be prepared from the finalized merit list duly following the rule of reservation and presidential order.
