SELECTION ON NON-TEACHING POSTS (STAFF NURSE) THROUGH COMPUTER BASED TEST (CBT) EXAMINATION- 2026 Direct Recruitment

The Government Institute of Medical Sciences Greater Noida is an autonomous Institute under the Uttar Pradesh State Government, established on the lines of S.G.P.G.I. Lucknow, and invites applications for direct recruitment to the Non-Teaching Posts for (Staff Nurse). Online applications are invited from citizens of India for the post of Staff Nurse advertised vide Advertisement No. GIMS/2026/Manpower/NT-03/10 of GIMS dated 09.08.2026 under the Computer Based Test (CBT) Examination- 2026. The category-wise details are given in Table-01.

The online application form window is open from **10.08.2026** on the Institute's website www.gims.ac.in and the last date of the application will be **07.09.2026**. Candidate can also amend their application form before final submission except his/her registered mobile no., e-mail id, Adhar no. and category. Candidates are advised to visit website www.gims.ac.in for periodic updates.

Special Note: The last date for application and fee submission relative to the above advertisement will be available on the Institute's website as per the examination schedule. Applications/fees will not be accepted after the provided date. The applicant will not be able to take a printout of his application until the fee is deposited by him.

Only the Online Application System is applicable for applying under the above mentioned advertisement. Applications sent through any other medium will not be accepted.

Candidates should read the said advertisement carefully and understand well that they possess the desired qualification/qualifications for the advertised posts and come within the prescribed age limit for the post. Only after that, start the process of filling the application form.

Process of filling the application form-The process of filling the application form is divided into the following five parts:

- Candidate Registration
- Filling up of details of the form
- Uploading photo, signatures and other documents
- Payment of Fees and Application Form Submission
- Printout of Application form

Note: The candidate can complete all the above mentioned procedures at once for filling the application form

Horizontal Reservation:

- The Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Physically Handicapped, Dependents of Freedom Fighters, and Ex-Servicemen) Act, 1993 dated 30.12.1993, (Amendment) Act 2018 dated 01.09.2018, and Amendment Act 2021 Notification No. 450(2)/LXXIX-1-21-ka-12-21 Lucknow dated 10.03.2021, along with Government Order No. 15/5/1986-ka-2/92 dated 28.04.1992 Personnel Section-2, will be applicable to the reservation of other categories (i.e., horizontal) and will apply only to the identified posts.
- Reservation for Ex-Servicemen and Dependents of Freedom Fighters: Reservation for Dependents of Freedom Fighters (DFF) and Ex-Servicemen will be permissible as per the provisions of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Physically Handicapped, Dependents of Freedom Fighters, and Ex-Servicemen) Act, 1993 (as amended) and the latest relevant rules/government orders.

2. Educational and Experience Qualifications: For recruitment to all the vacant posts mentioned in the above Table-1, it is essential for the candidate to possess the mandatory qualifications (educational and others) and preferential qualifications by the last date of application.

Educational Qualification:

- (i) B.Sc Nursing (4 years course) from an Indian Nursing Council / State Medical Faculty recognized Institute or University or B.Sc. Nursing (Post Basic) (2 Years Course) from an Indian Nursing Council recognized institute/university.
- (ii) Registered as Nurse & Midwife in State/Indian Nursing Council

OR

- (i) Diploma in General Nursing Midwifery (G.N.M) from an Indian Nursing Council recognized Institute/ Board or Council

- (ii) Registered as Nurse & Midwife in State/ Indian Nursing Council.
- (iii) Two Years experience in a minimum 50 bedded hospital after acquiring the educational qualification mentioned above.

3. Relaxation in Age Limit:

- The decisive date of age calculation for recruitment to all the posts mentioned in the above table is 1st July. Candidate has to have attained the age of 21 years and should not be more than 40 years age.
- For SC, ST, and OBC candidates of Uttar Pradesh, a maximum relaxation up to a period of **05 years** will be permissible as per the relevant government orders of the U.P. Government.
- In the case of permanent employees of the U.P. Government who have rendered at least **03 years** of regular and continuous service in the relevant field, a relaxation of up to a maximum of **05 years** can be given as per GOs of Govt. of UP, Karmik Anubhag. 4 Ref No- 2-E.M./2001-Ka-42013 dated 27.08.2013.
- Persons dismissed by the Union Government or any State Government will not be eligible for appointment to any post in the service.
- As per Government Order No. 18/1/2008(II)/ka-2 dated 03 February 2008, a relaxation of **15 years** in the maximum age limit will be permissible to persons with disabilities.
- For ex-servicemen, a relaxation of **03 years** in the maximum age limit will be permissible with the condition that after deducting their total service period from their actual age, the resulting remaining age should not be more than 03 years over the prescribed age. It is mandatory to be discharged from the Army by the last date of application. However, he should have rendered satisfactory approved military service in any wing of army, navy or air forces and he should be otherwise eligible for the post.

4. **Certificates:** Candidates seeking the benefit of reservation/age relaxation must obtain the caste certificate/reservation related certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format in **Appendix-1 to 5** of this detailed advertisement and should be available on the relevant website for online verification, issued by the last date of application.

For SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates, the caste certificate should be issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by the U.P. Government. EWS candidates must have a certificate issued by the competent authority. If any candidate fails to present a valid EWS certificate, he/she will be considered a General (UR) category candidate. Only permanent residents (**Domicile**) of Uttar Pradesh will be eligible to apply for reserved posts (both horizontal and vertical reservation).

5. Reservation:

- The OBC & EWS certificate must have been issued on or after 1st April 2026 and must be valid on the last date of submission of the online application.

- Reservation for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes of citizens shall be permissible in accordance with the Act-1994 (as amended), the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections) Act-2020, and the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Physically Handicapped, Dependents of Freedom Fighters, and Ex-Servicemen) Act, 1993 (as amended). **The benefit of reservation will be permissible only to the residents (Domicile) of Uttar Pradesh.**
- Reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS):
 - Under the present advertisement, such Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates who are not covered under the existing reservation system for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes, and are original residents of the State of Uttar Pradesh, and fall under the arrangement and prescribed standards defined in the Office Memorandum No. 1/2019/4/1/2002/ka-2/19 T.C.-II dated 18 February 2019 of the Personnel Section-2, Government of Uttar Pradesh, and fulfill the prescribed conditions, will be allowed 10 percent reservation on the advertised posts..
 - Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates who claim 10 percent reservation must compulsorily present the income and asset certificate of the family issued/certified by an officer not below the rank of Tehsildar of the concerned area, in accordance with the arrangement prescribed in the Office Memorandum dated 18 February 2019. This certificate must have been issued by the last date of application.

6. Application Fee:

The amount of non-refundable fee to be paid for applying against each post is as follows:

Candidates belonging to other categories (horizontal reservation) will have to pay the fee according to their basic category.

7. Recruitment Process:

- For conducting the competitive examination at Staff Nurse, an examination body will be determined as per the orders of the Chairman. To appear in the said competitive examination, applications will be invited by the designated examination body (Examining Body) in the format published in the advertisement issued by it.
- No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination unless they possess an admit card issued by the designated examination body (Examining Body).

- For the selection of candidates, the examination conducted by the designated examination body (Examining Body) will be of an objective type, containing questions related to nursing. Out of these questions, 80% will be based on theoretical knowledge and 20% on practical knowledge.
 - As per Rule 6, the designated examination body (Examining Body), keeping in view the need to ensure proper representation of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and other categories, will prepare a list of candidates in order of merit based on the marks obtained by them and will recommend as many candidates as deemed appropriate for appointment. In case two or more candidates obtain equal marks, the older candidate will be placed higher in the list. The designated examination body (Examining Body) will forward the list to the appointing authority.
 - The final process of selection will be based on-
 - i. Merit in CBT
 - ii. Biometric & Document verification from concerned authorities.
 - iii. Medical Examination
- 8. Negative Marking:** There is a provision for negative marking in the CBT for every wrong answer. For each wrong answer, 1/4 (one-fourth) of the total marks prescribed for that question will be deducted. If a question is not solved or left unanswered by the candidate, there will be no negative marking for it. Candidates are advised to answer questions only when they are fully confident.
- 9. Settlement of tie in case of equal marks:**
- Date of birth of candidates with equal marks (the older candidate will be given higher priority).
- 11. Syllabus:** Detailed syllabus for all advertised posts is available in **Appendix-6** below.
- 12. Mark for Review:** During the CBT, the "Mark for Review" option will be available to revisit a question. Candidates can review any question only within the prescribed time of that active section. Review will not be possible after the section is submitted.
- **Unanswered and Marked for Review:** If a candidate has marked a question for review without answering it, that question will not be evaluated when the section time expires and will be considered unanswered.
 - **Answered and Marked for Review:** If a candidate has answered a question and also marked it for review, it will be considered the candidate's final answer and evaluated when the section time expires. Marks will be given for correct answers and negative marking will apply for wrong answers.
- 13.** The examination schedule, city of examination (**Appendix-7**), and other recruitment information will be uploaded separately on the Institute's website **www.gims.ac.in**.
- 14. General Instructions:**
1. Candidates must fulfill all necessary eligibility criteria, educational qualifications, experience, age limit, etc as per appended guidelines.

2. Online registration and fee submission process will be published on the website. Candidates are advised to check **www.gims.ac.in** periodically for the detailed schedule; no correspondence will be made by the Institute.
3. All reserved category candidates of U.P. must mention their category in the application.
4. Only the date of birth recorded in the High School or equivalent certificate will be valid.
5. Ex-servicemen and dependent of freedom fighter must submit their claim on the prescribed format issued by the competent authority.
6. Male candidates who are married and have more than one living wife, or female candidates who have married a man who already has a living wife, will not be considered eligible unless exempted by the Governor.
7. The Institute's decision regarding the eligibility/ineligibility of the candidate will be final.
8. Selected women, dependents of U.P. freedom fighters, and ex-servicemen will be placed, as per existing rules, in the categories to which they belong.
9. Benefit of reservation will not be permissible to SC, ST, OBC, DFF, Women, and Ex-servicemen who are not original residents of Uttar Pradesh; such candidates will be considered as Unreserved (UR) category. In the case of female candidates, only the certificate issued from the father's side will be valid.
10. The number of unreserved and reserved vacancies can be changed as per U.P. Government reservation acts/orders.
11. Before applying, candidates should ensure that they fulfill the prescribed essential qualifications (educational and experience) and other conditions for the vacant posts, and that they fall within the prescribed age limit.
12. The number of vacancies mentioned in the advertisement may increase or decrease.
13. No need to send printed/hard copies of the application or documents by post. However, applicants must keep a printed/hard copy with them.
14. **Correction in Application:** Candidates can modify their application **only once** after final submission.
15. Candidates will have to give their preferences from the list of written examination centers where the exam is to be conducted (list of cities attached). The exact/allotted center will be provided at the time of issuing the Hall Ticket. In case of non-availability of slots at the preferred choices of examination centers, the nearest other cities will be allotted. In this regard, the decision of the Institute (GIMS, Greater Noida) shall be final.
16. The exam paper will be available in both Hindi and English language.
17. Applicants in regular service must present a **"No Objection Certificate (NOC)"** from their employers.

18. Candidates can download their Hall Ticket from the Institute's website www.gims.ac.in. Hall Tickets will not be sent by post. Candidates must appear for the examination only at the allotted examination center. No change in the examination center will be allowed under any circumstances.
19. No TA/DA will be admissible for attending the written test/Document Verification.
20. All disputes/differences or lawsuits will be under the jurisdiction of **Gautam Buddha Nagar** only.
21. The candidate must fulfill all the prescribed eligibility criteria by the last date of application. In case of failing to meet the eligibility criteria, or if false information is provided or facts are hidden, the candidate themselves will be held responsible. The appointing authority of the Institute reserves the right to cancel the candidate's eligibility at any stage in such cases.
22. The Institute will grant provisional admission to the candidates for the Computer Based Test (CBT) examination based on the information provided by them. However, **if at any later stage it is found that the candidate was not eligible or their application was not fit to be accepted at the initial stage, then in such a situation, the candidacy will be cancelled. Even if a decision for appointment has already been taken, it will be cancelled.**
23. Involvement in misconduct, such as cheating in the examination hall, indiscipline, misbehavior, or performing any undesirable activities, will lead to the cancellation of candidacy. Failure to comply with these instructions may result in the candidate being debarred from this examination as well as from examinations to be held in the future.
24. Selected candidates must undergo the required medical examination.
25. **The Institute does not provide any consultancy/advice to the candidates regarding their eligibility.** Therefore, they should study the advertisement carefully and apply only when they are satisfied that they are eligible according to the terms and conditions of the advertisement.
26. The Institute shall have the right to cancel the candidacy and debar the candidate from the Institute's examinations and selections if found involved in acts such as any misconduct/malpractice, hiding any important information, pending prosecution/criminal case, being convicted, having more than one living husband or wife, misrepresentation of facts, and making recommendations regarding candidacy/selection, etc.
27. The Director, GIMS Greater Noida, reserves the right to fill or not fill any or all advertised posts without assigning any reason.
