- (i) Essentially good academic record with First Class M.Sc. /M. Tech with a minimum 60% marks or equivalent CGPA in aggregate in Biotechnology/ Biochemistry / Molecular Biology/ Life Sciences/Zoology.
- (ii) Two years of research experience for M. Sc. Candidates as evidenced by publications in peer-reviewed journals.

Desirable:

- (I) Ph.D. in any of the above mentioned fields.
- (II) Candidates having experience in development of diagnostics, developing point of care biosensors for healthcare, applications protein purification and characterization, snake venom biochemistry will be preferred.

Tenure: Initially for up to one year (extendable as per norms). The approved duration of the project is 3 years. Extension may be granted after review of the work done. However, the position is terminus any point of time.

Age: Candidate shall not be more than 35 years on the last date of application. Upper age limit may be relaxed as per Government of India rules.
