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Terms and Conditions:

- The eligible candidates may send their duly-filled biodata in the enclosed application format 'Annexure I' and 'Annexure II', along with self-attested scanned copies (PDF) of the relevant documents by e-mail to pc.sorghummillets@gmail.com on or before 30th May, 2024.
- Only short-listed candidates will be called for a Walk-in interview on 11.06.2024.
- Shortlisted candidates may register their candidature from 9.30 a.m. to 10.30 am only on 11.06.2024.
- The above posts are purely temporary and on a contractual basis. The selected candidates shall not claim for regular appointment/absorption in ICAR-AICRP or funding agency at the end of the project. There is no provision of re-employment after termination of the project/Scheme.
- The tenure of the selected candidate may be extended from time to time in accordance with the guidelines of the Council/ICAR.
- Age limit (as on date of interview): For Young Professional (YP-I): 21-45 years. The candidate's age should not be less than 21 years as on 11.06.2024 and not more than 45 years as on 11.06.2024 (with relaxation as per Govt. rules) in case of SC/ST/OBC & PH candidates.
- The candidate should attend the interview with a duly filled-in application form (as per the Format Annexure I and II enclosed) with a photograph affixed on it and signed. A duly filled-in application form is compulsory.
- No Objection Certificate from the present employer must be produced, if already working.
- All the relevant original testimonials (date of birth, degree certificate, experience certificate, etc., if any) are to be shown and a set of attested copies of all the certificates will be required to be submitted by the candidates for verification, before joining, if selected.
- Candidates should bring their complete biodata, duly self-attested certificates, and mark sheets (From Class 10th onwards), experience certificate, and no objection certificate from their current employer at the appointment time.
- If any candidate is found to have submitted false information/claims at any stage, their candidature will be summarily rejected, or the appointment will be terminated.
- No TA/DA/ any other expenses will be paid for attending the interview.
- Only the candidates having essential qualifications would be allowed to attend the interview.
- Concealing of the facts or canvassing in any form shall lead to disqualification or termination
 of the candidate. The decision of the competent authority will be final and binding in all
 respects.
- The Young professional (YP) shall be subject to the laws of Secrecy of the country and will sign a declaration of secrecy and Non-Disclosure Agreement before reporting.
- In case of any disputes, it will be resolved within the jurisdiction of Hyderabad, Telangana court only.
