Project description: Archaeological Sciences Centre and Humanities and Social Sciences Discipline at IIT Gandhinagar is looking for two exceptionally bright postdoctoral researcher to conduct interdisciplinary research focusing on Indigenous Heritage as a Facilitator for Sustainable Development Goals.
