## INVITES APPLICATIONS FROM UNMARRIED MALE & FEMALE CANDIDATES FOR SHORT SERVICE COMMISSION (SSC) IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (EXECUTIVE BRANCH) – JUN 23 ONWARDS



**Date Of Opening – 21 Jan 23**

1. Applications are invited from unmarried eligible men & women candidates for grant of Short Service Commission (SSC) in Information Technology (Executive Branch) commencing **Jun 2023 onwards** at Indian Naval Academy (INA) Ezhimala, Kerala. Candidates must fulfill conditions

### Eligibility Conditions

#### 2. Educational Qualifications.

<u>Branch/ Cadre</u>	<u>Born Between (Both Dates inclusive)</u>	<u>Eligible streams/ Qualification</u>
SSC Executive (Information Technology)	02 Jul 1998 to 01 Jan 2004	A candidate must have minimum 60% marks in English in class X or XII and one of the undermentioned educational qualification with minimum 60% overall qualifying marks, in either or a combination of the following:- (a) MSc/ BE/ B Tech/ M Tech (Computer Science/ Computer Science & Engineering/ Computer Engineering / Information Technology/ Software Systems/ Cyber Security/ System Administration/ Networking/ Computer Systems & Networking/ Data Analytics/ Artificial Intelligence), <b>OR</b> (b) MCA with BCA/BSc (Computer Science/ Information Technology).

**Note (1).** (a) These vacancies are tentative and may be changed depending on availability of training slots.  
(b) **NCC Candidates.** NCC 'C' certificate holders will be given relaxation of 5% in cut off marks towards shortlisting for SSB sub-division. (i) Having NCC 'C' certificate of Naval/Army/Air Wing with minimum 'B' Grade.  
(ii) Served for not less than two academic years in the Senior Division, Naval/Army/Air Wing of the NCC.  
(iii) 'C' certificate should not be dated prior to **01 Jun 2020**.

**Note (2).** The final selection will be subject to verification of the certificate issued by DG NCC/ concerned NCC unit for its validity. Candidature for training/ post commissioning, in case of false declaration, misinformation, concealing of information.

3. **Medical Standards/ Relaxation in Height and Weight/ Tattoo.** All candidates recommended by SSB are required to undergo medical examination. Medical standards are available on the Indian Navy Website [www.joinindiannavy.gov.in](http://www.joinindiannavy.gov.in). There is no relaxation in medical standards on any **permissible under any circumstances.**

#### 4. Who Can Apply?

- Candidates who have graduated/post graduated or in the final year (regular/integrated) with minimum 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.
- The university for the above mentioned should be incorporated by an Act of Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as Universities/ Autonomous Universities under UGC, Act 1956; IIT Act, 1961; AICTE Act, 1987; NITSER Act, 2007; IIIT Act, 2014.

or

- Candidates who have graduated/post graduated or in the final year (regular/integrated) with 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.
- The university/college/institution should be incorporated by an Act of Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as Universities/ Autonomous Universities under UGC, Act 1956; IIT Act, 1961; AICTE Act, 1987; NITSER Act, 2007; IIIT Act, 2014.

**Note (3).** (a) No equivalent stream of BE/ B.Tech/other qualifications other than those mentioned in para 2 above will be considered valid.  
(b) Candidates selected in the final merit list for induction will be required to submit the proof of completing the qualifying degree by **Jun 2023**. Candidates failing to meet the stipulated educational criteria will not be permitted to join in this regard.

#### 5. Selection Procedure. The selection procedure is as follows:-

- Shortlisting of application will be based on normalised marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying degree. Marks obtained will be normalised using formulae mentioned on the website <https://www.joinindiannavy.gov.in/files/normalisation.pdf>.
- BE/B Tech.** For candidates who have completed or in final year of BE/B Tech, marks obtained upto fifth semester will be considered.
- Post-Graduate Degree Programme.** For candidates who have completed MSc/ MCA/ M Tech, marks obtained in all semesters will be considered.
- Shortlisted candidates will be informed about their selection for SSB interview through e-mail or SMS (provided by candidate's details). **not to change their e-mail/ mobile number till selection process is over.**
- Change of SSB Centre for examination/ interview is not permissible under any circumstances.**

11. **How to Apply.** Candidates are to register and fill application on Indian Navy website [www.joinindiannavy.gov.in](http://www.joinindiannavy.gov.in) commencing submission window, candidates can fill in their details and upload documents in advance. The online submission of application is as under:-

- (a) Whilst filling up the e-application, it is advisable to keep the relevant documents readily available to enable the following:-
  - (i) Correct filling up of personal particulars. Details are to be filled up as given in the Matriculation Certificate.
  - (ii) Fields such as e-mail address, mobile number are mandatory fields and need to be filled.
- (b) All relevant documents (preferably in original), marks sheets (for candidates appearing in final year) upto 5<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> semester respectively and all semesters (for candidates who have completed their degree), date of birth proof (as per 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> certificate), certificate issued by National Cadet Corps and a recent passport size colour photograph should be scanned in original JPG/TIFF format and submitted with application. Candidates are to take print out of application and carry it while appearing for SSB interview.
- (c) **If any scanned document is not legible/ readable for any reason the application will be rejected.**
- (d) The application once submitted will be final and no request for amendments/change will be entertained.

**Note (4).** (a) Please read the instructions given on the website carefully before finally submitting your online application.  
(b) Your candidature will be cancelled if any declaration is found wrong at any stage of selection.  
(c) Use/ possession of narcotics is banned. Candidate may be tested for presence of drugs in the body during SSB selection/ interview. If candidate is found to be using/ in possession of narcotics during any time of selection/ medical/ training/ service career, candidate will be removed from service if already joined.  
(d) **Your application is subject to subsequent scrutiny and the application can be rejected, if found INELIGIBLE/INVALID at any stage.**
