Duties include undergraduate and postgraduate teaching, research, research supervision, consultancy, training, and departmental and institutional activities. ‡Assistant Professor Grade II is not part of the regular faculty cadre in the Institute. Appointments at this level will be made purely on a temporary basis, generally for a maximum period of three years.

Institute Support for New Faculty Members (Assistant Professor Grade I):

In addition to the pay package, the Institute offers several incentives for professional and personal development of the new faculty members (Assistant Professor Grade I) as per institute norms. These include:

- Start-up research grant up to Rs. 5 Lakhs in the first year after joining and upon submission of a suitable project proposal; possibility of higher start-up grant for proposals requiring expensive research equipment.
- Cumulative Professional Development Allowance (CPDA) (at present Rs. 3 Lakhs for every block period of 3 years).
- Several well-established mechanisms for interaction with the industry, and other professional bodies, for research projects as well as for consultancy.
- The Cell for Cooperation with Academia, Industry and R&D Labs (C-CAIR) at the Institute facilitating faculty entrepreneurship, as well as faculty involvement in start-ups.
- Accommodation in campus housing subject to availability.
- Attractive medical facilities and medical insurance scheme.
- Reimbursement of relocation expenses.
