- Maintain local media relations and assist with preparing and issuing press releases.
- Ensure project participation in local student events, school and college festivals, major exhibitions and EPO events
- Contribute to detailed documentation of various stages of the LIGO-India project. Points to note:
 Organisation of events (at night or on weekends) requires a considerable amount of travel and stay outside Pune.
