1. INTRODUCTION:

- (i) Konkan Railway Corporation Limited (KRCL) invites ONLINE applications for the erstwhile Group D post of Track Maintainer-IV and Points Man in Engineering and Operating department. Only land loser candidates whose land has been acquired for the KRCL project, irrespective of the percentage of land lost; such persons can be land losers themselves, their spouse (wife/husband), son, daughter, grandson, or granddaughter only can apply.

Note: The above vacancies include the anticipated vacancies.

The number of posts indicated above is provisional and may vary as per KRCL's requirements. Accordingly, KRCL will publish updated vacancy positions again on its website, indicating the revised vacancies, if any.

This notification provides for Vertical Reservation for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), Economically Weaker Section (EWS), and Horizontal Reservation for Ex-Servicemen (Ex. SM).

NOTE: EBC & EWS are different categories. EBC candidates are not entitled to any job reservation.

Any unfilled vacancies of Ex-Servicemen (Ex. SM) and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) shall not be carried forward. The notification provides for horizontal reservation for Ex-Servicemen (Ex. SM) irrespective of their community, wherever applicable and admissible.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

4.1 AGE LIMIT - 18 to 45 years.

The lower age limit is standard for all the notified posts. The upper age limit has been increased from 33 to 45 as one time exception to provide relief to many land loser candidates who may have exceeded the age. The age shall be reckoned as on 01/08/2025.

4.2 The relaxation in the upper age limit for the following categories/communities in the table below is applicable, subject to the submission of requisite certificates at the time of DV. This age relaxation is over and above the twelve years age relaxation mentioned above.

- Candidates who wish to be considered against reserved vacancies or seek age relaxation must submit the requisite/relevant certificate in original from the Competent Authority in the prescribed format at the time of DV. Otherwise, their claim for SC/ST/Ex.SM/EWS status will not be considered, and their candidature/applications will be considered under the General (UR) category if otherwise eligible. The certificates should be in the format annexed. Certificates submitted in any format other than those prescribed in this notification will not be accepted.
- Service personnel likely to be discharged from military service on or before 12/08/2026 are eligible to apply against this employment notice as Ex-Servicemen.
- Candidates eligible for age relaxation on more than one ground will benefit from the category with the maximum relaxation and will **not get the cumulative benefit**.

- d. SC, ST & OBC (NCL) candidates applying against UR vacancies will not get any age relaxation.

5.0 LAND LOSER CANDIDATES:

A Land loser candidate is defined as a person who has lost his land for the KRCL project between Roha (Maharashtra) and Thokur (Karnataka) on the KRCL route, i.e., whose land was acquired for the Konkan Railway Project, irrespective of the percentage of land lost. Such person himself/herself, his/her spouse (wife/husband), son, daughter, grandson, or granddaughter only are eligible.

As per the above definition, even the daughters/granddaughters/grandsons from the maternal side of the land loser are also eligible to apply as a land loser candidate.

KRCL has a policy of giving recruitment to ONLY one member per acquisition whose land has been acquired by KRCL (GEN & OBC-NCL). However, this condition does not apply to SC/ST Candidates. (Candidates should read the amended Recruitment Policy of KRCL dated 16/03/2018, 29/08/2019 and 02/09/2020, which is available on KRCL website www.konkanrailway.com → Departments → Personnel → Recruitment Policy).

Land loser candidates, other than SC/ST, whose relative/joint owner of the same land survey number has already been recruited in KRCL, cannot apply as land loser candidates for the same land acquisition.

6.0 VERTICAL RESERVATION:

6.1 This notification provides for vertical reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), wherever applicable and admissible under extant rules. Only those communities recognized by the Government of India as SC and ST are eligible for reservation.

NOTE: EBC & EWS are different categories. EBC candidates are not entitled to any job reservation.

6.2 All candidates, irrespective of community, will be considered against general, i.e., unreserved (UR) vacancies (subject to fulfilment of eligibility conditions required for UR). However, vacancies reserved for specific groups (viz., SC, ST & EWS) will be filled only by candidates from that community/category.

6.3 Hence, EWS, SC, ST and OBC-NCL candidates who fulfil the requisite educational qualifications can also apply against UR vacancies, for which they will have to compete as general (unreserved) candidates without any relaxation/concession in age, educational qualification, marks, etc. at any stage of examination. In any case, candidates are advised to indicate their actual community in the application. There are no posts reserved for OBC-NCL. Hence, all candidates applying as OBC will be treated as unreserved candidates subject to fulfilment of eligibility conditions required for unreserved category.

6.4 For availing reservation, EWS, SC and ST candidates should furnish the necessary certificates (in original) during DV. The certificates should be issued by competent authorities as per the formats given at Annexure-IV (for SC & ST candidates) and Annexure-VII (for EWS candidates).

6.5 IMPORTANT: Community/category status as of the closing date for submission of applications against this notification shall only be considered for reservation and related benefits as per eligibility. Any change in this status thereafter shall not be entertained.

6.6 EWS (Economically Weaker Section) Reservation:

Candidates not covered under the scheme of reservation for SC/ST/OBC-NCL and whose family gross annual income is below Rs. 8 Lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh) are to be identified as EWS for the benefit of reservation for EWS. The income shall also include income from all sources, i.e., salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc., for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also, candidates whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of family income:

6.6.1: 5 acres of agricultural land and above;

6.6.2: Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;

6.6.3: Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;

6.6.4: Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a family in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. The term Family for this purpose will include the person who seeks the benefit of

reservation, their parents and siblings below the age of 18, and their spouse and children below the age of 18. The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon producing an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset Certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-VII shall only be accepted as the candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:

- A) District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Collector / Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy Commissioner / 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate / Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate/ Adnl Assistant Commissioner;
- B) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate;
- C) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar;
- D) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.

The candidates applying against the vacancies reserved for EWS must possess an Income and Asset Certificate as of the closing date of submission of applications against this notification. Accordingly, they have to fill out the certificate number, date of issue of the certificate, issuing authority, district, and state of issue in the ONLINE application. Further, these candidates must also produce valid Income and Asset Certificate during document verification. In case of non-compliance to these stipulations, their claim for reserved status under EWS will not be entertained. The candidature/application of such candidates, if fulfilling all the eligibility conditions for the General (UR) category, will be considered only under General (UR) vacancies.

7.0 HORIZONTAL RESERVATION:

7.1: This notification also provides horizontal reservation for Ex-Servicemen (Ex. SM) irrespective of their social community;

7.2: The vacancies shown in the Vacancy Table also include those reserved for Ex.SM;

7.3: Ex.SM candidates can also apply against unreserved vacancies of any post(s) not exclusively earmarked for them. They will be eligible for age relaxation and fee exemption while applying for these posts.

8.0 EX-SERVICEMEN:

8.1: The term Ex-Serviceman means a person who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or a non-combatant) in the regular Army, Navy, or Air Force of the Indian Union but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps., the General Reserve Engineering Force, the Lok Sahayak Sena, and the Para Military Forces, and -

- a) who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service, whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension; (or)
- b) who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; (or)
- c) who has been released from such service as a result of a reduction in establishment; (or)
- d) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than on his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service; (or)
- e) Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of the Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension or are released from the Army Postal Service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstances beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension; (or)
- f) Personnel who were on deputation in the Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to 14th April 1987; (or)
- g) Gallantry award winners of the Armed forces, including personnel of the Territorial Army; (or)
- h) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical grounds and granted medical disability pension w.e.f. 01.02.2006.

8.2: Persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service would come under the category of Ex-Servicemen are eligible to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specific terms of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to Ex-Servicemen but such persons shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specific terms of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union.

8.3: Accordingly, such serving Defence personnel to be released within one year (i.e., on or before 12/08/2026) of the closing date of submission of applications against this notification can also apply, both for vacancies earmarked for Ex-Servicemen and for posts not reserved for them. However, they should possess the prescribed Educational Qualification as of the closing date of submitting applications for this notification, i.e., 12/08/2025.

8.4: Ex-Servicemen candidates who have already secured civil employment under the Central Government in Group 'C' & erstwhile Group 'D' (including PSUs, Autonomous Bodies/Statutory Bodies, Nationalized Banks, etc.) after availing of the benefits given to Ex-Servicemen will be permitted only the benefit of age relaxation

as prescribed for Ex-Servicemen for securing another civil employment in a higher grade or cadre in Group 'C'/ erstwhile Group 'D' under Central Government. Such candidates will not be considered for the vacancies reserved for ex-servicemen in central government jobs.

8.5 If an Ex-Serviceman applies for various vacancies before joining any Civil employment, they can avail themselves the benefit of reservation as Ex-Serviceman for any subsequent employment, subject to the condition that an Ex-Serviceman as soon as he joins any Civil employment, should give self-declaration/undertaking to the concerned employer about the details of application against this notification. The acknowledged copy of this declaration and NOC from the civil employer should be produced during DV, failing which their candidature shall be cancelled. Further, this benefit would be available only regarding vacancies filled on direct recruitment and wherever reservation is applicable to the Ex-Servicemen.

9.0 EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

- (a) Please see the Post Parameters Table (Annexure-A) for the prescribed qualifications for each post.
- (b) Candidates appearing and awaiting final examination results of the prescribed educational qualification can also apply. However, they will be required to produce the requisite certificate of having acquired the educational qualification at the time of document verification, failing which their candidature will be rejected.

10.0 HOW TO APPLY:

Preference of Post:

Multiple posts in PML-1, their details, and other requirements have been indicated in para (1) & (2) of this notification. Candidates can apply for multiple posts. Candidates are required to indicate their post-wise preference very carefully. Once exercised in the ONLINE application, options shall be final, and no request for change shall be entertained. Therefore, candidates are advised to exercise the option for post(s) carefully. KRCL will allot only one post to the selected candidate as per the preference of the candidate, subject to merit, vacancy position, and qualifying the various stages of the selection process.

Note: Any request by candidates selected for a specific post as per their preference for allotment of a post lower in the preference shall not be entertained.

a) CANDIDATES ARE ADVISED TO VISIT ONLY THE OFFICIAL WEBSITES OF KRCL, i.e., www.konkanrailway.com AND BE VERY CAUTIOUS ABOUT FAKE WEBSITES AND JOB RACKETEERS.

b) Candidates should ensure they possess/fulfil all eligibility conditions prescribed for the post as of the closing date for applying.

c) Candidates who possess/fulfil all eligibility conditions prescribed for the post as of the closing date for applying may apply for one or more posts in a single application in the order of their preference for which candidate is eligible and interested in applying. Payment of the prescribed examination fee for CBT Examination is to be made by the candidates at the time of filling out an ONLINE application. Any attempt by a candidate to register more than once against this notification shall result in the rejection of all registrations, disqualification, and debarment from the selection process of this notification.

Candidates are advised to refer to paras. 16 and 17 of this notification for details regarding the examination fee and mode of payment.

d) Eligibility of the candidates to be called for CBT will be considered only on the strength of the information furnished in the ONLINE Application. If at any stage of recruitment or thereafter, it is found that any information furnished by the candidate in his/her application is false/incorrect, or the candidate has suppressed any relevant information, or the candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria for the post, his/her candidature will be rejected immediately.

e) Candidates are advised to read all the information and instructions detailed in the notification thoroughly before starting to fill out the application by clicking the link on the official website of KRCL. It is essential that the candidate understands all the information in the notification correctly to prevent any mistakes while filling out the application.

f) Candidates should have their own mobile number and valid and active personal email ID and keep these active for the entire duration of recruitment. KRCL shall send all recruitment-related communications only through SMS and email until the recruitment process is complete. KRCL will not entertain any request for a change of mobile number and e-mail address at any stage.

g) Candidates should enter their Name, Father's Name, and Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation/SSLC/High School Examination Certificate or an equivalent certificate ONLY.

- h) In cases of name change, candidates should indicate their changed name only in the ONLINE application. However, other details should match with the Matriculation or Equivalent certificate. The date of such change (or) application for such change should be prior to the date of submission of the ONLINE application. The candidate must submit the Gazette Notification or any other legal document, as applicable, at the time of DV.
- i) To ensure speedy filling up of the ONLINE application by the candidates, they should keep ready scanned copies of following mandatory documents before filling out the application:
- A recent, clear-coloured passport-size photograph (against a plain white background) in JPEG image (size 80 to 100 KB)-without dark glasses and/or cap;
Note: Candidates must have at least 12 (twelve) copies of the same photograph for future use during the recruitment process.
 - Scanned JPEG image of candidate's signature in running handwriting (size 80 to 100 KB);
 - SC/ST certificate (only for candidates requesting free passes for train travel) in PDF format (size 200 KB to 1 MB);
 - Affidavit for "Minority Community Declaration" as the case may be in PDF format as per Annexure- VI) (size 200 KB to 1 MB);
 - Self Attested photocopy of land loser certificate issued by SLAO as Annexure -I in PDF format (size 200 KB to 1 MB);
 - Self Attested photocopy of certificate issued by Tehsildar indicating the percentage of land lost concerning the total land holding of the land loser – As per Annexure -II (including all survey numbers). Details on SLAO and Tehsildar certificates should match in PDF format (size 200 KB to 1 MB);
 - Self Attested photocopy of valid income certificate in case of Economically Backward Class (EBC) candidates as Annexure -V in PDF format (size 200 KB to 1 MB)
- j) Candidates are further advised to visit KRCL's website frequently to get the latest information on the various stages of the recruitment process or any changes to this notification.
- k) The candidates are responsible for proving with valid documents that all the information they submitted in the ONLINE application is true.
- l) **Registration Process & Filling of Online Application:** The candidates shall first register their names by visiting the official website of KRCL, www.konkanrailway.com. A registration number will be generated upon successful registration. This registration number and password will be sent to the candidates via registered email and mobile number. Further, a link for

making an application along with the registration number and password will be sent to the candidate's registered e-mail address. On activation of this link, the candidate will get access to the application form. **The link for registration and application submission will go live on 23/07/2025.**

- m) Candidates are advised to keep a printed copy of the ONLINE application with themselves. However, under no circumstances should candidates send a hard or soft copy of the application or any document to KRCL. The same should be produced only at the time of DV.
- n) Candidates are advised to note and preserve their Registration Number for further stages of the recruitment process and correspondence with KRCL.

Candidates are advised to submit their ONLINE applications well before the closing date since there is a possibility of inability/failure to log on to the website due to heavy load on the internet or the website during the last few days.

KRCL is not responsible for any failure of payment transactions or application submissions due to internet issues at the time of filling out online applications.

Note: For any application difficulties/queries when filing an online application, please mail the recruitment cell help desk with the mail ID "Recruitment Cell Help Desk" helpdeskrectcell@krcl.co.in. Only queries pertaining to applications will be resolved and mailed to the candidates' mail ID. Personal grievances shall not be entertained in the above help desk mail ID. The help desk mail ID shall remain active only till the closing date of filling out the online application.

11.0 INVALID APPLICATIONS / REJECTIONS:

Online applications are liable for rejection on the following grounds, amongst others:

- Invalid photos on account of Black and White photos, photos with a cap or wearing goggles/dark glasses, disfigured photos, small photos, full-body photos, photos having only one side view of the face, unrecognizable photos, photostat copies of the photos, group photos, online applications without photos, candidate signatures in capital letters, among others;
- Any other irregularities which are observed and considered invalid by KRCL.
- In case the application is rejected, candidates will be able to view their status ONLINE on the KRCL website along with the reason(s) for rejection(s), which is final and binding; no further correspondence shall be entertained on the subject. **No refund of the examination fee will be made on account of the rejection of the application.** SMS and e-mail alerts shall also be sent to the

candidates using their registered mobile numbers and e-mail IDs, as indicated in their ONLINE application. Candidates will not be intimated by post.

- Candidates serving (including those undergoing induction training/probation) in any Central/State Government Department, including Railways or PSU, may apply directly to KRCL, duly informing their employer. However, shortlisted candidates must produce NOC from the employer on the date of their DV, failing which their candidature will be cancelled.
- Candidates should note that if KRCL receives a communication from their employer withholding permission to the candidates applying for/appearing at the examination, their application/candidature is liable to be rejected /cancelled.

12.0 RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

12.1: The recruitment process for the Pointsman and Track Maintainer posts shall involve Computer Based Test (CBT) followed by Document Verification, Physical Efficiency Test (PET), and Medical Examination.

Candidates qualifying the CBT will be called for document verification (DV) five times the number of vacancies notified. After that, candidates equal to three times the number of vacancies notified who qualify in CBT and DV will be called for PET. PET is qualifying in nature.

The date, time, and venue for CBT and other additional activities as applicable shall decided by KRCL and intimated to the eligible candidates. Request for any modification in this regard shall not be entertained.

CBT Cities : Applicant can select any three Test Cities as per preference from the drop down menu while filling up of online application form. One among the three preferred test cities will be allotted subject to availability. In rare case, if an applicant is not allotted to any of the preferred test cities, applicant will be allotted to a nearby available test city.

12.2 CBT: The CBT/CBTs is/are tentatively scheduled for September 2025.

The CBT is screening in nature, and the standard of questions will generally be in conformity with the educational standards prescribed for the post.

Negative Marking: Incorrect answers in CBT will be marked negatively. One-third of the marks allotted for each question will be deducted for each wrong answer.

12.3 Banned Items: Candidates carrying banned items like communication devices and Electronic gadgets (Mobile phones, Bluetooth devices, pen drives, laptops, calculators, smart watches), bangles, chains, bracelets, hearing aids, wallets/purses, metallic wears, etc., or any stationery items like pen/pencil shall not be allowed to appear during the examination. Any infringement/violation of this instruction shall lead to disqualification, legal action, and debarment from future examinations of KRCL.

Cloakroom arrangements for safekeeping belongings may not be available at the examination venues. Therefore, candidates are advised to refrain from bringing any valuables or banned items, including mobile phones, etc., to the examination venue. KRCL management shall not be responsible for the loss of any such item brought to the CBT venue.

12.4 CBT- Qualifying Marks

The minimum percentage of marks required for various categories to qualify for the next recruitment process shall be as follows:

Note: The marks mentioned above are the minimum qualifying marks. If more than the required number of candidates are able to secure the minimum qualifying marks, then the cutoff may be more than the qualifying marks.

12.5 CBT- Pattern and Syllabus

CBT Pattern: The CBT will be in five languages (English, Hindi, Marathi, Konkani, and Kannada). The candidate must choose any one of these languages.

Note: In case of any discrepancy between various versions, the English version will prevail.

12.5.1 The section-wise number of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) and marks for posts of Track Maintainer and Pointsman are as below :

12.6 The Questions will be of objective type with multiple choices and are likely to include questions about:

Basic Science: Physics, Chemistry and Life Sciences of seventh standard level.

Basic Mathematics: Number System, BODMAS, Decimals, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportions, Percentage, Mensuration, Time and Work, Time and Distance, Simple and Compound Interest, Profit and Loss, Algebra, Geometry and Trigonometry, Elementary Statistics etc. of seventh standard level.

General Awareness and Current Affairs: Science & Technology, Sports, History, Geography, Culture, Personalities, Economics, Politics, and other subjects of importance.

THE ABOVE-INDICATED LIST IS NOT EXHAUSTIVE, AND QUESTIONS ON OTHER RELATED TOPICS CAN ALSO BE ASKED.

12.7 OBJECTION AGAINST ANSWER KEY:

After the CBT, a link shall be provided on the Konkan Railway website (www.konkanrailway.com) to enable candidates who appeared in the CBT to view their question papers, responses, and answer keys. After viewing these details, objections, if any, regarding the questions, options, and keys published can be raised by the candidates, for which a schedule will be published on the KRCL website. Candidates can submit their objections online by paying fees of Rs. 59/- (Applicable fee of Rs. 50/- + GST @ 18%) + payment of gateway charges, if any, for each objection. If the objection is correct, the fee paid against such valid objections shall be refunded to the candidate, duly deducting bank charges as applicable. However, if the objection is incorrect, the candidate will forfeit the money.

13.0 NORMALISATION OF MARKS:

The examination may have to be conducted in multiple sessions in CBT. For these multisession papers, a suitable normalization is applied to account for any variation in the difficulty levels of the question papers across different sessions. The formula for calculating the normalized marks for the multi-session papers is detailed below :

Normalization mark of j^{th} candidate in i^{th} session $\widehat{M}_{ij}$ is given by :

$$\widehat{M}_{ij} = \frac{\overline{M}_i^s - M_q^s}{M_{ii} - M_{iq}} (M_{ij} - M_{iq}) + M_q^s$$

M_{ij} : is the actual marks obtained by the j^{th} candidate in i^{th} session.

$\overline{M}_i^s$: is the average marks of the top 0.1% of the candidates considering all sessions.

M_q^s : is the sum of mean and standard deviation marks of the candidates in the paper considering all sessions.

M_{ii} : is the average marks of the top 0.1% of the candidates in the i^{th} session or marks of topper if session strength is less than 1000.

M_{iq} : is the sum of the mean marks and standard deviation of the i^{th} session.

14.0 PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST:

The following criteria will be followed for the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) :

Male: Should be able to run a distance of 1000 meters in 4 minutes and 15 seconds in one chance.

Female: Should be able to run a distance of 400 meters in 3 minutes and 10 seconds in one chance.

15.0 MEDICAL STANDARDS FOR THE POSTS:

Candidates called for DV and found eligible in PET must pass a requisite medical examination(s) before their final empanelment to the post extent of the vacancies notified. The candidate shall bear the expenses towards the medical examination. Visual Acuity Standard is one of the essential criteria of medical fitness for KRCL employees. The medical requirements against different medical standards for various categories are outlined below:

Sr. No.	Medical Standard	General Fitness	Vision Standards
1	A-2	Physically fit in all respect	Distant vision-6/9,6/9 without glasses. Near vision-Sn: 0.6,0.6 and must pass the test of colour vision, Binocular vision, Night vision, and Mesopic Vision

2	A-3	Physically fit in all respect	Distant Vision- 6/9, 6/9 with or without glasses (power of lenses not to exceed 2D). Near Vision- Sn: 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses and must pass the test for Colour Vision, Binocular Vision, Night Vision, and Myopic vision.
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Candidates who have undergone Lasik surgery or any other surgical procedure to correct refractory error are not eligible for the post having Medical Standard of A-2 and A-3.

Candidates suffering from vertigo are not Fit in A2 and A3.

Candidates with contagious and infective disorders, epilepsy, asthma, otorrhea, psychiatric illness, ischemic heart disease, stammering, valvular disease, impaired hearing, hypertension, obesity, poor renal status, etc. will not be eligible for A2 and A3.

The above medical standards are only indicative and not exhaustive. The selected candidates must undergo a detailed medical examination as per the KRCL Medical Manual.

Candidates must ensure that they fulfil the prescribed medical standards for the post they opt for. Candidates found medically unsuitable for the opted post(s) shall not be given any alternative appointment.

16.0 EXAMINATION FEE:

16.1 Candidates applying for the posts in this notification have to pay the prescribed examination fee of Rs. 885/- (Applicable fee of Rs. 750/- + GST @ 18%, i.e., Rs. 135/-) + payment of gateway charges, if any, for examination. For the candidates belonging to SC, ST, Ex-Serviceman, Female, Minorities or Economically backward class (EBC) categories, the fee shall be refunded to the candidates duly deducting bank charges as applicable on appearing in CBT.

16.2 Minorities include Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, and Zoroastrians (Parsis), subject to revision/deletion/inclusion if any, received by the last date for submission of the online application, i.e. 12/08/2025-

Affidavit for “Minority Community Declaration”: Minority candidates claiming waiver of examination fee will be required to furnish an affidavit (as per Annexure-VI) on non-judicial stamp paper mentioning their minority community at the time of DV, failing which their candidature will be rejected.

16.3: Economically Backward Class (EBC) candidates are those whose annual family income is less than Rs. 50,000 and are eligible for concessional fee (as per para 16.0 above). For this, they should have :

a) Valid Income Certificate on the date of application in the prescribed format (as per Annexure-V) on the letterhead of the Issuing Authority. The following authorities are authorized to issue income certificates to identify economically backward classes:

- District magistrate or any other Revenue Officer up to the level of Tahsildar;
- Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their Constituency;
- Sitting Member of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the district in which these MPs normally reside;
- Union Minister for any persons from anywhere in the country.

(OR)

b) BPL Card or any other certificate issued by the Central Government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme

(OR)

All EBC candidates who seek concessional fees should fill in the relevant details of a valid EBC certificate/BPL card in the ONLINE application. The same must also be submitted in the original at the time of DV, failing which, their candidature will be rejected.

NOTE: EBC and EWS are distinct categories, and EBC should not be confused with OBC or EWS. EBC candidates should know that they are entitled only to fee concession, not job reservation.

17.0 MODES OF PAYMENT OF FEE

- ONLINE fee payment will only be accepted through Internet banking, debit/credit cards, or UPI. The candidate shall bear all applicable service charges.
- Candidates can pay the fee ONLINE only. There will be no option to pay the fee through any other mode.
- Applications received without a prescribed fee shall not be considered and will be summarily rejected. No representation against such rejection will be entertained.

18.0 REFUND OF EXAMINATION FEE (FOR THOSE ATTENDING CBT ONLY):

- The Examination Fee is refundable to candidates from exempted categories who have appeared in CBT. The examination fee of Rs. 750/- paid by them through online payment (Net Banking, Debit Card, Credit Card, and UPI) shall be refunded, duly deducting bank charges to the same account from which the online payment was received.

- **There will be no refund of the examination fee for erroneous, incomplete, or rejected applications.**

19.0 INSTRUCTION RELATED TO E-CALL LETTER :

- a) SMS and email messages will be sent to all eligible candidates with details of the e-call letter. Eligible candidates can download the e-call letter from the KRCL website about 10 days before the date of the CBT/DV/PET (as applicable).
- b) Call letters will not be sent by post to candidates.
- c) The mere issue of an e-call letter to the candidates does NOT imply that KRCL has finally accepted their candidature.
- d) Candidates should read the instructions on the e-call letter carefully and follow them scrupulously. Failure to comply with the instructions may result in the cancellation of their candidature.
- e) **Free Travel Facility:** In the case of SC/ST candidates who have uploaded the details of their community certificate to avail the benefit of free travel authority (Sleeper Class Railway Pass), the e-call letter for CBT/DV/PET/ME (as applicable) will contain the free travel authority and such candidates will be allowed to book a ticket on submission of self-attested photocopy of the e-call letter and SC/ST certificate at the ticket booking counter. If two or more candidates secure the same marks, their merit position shall be determined by their age criteria. For example, an older person shall be given higher merit, and if the age is the same, then the alphabetical order (A to Z) of the name shall be taken into account to decide the merit position.

 - i) NOC from a current employer with the date of appointment if the candidate is a serving employee (including those undergoing induction training/probation) in any Central/State Government Department, including Railways or PSU.
 - j) Original discharge certificate for Ex-serviceman. NOC from Serving Defence Personnel with probable date of discharge (if applicable)
 - k) Gazette notification and/or any Legal document in case of a formal name change.

22.0 IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- The selected candidates can be posted and transferred anywhere in Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd's area of operation, including its project sites. However, Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd. employees are not eligible for transfer to other Zonal Railways.
