**FILLING-UP OF THE PC ST OF CHIEF VIGILANCE OFFICER ON DEPUTATION BASIS**

National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) – a Joint Venture Company of Govt of India and State Governments of Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan and U.P, under the administrative control of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, is implementing the Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) in National Capital Region (NCR). The RRTS is a rail based, high speed, high frequency commuter system connecting centres of metropolitan and big cities, towns and regional nodes across NCR seamlessly.

With 180 kmph design speed and average speed close to 100 kmph, first of its kind RRTS will provide fast, reliable, comfortable, safe and efficient regional mobility solution. Fast and efficient regional mobility will help in addressing urban issues of severe congestion, hazardous pollution, unmanageable urban sprawl, economic and social exclusion and will not only create new economic and employment opportunities but will also improve productivity of industry and human resources and bring development into regional nodes. Once operational, RRTS will be the fastest, the most comfortable and the safest mode of travel in the NCR. In the first phase, three RRTS corridors namely **Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut**, **Delhi-Gurugram-SNB-Alwar** and **Delhi-Panipat** are being implemented.

These high profile projects with high performing teams offer a once in a lifetime opportunity to make a significant and lasting contribution to improve quality of life of citizens in NCR and the country as a whole. 8.	Whether the company/ organization has been exempted from the rule of permanent absorption and if so, the date up-to which the exemption is valid.	DoPT vide its OM No. AB.14017/86/2007-Estt. (RR) dated 16.01.2008 has granted exemption for deputationist Officers joining Joint Sector companies like DMRC etc. set up for Metro Projects, from the rule of permanent absorption so long as they are in "construction mode". MoHUA has extended these instructions for NCRTC also vide its letter No. K-14011/17/2016MRTC-1dated 03.01.2017.
9.	Residential accommodation	NCRTC will be providing Company/ Leased Accommodation as per entitlement to the officer who joins NCRTC on deputation. Officers occupying GPRA will be governed in terms of MoUD's letter No. O.M. No. 12035/14/92-Pol.II dated 11.10.2000.
10.	Perks & benefits	Lease, Transport, Medical, Laptop/ Mobile handset/ Electricity/ Phone charges, subject to limits, and other allowances as per Company's policy.

**SELECTION PROCESS:**

Selection Process shall involve initial screening by NCRTC in terms of Railway Board's letter No. 2018/E(O)II/41/1 dated 07.03.2018 and final approval of Central Vigilance Commission.
