#### Eligibility Criteria:

Bachelor's Degree in Law (LLB or equivalent – full time degree from recognized Indian University/Institute) with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST candidates) in the final semester of the qualifying course can also apply. However, they must be able to produce marksheet and course completion certificate/provisional degree certificate with minimum marks (55% for SC/ST candidates) on or before 31.08.2022.

Candidates must appear for **CLAT-2022 (Common Law Admission Test-2022) Post Graduate programme** (conducted only by the Consortium of National Law Universities). Candidates shall be shortlisted for document verification based on **CLAT-2022 Post Graduate programme** performance, from amongst the candidates who appear in the advertisement in NTPC. Further, the candidates will be extended "Offer of Appointment" subject to meeting the advertised eligibility criteria. **Please note that the marks of any other year or score of any other examination will not be considered valid.** Last date for online registration for CLAT-2022 is 09.05.2022. Upper age limit is 30 years as on last date of online application in NTPC.

#### Reservation & Relaxations:

- Reservation & Relaxations to candidates will be provided as per Government guidelines.
- Category once filled in the online application form will not be changed and no benefit of other category will be admissible later on.
- No registration fee will be charged from SC/ST/PwDB/XSM and female candidates during online registration in NTPC Ltd.
- The upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years for SC/ST, 3 years for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates. Upper age is relaxed by 5 years for the candidates who have been domiciled in the state of Jammu & Kashmir from 01.01.80 to 31.12.89. In addition, the age relaxation for Ex-servicemen (XSM) will be as per Government guidelines.
- The OBC candidates who belong to "Creamy Layer" are not entitled for concession admissible to OBC category and such candidates have to appear in the General.

#### HEALTH:

The candidate should have sound health. Before joining, candidates will have to undergo medical examination at any of the NTPC hospitals and the results will be binding. #### HOW TO APPLY:

- The candidates need to apply in online mode in NTPC for the post of Assistant Law Officer on the website [careers.ntpc.co.in](http://careers.ntpc.co.in) or [www.ntpc.co.in](http://www.ntpc.co.in) with their CLAT-2022 Admit Card number.** No other mode of application shall be accepted.
- Candidates belonging to General/EWS/OBC category are required to pay a non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 300/-. The SC / ST / PwBD/ XSM candidates need not pay the registration fee.
- Payment in offline mode:** State Bank of India has been authorized to collect the registration fee, in a specially opened account (A/C No. 3098791999999999, Delhi (Code: 09996), on behalf of NTPC. Candidate has to approach the nearby SBI branch with a printout of the "pay-in-slip" which is available on the website. The pay-in-slip printed from the portal should only be used for depositing the fee for proper crediting of amount in the allocated account. On successful completion of the payment, the bank will issue a unique Journal Number and a Branch Code of the bank collecting the money. This journal number and the branch code are to be mentioned in the online application. NTPC will not be responsible, in case a candidate deposits the fee in wrong account.
- Payment in online mode:** Candidates also have the option to pay the fees online (through Net banking / Debit Card (Rupay Debit Cards Only) / Credit Card). The payment option will be available on the website. The candidate is required to make the payment before proceeding for online application. After making the payment, Challan number, Bank Reference No, date of payment etc. are required to be filled up in the online application.
- Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. Candidates are therefore requested to verify their eligibility before paying the fee.**
- Read the instructions carefully and fill-in the online application form giving accurate information including the CLAT-2022 Admit Card number and the registration fee. After applying online, candidate is required to download the registration slip generated by the system with unique registration number. Copy of registration slip should be kept by the candidate for future reference. No document/slip is required to be sent to us by post.
- Please ensure that the CLAT 2022 Admit Card number, which is mentioned on your CLAT 2022 Admit Card/Hall Ticket, is filled up correctly in the online application.** If the number is not filled up as appearing in CLAT 2022 Admit Card/Hall Ticket.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS:

- Only Indian Nationals are eligible to apply.
- All qualifications should be from Universities / Institutions recognized and approved in India.
- All computations of age shall be done as at the last date of online application for NTPC.
