Above monthly remuneration rates shall remain unchanged for the entire duration of engagement, including the extension period, if any, unless, the remuneration rates specified under the relevant SAIL guidelines get revised with the approval of the Competent Authority. (ii)	The selection will be through a "Screening-cum-Selection Committee" to be constituted by ISP. In case of receipt of large number of applications, SAIL ISP will reserve the right to adopt suitable/additional short-listing criteria.
(iii)	Candidates shall be required to appear before the Selection Committee for Interview. The date of the interview shall be intimated to the candidate through e-mail, on the e-mail ID mentioned in their application.
