GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. AGE LIMIT

The eligibility date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications, i.e., the closing date of the advertisement.

2. HOW TO APPLY

- (i) Applications for all posts shall be accepted online only.
- (ii) Interested candidates shall apply through the website <https://sameer.gov.in/recruitment> up to midnight of the closing date of the advertisement. Detailed instructions and deadlines for submission of the online application are available on the said website. Candidates may edit their application before final submission. Upon clicking “FINAL SUBMIT”, a PDF copy of the application shall be generated. Candidates must take a printout of the same and produce it along with all original documents and one set of self-attested photocopies at the time of written test and/or interview.
- (iii) Candidates applying for the posts of Project Engineer / Project Associate / Project Scientific Assistant / Project Technical Assistant, who fulfil the prescribed qualifications, shall be required to appear for written test(s) for the purpose of screening.
- (iv) No candidate shall be permitted to appear for the written test and/or interview without the printout of the online submitted application (PDF file).
- (v) The results of the screening test (written examination) shall be declared, and only shortlisted candidates shall be called for interview, either on the same day or on a subsequently notified date.
- (vi) Candidates must possess the prescribed experience in one or more relevant fields, as specified under the column “Experience”, and shall be required to produce documentary proof in support thereof.
- (vii) The crucial date for reckoning experience shall be the closing date of application. Experience acquired prior to obtaining the essential qualification shall not be taken into consideration. Selection shall be made purely on merit, and mere experience of working at SAMEER shall not confer any preferential claim.
- (viii) The prescribed essential qualifications and experience are the minimum requirements. Mere possession of the same shall not entitle any candidate to be called for written test, skill test, or interview.

3. SELECTION PROCEDURE

- (i) Candidates shortlisted through the screening test(s) shall be required to appear for a personal interview. The date, time and venue shall be notified online. Candidates are advised to regularly visit <https://sameer.gov.in/recruitment> for updates.
- (ii) Candidates fulfilling the prescribed qualifications shall be permitted to download the Identity Card (Admit Card) through the designated web link. A printed copy of the same must be produced at the time of screening test and interview.
- (iii) Final selection shall be based on the performance of the candidate in the interview, which shall be conducted at the venue mentioned in the admit card, unless otherwise notified.
- (iv) Mere appearance in the screening test, document verification, or interview shall not confer any right to selection or appointment. Selection shall be subject to fulfilment of all eligibility conditions and satisfactory performance at all stages of the selection process.
- (v) The panel of candidates recommended by the Selection Committee shall ordinarily remain valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of interview/skill test or for such period as may be decided by the competent authority.

4. GENERAL NOTES

- (i) Only those candidates who possess the prescribed degree/certificate with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent CGPA, awarded by the concerned university/board on or before the closing date of application, shall be eligible for consideration.
- (ii) The prescribed essential qualifications and experience are the minimum requirements, and mere possession of the same shall not entitle candidates to be called for written test, skill test, and/or interview.
- (iii) For Project Engineer positions, candidates who have already appeared in the final examinations between April and July for concurrent academic year and are awaiting results may also apply for the advertised positions. Appointment shall be subject to production of the pass certificate at the time of joining, provided they have secured 55% marks or equivalent CGPA in all declared semesters.

5. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT

- (iv) No TA/DA shall be admissible for appearing in the screening test and/or interview.
- (v) SAMEER reserves the right to accept or reject any candidature at any stage of the recruitment process without assigning any reason thereof.
- (vi) SAMEER reserves the right to cancel, restrict, enlarge, modify or alter the recruitment process, if circumstances so warrant, without issuing any further notice or assigning any reason.

- (vii) Candidates must ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions prescribed for the post applied for. In the event it is found at any stage of the selection process or thereafter that a candidate has furnished false or incorrect information, suppressed material facts, or does not meet the eligibility criteria, the candidature/service shall be liable to rejection/termination without notice.
- (viii) Candidates shall be required to produce all original certificates for verification at the time of interview.
- (ix) The appointment shall be purely on contractual basis and shall not confer any right to regularisation, absorption, or continuation of service in SAMEER.
- (x) The selected candidate shall have no claim or right for continuity of service or automatic extension of the contractual term.
- (xi) Experience beyond the period prescribed in the advertisement shall not be considered for grant of additional increments, and no candidate shall have any right to claim such increments.
- (xii) Candidates who have previously been engaged with any SAMEER Centre as Research Scientist, Project Engineer (PE), or Project Associate (PA) for an aggregate period of five (5) years or more shall not be eligible for appointment to the posts of Project Engineer or Project Associate.
- (xiii) Selected candidates will have liability to serve anywhere in the country.
- (xiv) Temporary accommodation, if available, may be provided as per the prevailing rules of the Institute on shared and payment basis. In case of violation of accommodation rules or misconduct in general the project staff will have to vacate the facility extended immediately as per the directions of the authorities. However, no candidate shall have any right to claim accommodation.
- (xv) Canvassing in any form or bringing any influence will be treated as a disqualification for the post.
- (xvi) No interim correspondence or queries shall be entertained.
- (xvii) Applications of Indian citizens only shall be considered.
