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2. Only online applications will be accepted. Candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria may apply online on **upto 11/05/2026** through STPI's Web Portal (under Career Section) i.e., www.stpi.in. Application received after the last date of submission will not be considered.

3. Important Instructions:

- Depending upon the vacancies available in various disciplines, selection of candidates will be carried out by short listing based on the marks obtained in the interview.
- Reservation shall be applicable as per Govt. of India Rules. Out of above 15 vacancies preference shall be given to 3-OBC, 2-SC, 1-ST candidates.
- It is mandatory for the candidates to register on NATS Portal(<https://nats.education.gov.in>) first before applying for Apprenticeship through STPI's Portal. Candidate needs to mention the NATS Enrolment ID on STPI's Online application module. Annexure-A briefly explains the steps to register on NATS Portal.
- Only completed Degree/ Diploma holder candidates who had completed their qualification in April 2021 or thereafter shall be considered for appointment as Apprentice Trainee.
- Candidates who have already completed their apprenticeship (if any) in the past at STPI or any other organization shall not be considered.
- The stipend payable to apprentices will be facilitated through the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mechanism. Under this arrangement, the admissible Government share of Stipend will be directly credited to the apprentices' bank accounts through the NATS portal after successful registration on NATS Portal for DBT.

Subject: Student Guide for Registration on the NATS Portal

Step-by-Step Registration Guide:

Step 1: Visit the NATS Portal

- Go to the official NATS portal: <https://nats.education.gov.in>
- Click on the “**Student**” section in the top menu bar.

Step 2: Enroll as a Student

- Click on “**Enroll**” under the Student section.
- Read the **eligibility criteria** carefully. Click on “**Yes**” if you meet the eligibility.
- Proceed to the **Enrollment Form**.

Step 3: Fill in Personal Information

- Provide your **name, date of birth, gender, email, and mobile number**.
- Create a **login ID** and **password** for your account.
- Enter your **Aadhaar number** and other identification details as required.

Step 4: Fill in Educational Details

- Select your **highest qualification** (e.g., Diploma, Graduate).
- Enter the **institution name, year of passing, and percentage/CGPA**.

Step 5: Fill in Communication & Bank Details

- Provide your **present and permanent address**.
- Enter your **bank account details** (account number, IFSC code, bank name) for stipend processing.

Step 6: Review and Submit

- Review all details carefully.
- Submit the registration form.
- A **unique student enrolment I.D** will be generated and sent to your registered email ID.
