1. VACANCIES

The Telangana State Level Police Recruitment Board (TSLPRB) invites Applications from eligible Candidates through **ONLINE** mode only in the prescribed proforma, which will be made available on the TSLPRB Website (www.tgprb.in), for direct recruitment to the following Post. 2. CANDIDATES TO CHECK THEIR ELIGIBILITY BEFORE APPLYING

Exact Dates for submission of Online Application Form will be intimated in due course through a Press Release. Candidates who are desirous and eligible REPEAT: eligible only may apply through the ONLINE mode only after having satisfied themselves of their eligibility for this recruitment. (Please see *Para 14: Eligibility Conditions of Candidates to ensure their eligibility for the Post and Para 4: General Instructions*)

4. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Candidates are required to go through the Notification meticulously and decide themselves as to their eligibility with reference to the laid down criteria for this recruitment carefully, before applying and filling in all relevant columns in the Online Application Form
- Applications received online shall only be considered, and the Telangana State Level Police Recruitment Board (TSLPRB) will not be responsible for any kind of discrepancy
- TSLPRB will not be responsible for any inconsistencies or errors in the Application submitted online. Candidates are advised to strictly follow the instructions in their own interest and to verify the contents before submitting the Online Application Form

- d) Particulars furnished by the Candidates in the Online Application Form will be taken as final. Candidates should therefore be very careful in uploading/submitting the Online Application Form
- e) No relevant column of the Application Form should be left blank. Incomplete / Incorrect Online Application Form will be summarily rejected. Information, if any, furnished by the Candidate subsequently in any form will not be entertained by the TSLPRB under any circumstances. Candidates should be careful in filling out the Online Application Form before submission. If any lapse is detected at any stage of the recruitment process, the candidature will be rejected
- f) Candidates should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered with, or fabricated. They shall not suppress or conceal any material information while filling out the Online Application Form. In case, if it is found at a later date that any false information has been provided, punitive action will be taken as per the law
- g) Candidates are expected to behave in an orderly and disciplined manner while appearing for the Tests / Examination / Certificates Verification. Any impersonation will be viewed adversely, and such Candidates shall be criminally prosecuted, besides being disqualified
- h) All the testimonials issued by the Competent Authorities shall compulsorily be produced as and when required. If the Candidate fails to produce the same, his / her candidature will be rejected/disqualified without any further correspondence
- i) The claim of the Candidates with regard to the Age, Date of Birth, Educational Qualifications, Community, etc., is accepted only provisionally based on the information furnished by them in their Online Application Form and Certificates produced, subject to verification and satisfaction of the TSLPRB, at an appropriate time. Mere acceptance of the Application, admission to any Exam, or inclusion of a Candidate in a Qualified Candidates List does not confer any right for selection. The candidature is therefore provisional at all stages, and the TSLPRB reserves the right to reject his / her candidature at any stage of the selection without giving any notice.
- j) Due to various Age relaxations being there for different Posts, Age validation is not being done in the Online Application Form. It is the responsibility of the Candidates to satisfy themselves about their Age eligibility for the Post(s) applied for

- k) If Candidates who are Under-Aged or Over-Aged apply for this Recruitment Notification, their candidature will be rejected at any time, and TSLPRB is not responsible for the same. Fee once paid will not be refunded.

Note: *As candidature for the recruitment is processed through Computer / Electronic devices, based on the particulars furnished in the Online Application Form, the Candidates are advised to fill in all the relevant particulars carefully.*

5. FEE

- a) OC and BC Candidates with local status of Telangana State applying for this Post have to pay the fee as designated in the Online Application towards Registration of the Application, Processing of Application, Conduct of Tests and Examinations (PMT / PET, Written Examination & Certificates Verification), Maintenance of Portal etc. However, SC and ST Candidates who are Local to Telangana State have to pay the concessional fee as designated in the Online Application. All other Candidates will have to pay the fee as designated in the Online Application.
- b) For the Candidates who apply for more than one Notification issued by the TSLPRB within a period of 3 months from this date of Notification, the Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test for all the Posts in the Notification(s) applied for by a Candidate, will be conducted only once and the same readings / scores will be valid for all the Posts for which he / she is applying for among the Notifications.

- a rebate of Rs.50/- per each additional Post applied for (in excess of 1 Notification) on account of the saving incurred due to the conduct of Common Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test shall be given, in the

total fee payable, in the case of Local Candidates of Telangana belonging to SC & ST categories and a rebate of Rs.100/- per each additional Post applied for (in excess of 1 Notification) shall be given to all other Candidates.

d) The fee being collected from the Candidates will be towards

6. PAYMENT OF FEE

I Step: Candidate has to register himself / herself on the TSLPRB Website – www.tgprb.in by making his / her Mobile Number as his / her User ID and then choose the Notifications and Posts that he / she would like to apply for. The fee payable will be determined based on the Posts he / she applies for. Candidates are advised to provide their mobile number as their Login ID, which will be in use throughout the recruitment process and will be in their personal custody. It shall be their responsibility to ensure that this Mobile number is maintained continuously without any interruption throughout the process of recruitment, so that there will not be any loss of communication between the Board and the Candidates.

II Step: This fee can be paid by using Credit Card, Debit Card, or Net Banking made available on the TSLPRB Website.

III Step: After making the Payment, it shall be the responsibility of the Candidate to visit the website www.tgprb.in to submit the Online Application Form which is in 2 parts i.e., Part I and Part II. Part I Application has to be submitted initially along with a scanned copy of Passport Size Photo +

specimen Signature combined as one file / image in jpg/jpeg format. Even after making payment of fee and furnishing the details in the application form, if the Candidate fails to press submit button and the Application is not uploaded, such Applications shall be rejected without giving any notice and fee once paid will not be refunded in any case.

IV Step: As there is no Preliminary Written Test for the technical posts of SCT Assistant Sub Inspector (Finger Print Bureau), Candidates shall visit the website www.tgprb.in at the appropriate time prior to PMT / PET and upload the Part-II Application along with scanned copies of the required certificates / documents. The dates for submission of the Part-II Application will be intimated subsequent to the conclusion of Preliminary Written Test of SI Civil and / or equivalent Posts.

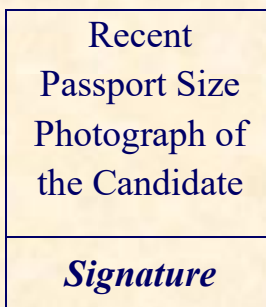
7. CANDIDATES SHOULD KEEP THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS READY TO APPLY

Candidates are requested to keep ready with the following documents before the schedule for submitting the Online Application Form

- i. Latest SC Community Certificate with sub-classification of SC Group I, SC Group II and SC Group III issued by the Competent Authority of Government of Telangana (For SC Candidates only)
- ii. Latest Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Category Certificate issued by the Competent Authorities of Govt. of Telangana issued on or after 1st April 2026, wherever applicable
- iii. Latest Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Govt. of Telangana issued on or after 1st April 2026 (For BC Candidates only)
- iv. Local Candidature Certificates i.e., Bonafide from 1st to 7th Class (or) Residence Certificate, wherever applicable
- v. Special Category Certificates like Police Executive, Police Ministerial, and Children of Police Personnel etc.

8. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING PART-I ONLINE APPLICATION

- a) Candidates are requested to check their eligibility carefully and fill-in all the relevant columns in the Part I Application Form. Candidates should not register more than one Application Form for the present Recruitment Process which intends to collect information for all the Posts notified through 4 (four) different Notifications with Rc Nos. 189 / Rect. / Rect.2 / 2026, 225 / Rect. / Rect.1 / 2026, 234 & 279 / Rect. / Rect.-3 / 2026, dated 29-07-2026
- b) The following steps are to be followed by the Candidates who intend to submit the online Application through Payment Gateway –
- Registration using Mobile Phone as User ID
 - Select the Post(s) for which he / she wants to apply as per the eligibility
 - Note the Fee that has to be paid depending on the Posts chosen
 - Payment of Fee using any mode made available
 - Continue on TSLPRB Website with the User ID and fill Part-I of the Application
 - Scan and Upload copy of Passport Photograph and Specimen Signature as one file
 - Submit the Application Form
 - Print Application Form / Forms generated for the Notification(s) applied for
- c) Candidates should keep ready a soft copy of his / her Passport Size Photo + specimen Signature combined as one file image in jpg format as shown below to be scanned and uploaded with the Online Application



- d) **Application will be rejected if the Candidate uploads the Photo without a signature.** The size of the above image / file should not exceed **100 KB (Minimum size is 30 KB)**. Please note that if the file is not in JPG format, the system will reject it, and the candidate may not be able to complete the process of filling up the remaining details of the Online Application Form.
- e) After payment of the fee, Candidates can use the "Apply Online" in the main menu option on the website (www.tgprb.in) to fill his / her Part I Application Form.

- f) Candidates are advised to carefully read all the instructions and understand before clicking on "I AGREE".
- g) **Candidates should endorse the declaration at the end of the Online Application signifying the fact that they have read and understood all the Rules and Regulations and that they agree to scrupulously abide by them and confirm with an OTP (One Time Password) sent to the Candidate's Registered Mobile.**
- h) Once the Candidate submits the Application Form, no corrections can be made. Hence Candidates are requested to carefully verify the details before submission.
- i) After submission of Online Application Form, the Candidate must download a copy of his / her submitted form in PDF for future use.

9. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING PART-II ONLINE APPLICATION

- a) There is no Preliminary Written test for the post of SCT Assistant Sub Inspector, Fingerprint Bureau. Candidates have to visit the website www.tgprb.in again for submitting the Part-II Application.
- b) Post Preferences / Unit Options once exercised are final and cannot be changed thereafter. Candidature will be considered as per the preferences indicated in the Application Form as per the eligibility. Candidature will not be considered for those Posts / Units which are left blank / unfilled by the Candidates
- c) Giving false information or Suppression or Concealment of facts will result in disqualification of the Candidates and renders them liable for Prosecution
- d) Once the Candidate submits the Application, no corrections can be made. Hence Candidates are requested to carefully verify the details before submission
- e) Candidates are advised to carefully read all the instructions and understand before clicking on "I AGREE"
- f) After successful submission of the Online Application, the Candidate will receive an Acknowledgment through his / her email ID. (Check SPAM folder of your email account if you have not received it in INBOX). The Candidate must download a copy of his / her submitted form in PDF for future use.
- g) Candidates are advised to fill their Online Application Form themselves instead of handing it over to others to avoid any wrong entries. If their Online Application Form is being filled by some other person the Candidate should

personally be available and ensure that the entries are made correctly and Online Application is uploaded successfully.

- h) Candidature is provisional at all stages. Mere issuance of Hall Ticket to the Candidates allowing them to attend the Examination(s) / Test(s) will not imply that Candidature has been finally cleared by the TSLPRB. TSLPRB will take up the Verification of Eligibility Conditions with reference to their Original documents of those Candidates who qualify in Final Written Examination.

10. UPLOADING / SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

Copies of the following documents must be uploaded in support of the information given in the Part II Application Form where necessary as well as the documents in original should be produced at the time of Certificates verification. Failure to upload the same will lead to rejection of the Online Application Form.

- i. SSC / Matriculation Certificate or its equivalent Certificate in support of Date of Birth
- ii. Education Qualification Certificate (See Para No.14(C) of this Notification)
- iii. Latest Community Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Government of Telangana for claiming Age relaxation/reservation (Candidates who belong to SC Community should submit the Community Certificate with SC Sub-classification i.e., SC Group - I, SC Group - II, and SC Group - III)
- iv. Latest Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued on or after 1st April 2026 by the Competent Authority of the Government of Telangana for BC Candidates, if they claim reservation in Selection
- v. Latest Certificate of Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) category issued on or after 1st April 2026 by the Competent Authority of the Government of Telangana for claiming Age relaxation / EWS reservation as mentioned at Para No. 12(C) of this Notification
- vi. Agency Area (Local Scheduled Tribe) Certificate issued as per GO Ms No. 24, dated 12-06-2018 of the Government of Telangana for ST & Aboriginal Tribe Candidates of Adilabad, Komarambheem-Asifabad, Mancherla, Nagarkurnool, Khammam, Bhadrachalam-Kothagudem, Mulugu, Mahabubabad, and Warangal districts, if they claim relaxation in height as per Para No. 15(A) (ii) (c) & (d) of this Notification

- vii. Latest Service Certificate by those Employees / Candidates who are in the Telangana State Government Service for claiming Age relaxation (Annexure III)
- viii. Necessary Certificate by NCC Instructor for claiming Age relaxation
- ix. PPO (Pension Payment Order) / Discharge Book, if already discharged from service of the Army / Navy / Air Force / Territorial Army, for claiming Age relaxation / reservation under the Ex-Servicemen category
- x. Serving Armed Forces of Army / Navy / Air Force / Territorial Army of the Indian Union retiring within one year from the last date on which Part-I Application could be submitted, should submit “No Objection Certificate” issued by the concerned Unit Commanding Officer duly indicating his Personal Number, Rank, Name, Unit and date of retirement or retirement order, for claiming Age relaxation / reservation under Ex-Servicemen category
- xi. Study / Bonafide / Residence Certificates for claiming Local Candidature (See Para No. 17 of this Notification)
- xii. MSP Certificate(s) for claiming reservation under MSP (See Para No. 12 (D) of this Notification)

11. RULES GOVERNING THE POST(S)

Recruitment to the Posts of the Police Department (Post Code No. 33) is being made under the Telangana Police (Stipendiary Cadet Trainee) Rules, 1999 issued in GO Ms No. 315 Home (Police-C) Department, dated 13-10-1999 and the amendments issued thereon from time to time by the Government r/w GO Ms No.68, Home (Legal) Department, dated 28-07-2026.

12. SPECIAL REPRESENTATION (RESERVATION)

A) Reservation:

The rule of Special Representation (Reservation), i.e., BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC, ST, Ex-Servicemen, Meritorious Sports Person, and Economically Weaker Section category provided in Rule 22 of Telangana State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996, shall be applicable to all the Posts. Further, Rule 22-A of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules 1996 shall also be applicable.

B) Community:

- i. SC and ST Candidates who are local Candidates to Telangana State as per the definition given in the Presidential Order, 2018, are required to produce latest Community Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Government of Telangana State for claiming Age relaxation / reservation. Candidates who belong to SC Category should submit Community Certificate as per Act No. 15 of 2025, dated 14-04-2025 issued by the Government of Telangana with regard to reservations to SCs by way of sub-classification in the State i.e., SC Group - I, SC Group - II and SC Group – III.
- ii. BC Candidates who are local Candidates to Telangana State as per the definition given in the Presidential Order 2018, are required to produce Community Certificate (BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D & BC-E) from Competent Authority of the Telangana State Government.
- iii. Candidates belonging to Backward Classes shall submit the Community Certificate to claim Age relaxation and the latest Certificate of Non Creamy Layer issued by the Competent Authorities of Telangana State on or after 01-04-2026 to claim Reservation. In case of failure to produce the Non Creamy Layer Certificate on the day of Certificates Verification, such Candidates will be considered under “Open Competition”, if otherwise eligible, and the status cannot be changed later.
- iv. Relaxation in upper age limit and / or reservation to BC-E Group will be subject to the adjudication of the litigation pending before the Honourable Courts including final orders in Civil Appeal No(s). 2628-2637 of 2010 in SLP No. 7388-97 of 2010 dated 25-03-2010 and orders of the Government.
- v. BC, SC and ST Candidates who are not local to Telangana State as per Presidential order 2018 are not entitled for any kind of reservation.

C) Economically Weaker Section (EWS):

Candidates who are local Candidates to Telangana State as per the definition given in the Presidential Order 2018 and belonging to Economically Weaker Section category (as per GO Ms No. 65, GA (Ser. D) Department, dated 19.03.2021 r/w GO Ms No. 244, GA (Ser. D) Department, dated 24-08-2021) shall submit the Income and Asset Certificate issued by any of the following Authorities of Government of Telangana State to claim Age relaxation and Reservation under this Category.

- i) District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Collector / Sub-divisional Magistrate / Mandal Revenue Officer
- ii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar and
- iii) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the Candidate and / or his family normally resides

D) Meritorious Sports Persons:

Persons who satisfy the definition given in sub rule (20) of Rule 2 of Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 and who possess the necessary certificate issued by the Competent Authority clearly certifying that the qualifying participation was prior to the date of this Notification, will come under this reservation and it will be applicable to the following categories only:

Category 1 - A sports person who won medals or represented India in an International Competition / Multinational Competition in any one of the recognized Games / Sports which are mentioned in Annexure I of GO Ms No. 74, YATC (Sports) Department dated 9-8-2012 and as subsequently amended from time to time

Category 2 - A sports person who won medals or represented a State in India in a National Competition in any one of the recognized Games / Sports which are mentioned in Annexure I of GO Ms No. 74, YATC (Sports) Department dated 9-8-2012 and as subsequently amended from time to time

Note:-

- i) Candidates who come under category (1) above shall be considered initially to fill the vacancies under MSP reservation. If sufficient Candidates of category (1) are not available, then the Candidates from category (2) shall be considered for the relevant Posts.*
- ii) Where there is more number of Candidates possessing the certificates of same category available, then marks secured by them during the final selection shall be taken to decide the inter-se-merit.*
- iii) In the event of non-availability of eligible sports persons, the vacancies reserved for them shall be allotted to Open Competition in the same recruitment.*

E) WOMEN RESERVATION

33⅓% of the vacancies in each category including EWS are reserved for Women. The reservation for Women will be a horizontal reservation following the principle of sufficiency i.e., the reservation of Women Candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective category to which the Woman Candidate belongs. In the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable Women Candidates, the vacancies reserved for them shall not be carried forward for the succeeding recruitment and shall be filled up by Men Candidates of respective Communal Category.

13. INSTRUCTIONS TO BE READ CAREFULLY

The requisite Educational qualifications, age limits, Physical standards, Procedure to be followed for selection etc., is given below. Candidates must read the instructions given in this Notification carefully in their own interest.

14. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS (CANDIDATES TO ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE EXAMINATION)

Candidates applying for the examination should ensure themselves that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the examination. Their admission at all the stages of the Examination(s) / Test(s) will be purely provisional and shall be subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.

Mere issue of Hall Ticket to the Candidate will not imply that his / her candidature has been finally cleared by the Board.

TSLPRB will take up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to original documents only after the Candidate has finally qualified or at an appropriate time.

A. Eligibility by Gender: Both Men and Women are eligible for this Post.

B. i) Age Limit (General): Must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 25 years as on 1st July, 2026. However, the Government of Telangana vide GO Ms No. 87, General Administration (Services-A) Department dated 18-05-2026 have raised the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment by **5 (five) years** for uniformed services including Police, Fire Services, Prisons and Special Protection Force Departments. This relaxation is in addition to the upper age limit as mentioned above.

ii) Relaxation in Upper Age Limit: The Upper age limit prescribed above is however relaxable in the following cases:

4	SCs, STs, BCs and EWS category	5 (five) Years

Save as provided above, the age limits prescribed can in no case be relaxed.

Note:

1. Persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Indian Union, who on Retirement from Service, would come under the category of Ex-Servicemen, may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified terms of engagement and avail themselves of all the concessions available to Ex-Servicemen

2. Name and date of birth accepted by the TSLPRB is that entered in the Secondary School Certificate or Matriculation or an equivalent examination certificate. No other document relating to Age like horoscopes, Affidavits, birth extracts from Municipal Corporation, Service Records and the like will be accepted

C. Educational Qualification: Must possess a Degree of B.E. / B.Tech in Information Technology, Computer Science OR Computer Science

specialization in Artificial Intelligence / Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning / Data Science / Networks / Cyber Security / Internet of Things OR Degree of BSc in Computer Science OR Computer Application awarded by any university in India, established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, Provincial Act of State or of any institution recognized by the University Grants Commission or any other equivalent qualification as on date of Notification i.e., 29th July 2026.

Provided that, Degree or Provisional Certificate or Consolidated Marks Memo of the whole duration of study which proves the qualification, shall be made available by the Candidate at the time of certificate verification to prove his / her qualification issued by the University on or before 29th July 2026. If any Candidate fails to produce the required pass certificate as above on the designated day, then it shall be deemed that he / she does not possess the required qualification and such candidature shall not be taken forward. Any certificates produced after the last date of Certificate Verification shall not be taken into consideration.

Note:-Candidates who possess a higher qualification than the prescribed one will also be considered on par with the Candidates who possess the prescribed qualification.

D. Medical Standards:

- i) Eye Sight: Visual Standards required for the above selection shall be as follows –

- ii) Each eye must have a full field of vision

- iii) Colour blindness, squint, or any morbid condition of the eye or lids of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification
- iv) Candidate should possess sound health and be free from any bodily defect or infirmity which will render him / her unfit for the Posts notified
- v) Candidates who have the following ailments or defects will not be considered for recruitment to any post specified in this rule
 - i) Physically handicapped
 - ii) Knock-knees, pigeon chest, flat foot, Varicose veins, Hammer toes, fractured limbs, decayed teeth, stammering, hard of hearing, and abnormal psychological behavior
- vi) Candidates provisionally selected shall be referred to the District Headquarters Hospital for Medical Examination / Fitness. For any expert opinion, Candidates shall be referred to Osmania / Gandhi Hospitals, Hyderabad, on the basis of the recommendations made by the District Headquarters Hospitals. Candidates who are declared unfit due to eye-related issues shall be referred to the Sarojini Devi Eye Hospital, Hyderabad, based on the recommendation made by the District Headquarters Hospital. The opinion given by the Sarojini Devi Hospital shall be final. The Candidates can be referred / examined only once on such recommendations. There shall not be any further re-examination once the Candidate is already examined as per the referral of the District Headquarters Hospital for expert opinion. Where there is no referral for expert opinion from the District Headquarters Hospital, such Candidates shall not be referred any further.

Note:- *In order to avert getting disappointed at a later stage, Candidates are advised to have themselves examined by a Civil Surgeon before applying for the examination to ensure that they meet the prescribed Physical and Medical Standards.*

15. SELECTION PROCEDURE / SCHEME

The Selection Procedure / Scheme of the Examination will be as follows –

Intimation Letter: Candidates will be informed of the dates for downloading the Intimation Letter through the website (www.tgprb.in) for appearing in the PMT / PET

with details of Venue, Date, and Time. Candidates should bring the Intimation Letter while attending the PMT / PET.

A) Sequence of Physical Efficiency Test and Physical Measurements:-Candidates who submitted the Part II Application Form shall be required to undergo the following tests and qualify as specified below:

i) 1600 meters / 800 meters Run event:- Men Candidates must qualify in the 1600 meters Run within a maximum time of 7 Minutes 15 Seconds. For Ex-Servicemen, the maximum time is 9 minutes and 30 Seconds. Women Candidates must qualify in the 800-meter run within a maximum time of 5 Minutes 20 Seconds.

While conducting the 1600-meter and 800-meter run events, where RFID-based readings are taken, the competitors perform totally independently of each other. Consequently, starting time, finishing time, and duration are automatically recorded individually for each competitor. Nevertheless, wherever required, only the curved-start (not staggered-start) method, wherein the competitors can change lanes immediately after the start, will be adopted. All digitally recorded readings shall be rounded mathematically to 2 decimal places to determine qualification / disqualification and also gradation.

ii) Physical Measurements: Candidates who qualify in the above Run event should meet the following requirements:

- a) For Men Candidates –
Height: Must not be less than 162cms
- b) For Women Candidates –
Height: Must not be less than 152.5cms

Provided that, Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes and Aboriginal Tribes in the Agency areas of Adilabad, Komarambheem-Asifabad, Mancherial, Nagarkurnool, Khammam, Bhadravathi-Kothagudem, Mulugu, Mahabubabad, and Warangal districts should meet the following requirements:

- c) For Men Candidates –
Height: Must not be less than 160 cms
- d) For Women Candidates –
Height: Must not be less than 150 cms

iii. Long Jump / Shot-put events: Candidates declared qualified in the Physical Measurements as above shall be required to undergo the remaining PET events and must qualify as detailed below:

Long jump and shot put are qualifying in nature.

Note: *Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test for all the Posts in the Notification(s) issued by TSLPRB (within a period of 3 months) applied for by a Candidate, will be conducted only once, and the same readings / scores will be valid for all the Posts for which he / she is applying among the Notifications.*

Intimation Letter: Candidates who qualify in the Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test will be issued Hall Tickets for appearing in the Written Examination with details of Venue, Date, and Time. Candidates should bring the Hall Ticket when they come to attend the Written Examination.

B) Written Examination: Candidates who qualify in the above Physical Efficiency Test shall be required to appear for the Written Examination in 3 (three) papers (each of three hours duration) as given below. The syllabus for this exam is given in Annexure I.

Note:

- 1) The minimum marks to be secured by the Candidates in order to qualify in the Written Examination in each paper are 40% for OCs, including EWS, 35% for BCs, and 30% for SCs / STs / Ex. Servicemen.
- 2) Paper I is qualifying in nature and the marks secured in this Paper shall not be taken into account for final selection. Those Candidates who do not secure the minimum qualifying marks in this Paper shall not be considered further in the selection process, irrespective of their performance in Papers II and III.
- 3) Part A of Paper I referred to above shall be objective in nature, and Candidates have to answer the questions using a Blue / Black Ball Point pen only, and Part B of Paper I is descriptive in nature.
- 4) For each question in Part A of Paper I, the Candidate shall be awarded full marks assigned to that question if he / she darkened only one bubble that corresponds to the correct answer. In case the Candidate has not darkened any bubble, the Candidate shall be awarded zero marks for that question. In all other cases, 25% of the full marks shall be awarded as a negative mark for that question.
- 5) In Paper II, the Candidates can choose to have either Telugu or Urdu and should indicate their choice as and when asked for. Option once exercised shall be final, and Candidate shall not be allowed to change it subsequently.

6) Questions in Paper II shall be objective in nature. Candidates have to answer the questions on an OMR answer sheet using a Blue / black ball-point pen only.

7) Appearance in all the Tests and Written Examinations, as per rules, is compulsory. Absence in any of the above Tests / Examination shall automatically render a Candidate disqualified.

8) Mere securing of minimum qualifying marks does not vest any right in a Candidate to be considered for selection.

9) Questions in Paper II shall be set in English-Telugu & English-Urdu languages, and in case of terminology of Science, technology / Management, transliteration will be employed at the expert's discretion. In case of any ambiguity or spelling mistake in Translation / Transliteration in any Question in the Telugu or Urdu language, the English version shall be considered as final and the correct version.

10) While evaluating Objective-type Papers, the marks for the deleted questions, if any, will be awarded to each Candidate proportionately, and the marks will be considered up to 3 (three) decimal places to determine the merit of the Candidate. Thus, with reference to deleted questions, each Candidate will be compensated in proportion to his / her percentage of marks obtained in the rest of the questions (which remain undeleted)

11) Candidates who secured 40% and above in each Paper, i.e., Paper-II and Paper-III only, are eligible to be considered for selection for Posts under OC / EWS irrespective of social categories.

C) No Postponement / Reconsideration of Tests, including PMT / PET, during recruitment process:- Candidates should be fit in all aspects at all stages of recruitment, including PMT / PET. No Postponement / reconsideration of stages under any circumstances shall be allowed. A Candidate has to undergo the tests,

including PMT / PET, on the designated day in the sequential order as prescribed above.

D) Final Selection:

The final selection of the Candidates will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their aggregate score of Paper II and Paper III of the Final Written Examination. 95% of the vacancies of SCT ASI (FPB) in the Contiguous Zones as organized under “The Telangana Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2018” r/w GO Ms No. 169, GA (SPF.II) Department, dated 04-08-2021 shall be filled up from the Local Candidates of the respective Zones as per GO Ms No. 46, GA (SPF.II) Department, dated 04-04-2022.

E) Merit among Candidates who secure the same Marks: When 2 (two) or more Candidates in a particular category obtain equal marks, preference will be given to the Candidate who was born earlier.

16. CERTIFICATES VERIFICATION

Candidates who qualify in the Written Examination will be called for Certificates Verification, and they have to produce Original Documents (along with two sets of photocopies) and other particulars on the day of verification itself, for verification or as and when required and called for. If Candidate(s) fail to produce the Certificates at the time of verification or if the particulars furnished in the Online Application Form do not tally with the Original Documents produced by the Candidate(s), the candidature will be rejected / disqualified without any further correspondence.

17. RESERVATION TO LOCAL CANDIDATES

Reservation to Local Candidates is applicable as per the provisions of “The Telangana Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2018” issued in GO Ms No. 124 General Administrative (SPF-

MC) Department, dated 30-08-2018. Candidates claiming Reservation as local Candidates should enclose the required Study Certificate(s) for the duration of education from I class to VII class issued by the Government School Authorities / Government Recognized School authorities. Within the 7 (seven) years, in case the Candidate did not study in any Government or Government-recognized school, then, the Residence Certificate (for such period) issued by the Tahsildar of the concerned Mandal should be enclosed for determining local Status.

Note:-

a) Single certificate, whether of study or residence, would suffice for enabling the Candidate to apply as a “Local Candidate”

b) Residence certificate will not be accepted if a Candidate has studied in any Educational Institution up to the 7th class or equivalent examination. Such candidates have to produce study certificates only, invariably. The Candidates, who acquired degree from Open Universities without studying 7th class or equivalent in Educational Institutions, have to submit Residence Certificate only. Educational Institution means an institution recognized by the Government / University / Competent authority.

18. LOCAL RESERVATION

Local Reservation shall be followed in terms of Para (7) of Telangana Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct recruitment), Order 2018 issued in GO Ms No. 124, GA (SPF.MC) Department, dated 30-08-2018 r/w GO Ms No. 128, GA (SPF-I) Department dated 30-06-2021 and GO Ms No. 46, GA (SPF-II) Department, dated 04-04-2022 and subsequent Orders issued by the Government from time to time.

19. NECESSARY CERTIFICATE FOR EX-SERVICEMEN

Candidates who claim reservation as Ex-Servicemen should satisfy the conditions mentioned in Sub-Clause (16) of Rule 2 of Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996, and shall have the necessary certificate from the Competent Authority (PPO – Pension Payment Order, Discharge Book, and NOC, whichever is applicable).

20. SELECTION TO BE PROVISIONAL

Selection of the Candidates shall be provisional and subject to verification of the original certificates, antecedents, medical fitness, and also the outcome of disciplinary proceedings, if any, pending against the serving employees.

21. INCLUSION IN THE MERIT LIST DOES NOT CONFER ANY RIGHTS

Mere admission to any test or inclusion of a Candidate's name in a Merit List shall not confer on him / her any right for Selection / Appointment to such service, class or category. The provisional selection of the Candidates to the Posts mentioned in this Notification, are subject to the several other requirements described below.

- a) **Verification of Antecedents and Medical Fitness**: No person shall be eligible for appointment to any service by direct recruitment unless he / she satisfies the selection authority as well as the appointing authority that his / her character, antecedents, and medical fitness are such as to qualify him / her for such service.

b) **Disqualification for Selection / Appointment**: Candidates falling under the following categories shall be disqualified for Selection / Appointment, as per the rules.

- (i) Suppression of Material facts or providing False / Erroneous Information (either in the Application Form or in the Attestation Form)
- (ii) If the Candidate himself or through his / her relatives or friends or any other has canvassed or endeavored to enlist extraneous support, whether from official or non-official sources, for his / her candidature
- (iii) A person (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person. Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person, exempt any person from the operation of this rule
- (iv) A person who has been dismissed from the Services of a State or Central Government or from the service of any Central or State Government Undertaking or Local body or any other authority
- (v) A person who has been convicted for any offense except in cases where imposition of fines under the MV Act and imposition of fines in summary trial cases.
- (vi) A person who is involved in criminal case(s) that are of a grave / serious nature (or) involving moral turpitude.

22. SUPPRESSION / WITHHOLDING OF FACTS – NOT ADVISABLE

Suppression of Material facts or withholding any factual information in the Application or Attestation Form (which would be supplied to the Candidates who are declared provisionally selected) will disqualify the Candidate from being considered for

appointment. In the event of any information being found false or incorrect or ineligibility being detected at any time even after Appointment, he / she will be discharged from service forthwith by the Appointing Authority without giving any notice.

23. FALLOUT VACANCIES

There shall be no waiting list for any of the recruitment processes conducted by TSLPRB, and the list of Candidates provisionally selected against the notified Posts shall be final, and there shall not be any sliding under any circumstances. The fallout vacancies, if any, due to cancellation of provisional selection for any reasons, including adverse Antecedents, Lack of Medical fitness, relinquishment by the candidates, and non-joining of the Induction Training as per the designated procedure, etc., of the provisionally selected Candidates shall be deemed to lapse for the recruitment notified.

24. APPOINTMENT ON COMPLETION OF INDUCTION TRAINING

Candidates who are provisionally selected to the SCT Posts of the Police Department will be appointed to the regular Posts by the concerned Appointing Authorities, only on successful completion of Induction Training.

25. RESIGNATION AND RELIEF FROM EARLIER EMPLOYER / NECESSARY PREREQUISITE TO JOIN TRAINING

Candidates who are provisionally selected for any one of the Posts specified in this Notification and are employees of Telangana State Government / any other State Government / Central Government / any Public Sector Undertaking / Government Enterprise can join training only after relief from the earlier employer / after resignation from the earlier service. Such relief / resignation should be obtained well before the commencement of training and submitted to the concerned Appointing Authorities for necessary action.

26. TIME LIMIT FOR SUBMISSION OF FORMS

Time limit for submission of Attestation Forms (or) other relevant documents (or) attending Medical Examination (or) joining the Induction Training: i) Candidates who are provisionally selected for any one of the Posts specified in this Notification will be asked to submit an Attestation Form, produce other relevant documents, and attend Medical Examination on a specified date. List of the Candidates who become eligible will be sent to the concerned Head of the Department for taking further necessary action. If any Candidate fails to respond and submit the necessary form(s) or document or attend the Medical Examination or join the training on a specified date, his / her provisional selection will be cancelled without any further notice to the Candidate. The Candidates who are found fit in all aspects and become eligible to be sent to the concerned Heads of Departments for further action.

ii) If any Candidate finally selected as above fails to join the training on the specified date or seeks postponement of training for any reason, further action, either to cancel the selection or postponement of training, shall be taken by the concerned Head of the Department. For the Candidates whose training is postponed, further action to verify the Antecedents Verification and conduct Medical Examination before sending the Candidates for the next batch of training shall be taken by the concerned Head of the Department.

iii) If any Candidate subsequent to his / her selection is unable to join the original Induction Training Batch meant for the respective Post of the selection for reasons attributed to the Candidate; and such situation continues till the conclusion of the usual date of declaration of probation of the said batch, then such Candidate/s shall undergo the Physical Efficiency Test prescribed for recruitment purposes as on the date of the conduct of such test, only those Candidates who cleared the Physical Efficiency Test shall be allowed to be considered for selection / consequent Induction Training.

27. STIPEND AND ALLOWANCE

During the period of Institutional training (regular as well as extended) Candidates shall be eligible for stipend as fixed by the Government from time to time. On successful completion of training, they will be appointed to the regular Post.

28. PENSION RULES

Employees who are appointed on or after 01-09-2004 are covered by the Contributory Pension Scheme. Existing Pension Scheme as per Revised Pension Rules, 1980, as applicable to the State of Telangana, will not be applicable to them.

29. DECISION OF TSLPRB TO BE FINAL

TSLPRB reserves all the rights to itself with regard to taking decisions pertaining to acceptance or rejection of Application/s, procedure of Certificates Verification, conduct of Examinations (especially as regards modifying and rescheduling Examinations), Antecedent Verification, Medical Examination, and Selection as per Rules, and decision/s of TSLPRB shall be final in all these aspects. Candidates are advised to visit the website of TSLPRB regularly to keep themselves updated until the completion of the recruitment process. Candidates are further advised not to rely on rumors and false propaganda resorted to by persons with vested interests through media / social media platforms. TSLPRB website information is final, legitimate, and definitive as far as correspondence / communication with the Candidates is concerned. No individual correspondence by any other means will be entertained under any circumstances.
